ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Some evidence of horse stalls and or milk cow stanchions has been removed. Asphalt shingles has been installed over cedar shingles on the roof.

INTERIOR NOTES: Two rows of 6x6 posts, and 6x6 beam support the 2x8 joists for the hayloft floor. Two double horse stalls and two double and one single milk cow stalls were on the South wall. 8' x 10' granary are still in the NW corner. Three granaries still in place in the NW corner of the hayloft.

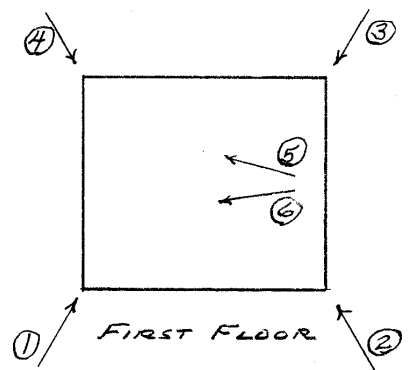
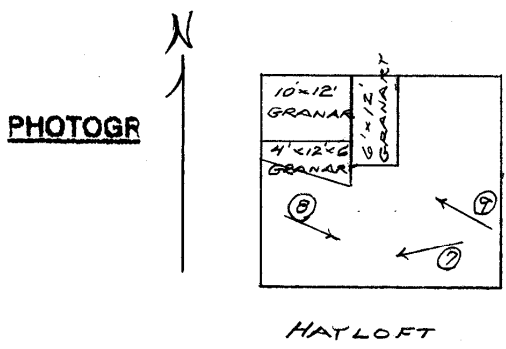
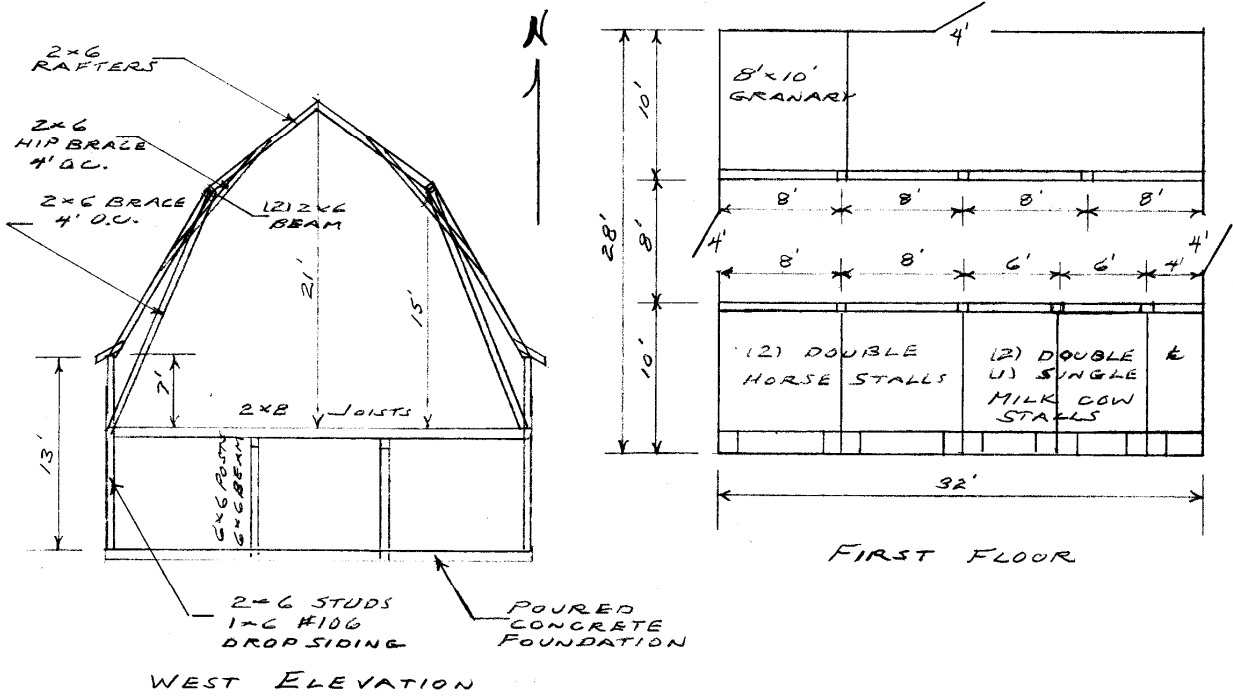
OTHER NOTES: 2x6 stud walls with 1x6 #106 drop siding. Rafters are 2x6's with a 2x6 brace at the hip 4' O. C. and a 2x6 brace supporting hip 4' O. C., between braced hip rafters. Asphalt shingles over cedar shingles. Windows are 8" x 10" four light. Metal cupola is still in place. Cupola is small compared others.

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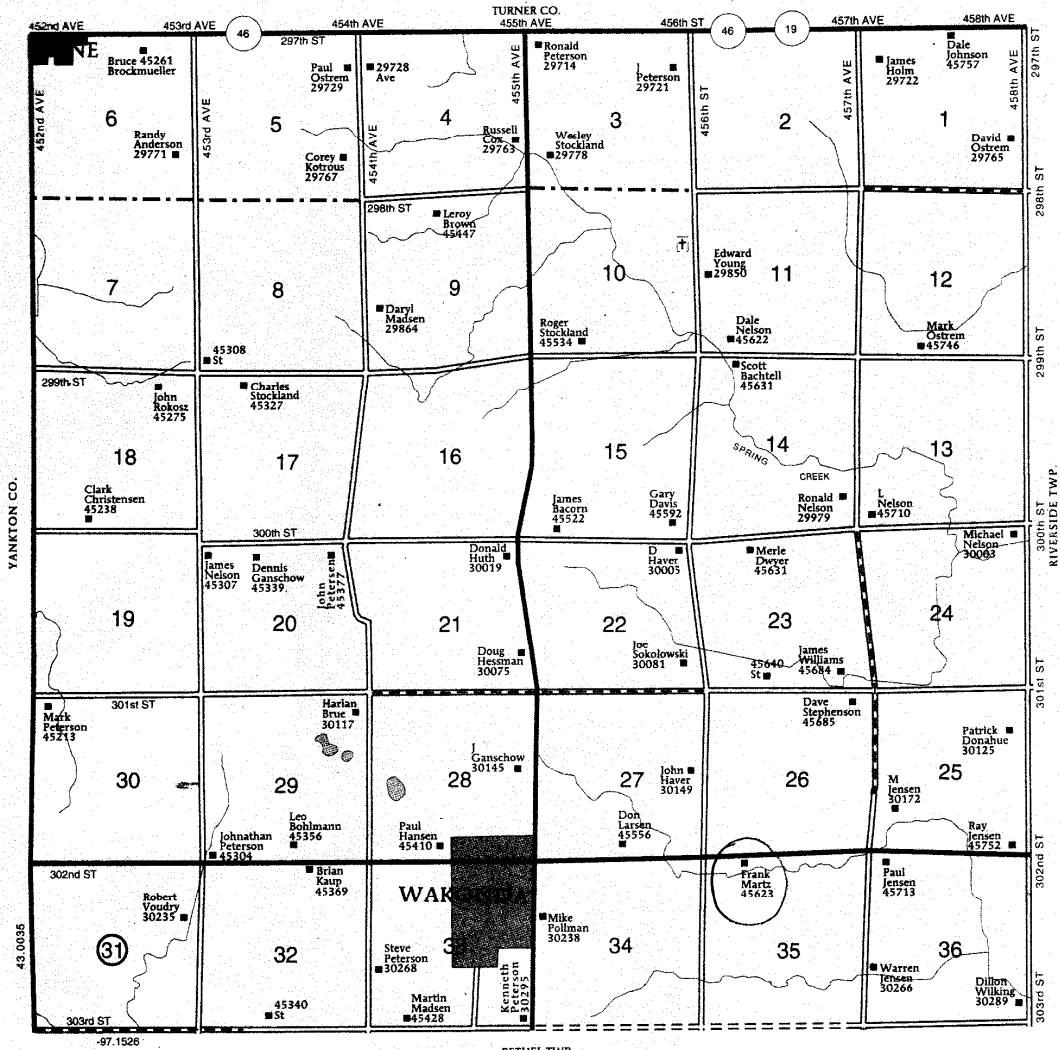
