



This farm located in the NW ¼ of Section 22, Prairie Center Township, Clay County was homesteaded by Andres Salberg.

The 1894 and 1901 Clay County Atlas lists Andrew Salberg as the owner and lists this farm as the "Salberg Farm".

The 1912 Clay County Atlas lists S. A. Salberg as the owner.

The 1924 Clay County Atlas lists S. A. Salberg as the owner.

The 1937 Clay County Atlas lists S. B. Salberg as the owner and J.B. Salberg as the operator..

The 1948 and 1956 Clay County Atlas lists J. B. Salberg as the owner.
