




SKETCH MAP



The 1924 Clay County atlas lists Mytle Johnson as the owner.

The 1937 Clay county Atlas lists Equitable Life Insurance as the owner. Repossessed in the 1930's.

The 1948 Clay County atlas lists A. F. Lowman as the owner.

The 1956 Clay County atlas lists C. F. Lowman as the owner.
