ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Roof has been covered with asphalt shingles
Horse stalls and any milk cow stanchions have been removed. Windows have been replaced with 9"x12"
vinyl four light windows.

INTERIOR NOTES: Four rows of posts and beams running East to West. West 18' beams are (3) 2X8'S
with steel posts replacing 4x6's. East 42' has one row of 4x6 beam and 4x6 posts on the North. The
posts and beams are missing on the South side. A 2x6 wall supports the next 16' from the South.

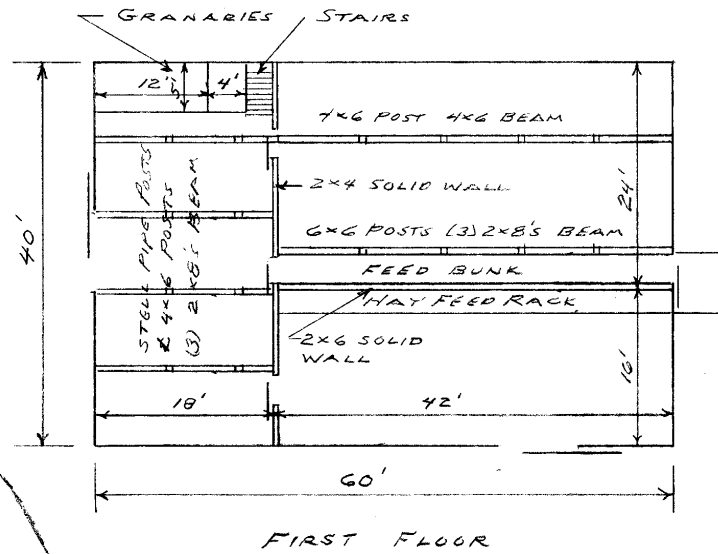
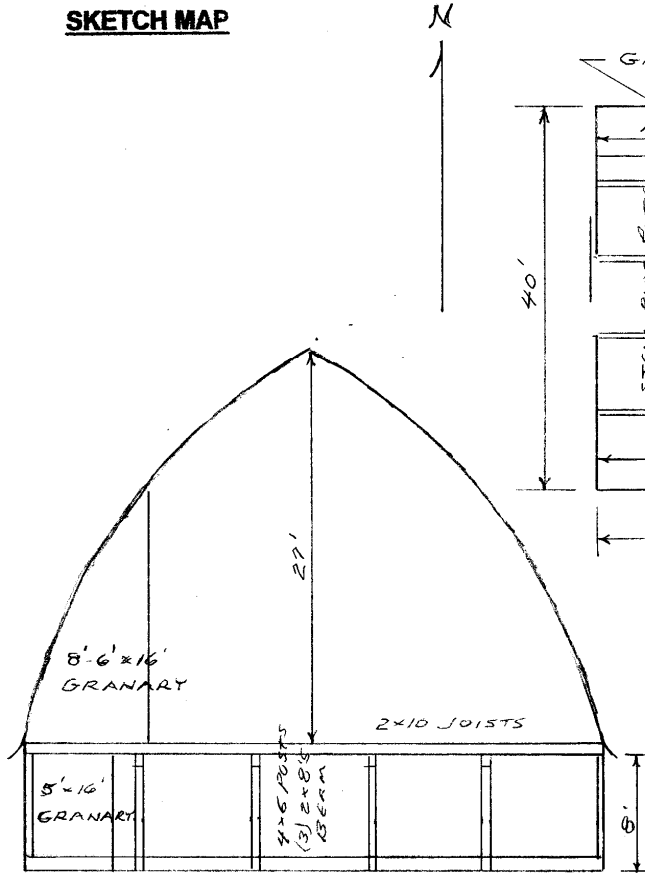
OTHER NOTES: Laminated round gothic rafters, with sheathing cedar shingles and asphalt shingles.
A 2x4 solid wall separates the West 18' from the East. A 42' 2x6 solid separates the South 16' from
the North 24'. Two metal cupola's. 9"x14" four light vinyl windows in the first floor. 9"x12" six light
windows in the hayloft. 16'x8'- 6" granary in NW corner of hayloft. 5'x16' granary in NW corner of first
floor

*PHYSICAL NOTES: Barn is in excellent condition.

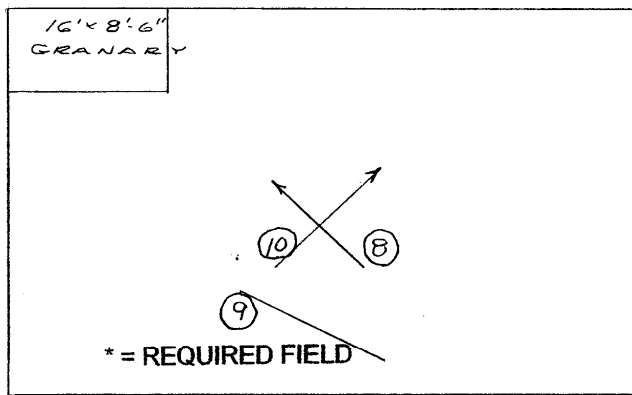
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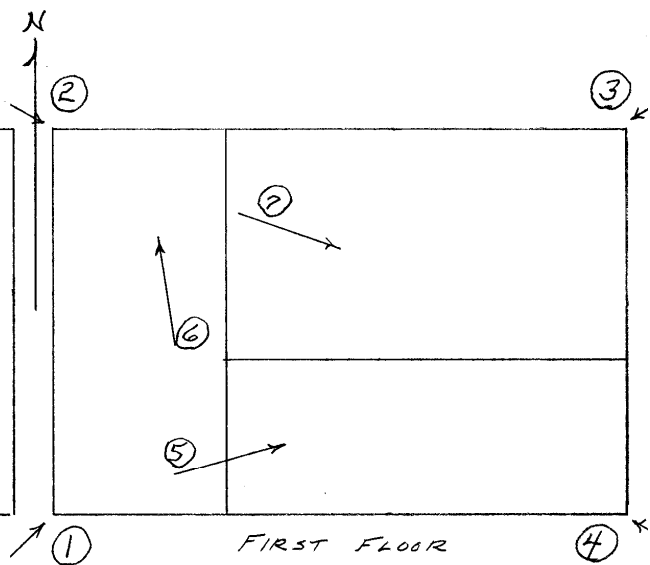
SKETCH MAP

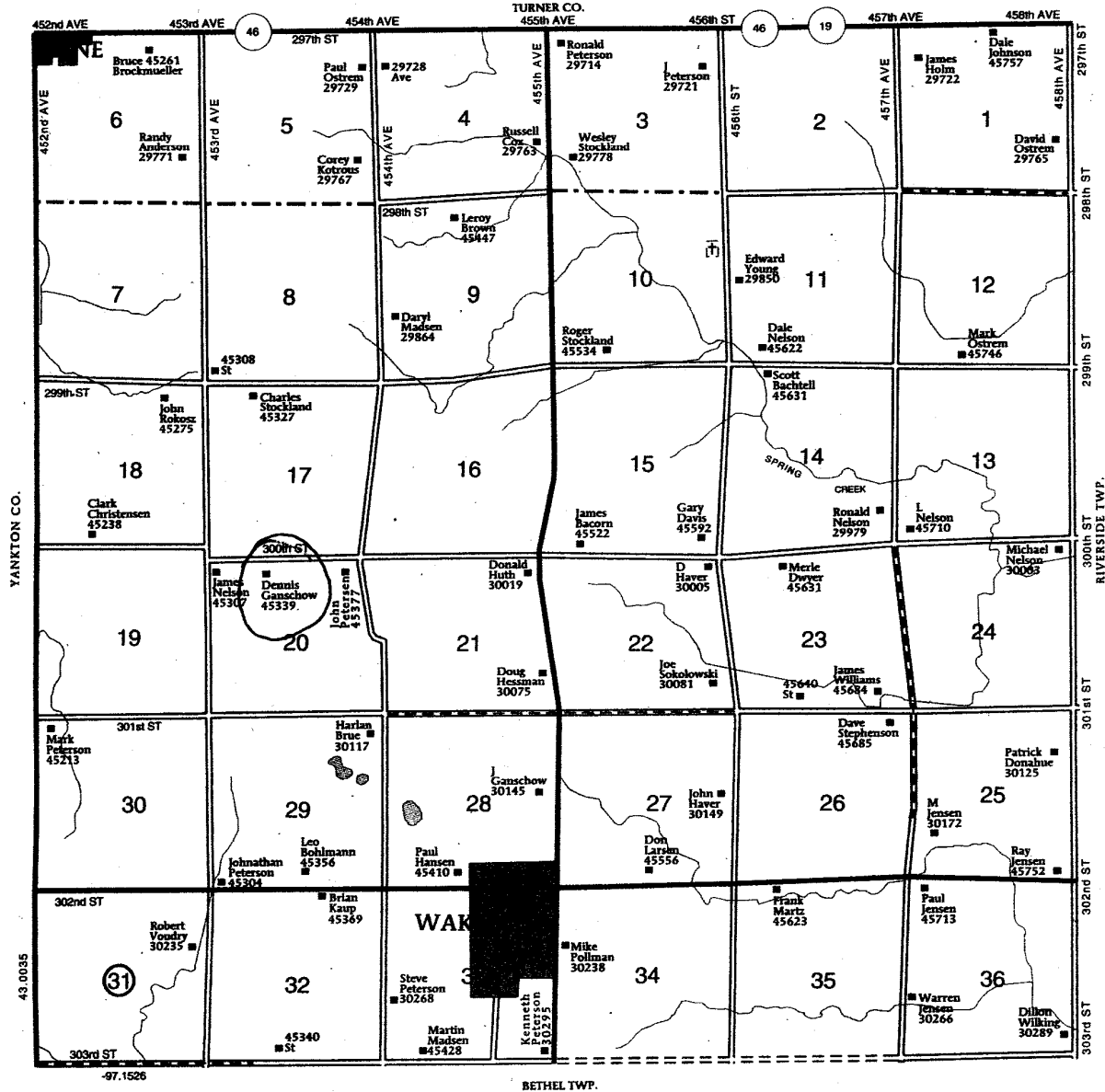
