





ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Any evidence of horse stalls in the main barn have been					
removed. Some of the rafters and roof sheathing have been replaced. 14' x 26' lean-to added on the West					
side. Asphalt shingles applied on the roof. The hay track may have been removed when the new rafters					
were installed.					
INTERIOR NOTES: _ Two rows of 4x6 posts, 6x6 beams and 2x8 floor joists support the hayloft floor.					
10' x 12' granary still in place in the SW corner. Granary is extended into the hayloft. 8' x 13' milk room					
in the SE corner. This room has a concrete tank with well water running through it for a milk cooler.					
OTHER NOTES: 2X6 stud walls with 1x6 #106 drop siding on all four exterior walls but the West lean-to					
has double 2x6 studs 4' O, C, with 1x8 vertical siding and metal battens. Windows are 9" x 12" four light.					
Rafters are 2x6's with two rows of double 2x6 posts and 2x6 and 2x8 beam supporting the center of the					
rafters. All of the 2x6 studs, 2x6 posts 2x6 rafters, 2x8 floor joists, 4x6 posts and 6x6 beams are rough					
sawn cottonwood. 10' x 10' hayloft door on the South wall. No hay track, but has rope and wooden drum					
at the peak on the North gable end to open and close large hayloft door. *PHYSICAL Barn is in good condition. Roof has




SOUTH ELEVATION


