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ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Any evidence of milk cow stanchions or horse stalls has been removed, except one double horse stall. 15'x50' lean-to added on the West side at a later date. Battens removed from the vertical siding and 1/2"x6" cedar lap siding applied. Original barn had large native stones for a foundation, which has been repaired with poured concrete in places. 15'x50' lean-to added on the West side at a later date.

INTERIOR NOTES: Has two rows of 6x6 posts, a 4x6 for a beam in the South area. 6" round posts and 4x6 beams in the North area. Floor joists are 2x8's for the hayloft floor. Has a 2x4 solid wall in 20' from the North end. The first floor has 4x6 joists 6' O.C. with 2x12's for a floor in the South 30'.

OTHER NOTES: 2x6 stud walls with 2x4 girts 4' O.C. and original 7/8"x16" vertical siding with 1x3 battens. The battens were stripped off and 1/2"x6" cedar lap siding applied to the North, East and South walls about the time the West lean-to was added. Windows are 8"x10" four light, with two 8"x10" four light over 8"x 10" four light double hung windows on the South wall. Rafters are 2x6's with a 2x6 horizontal brace 8' O.C.

***PHYSICAL NOTES:** Barn is in very poor condition.

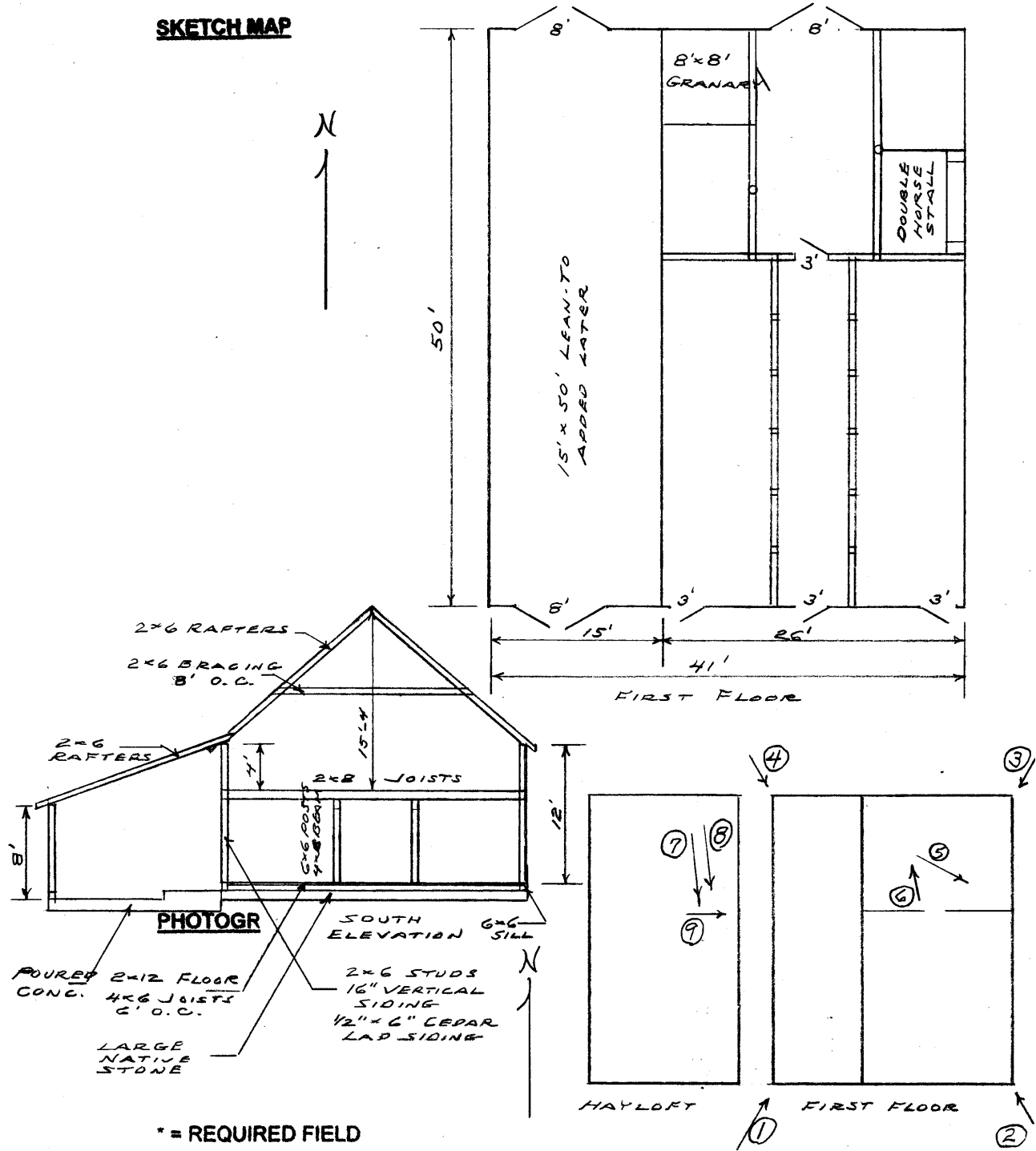

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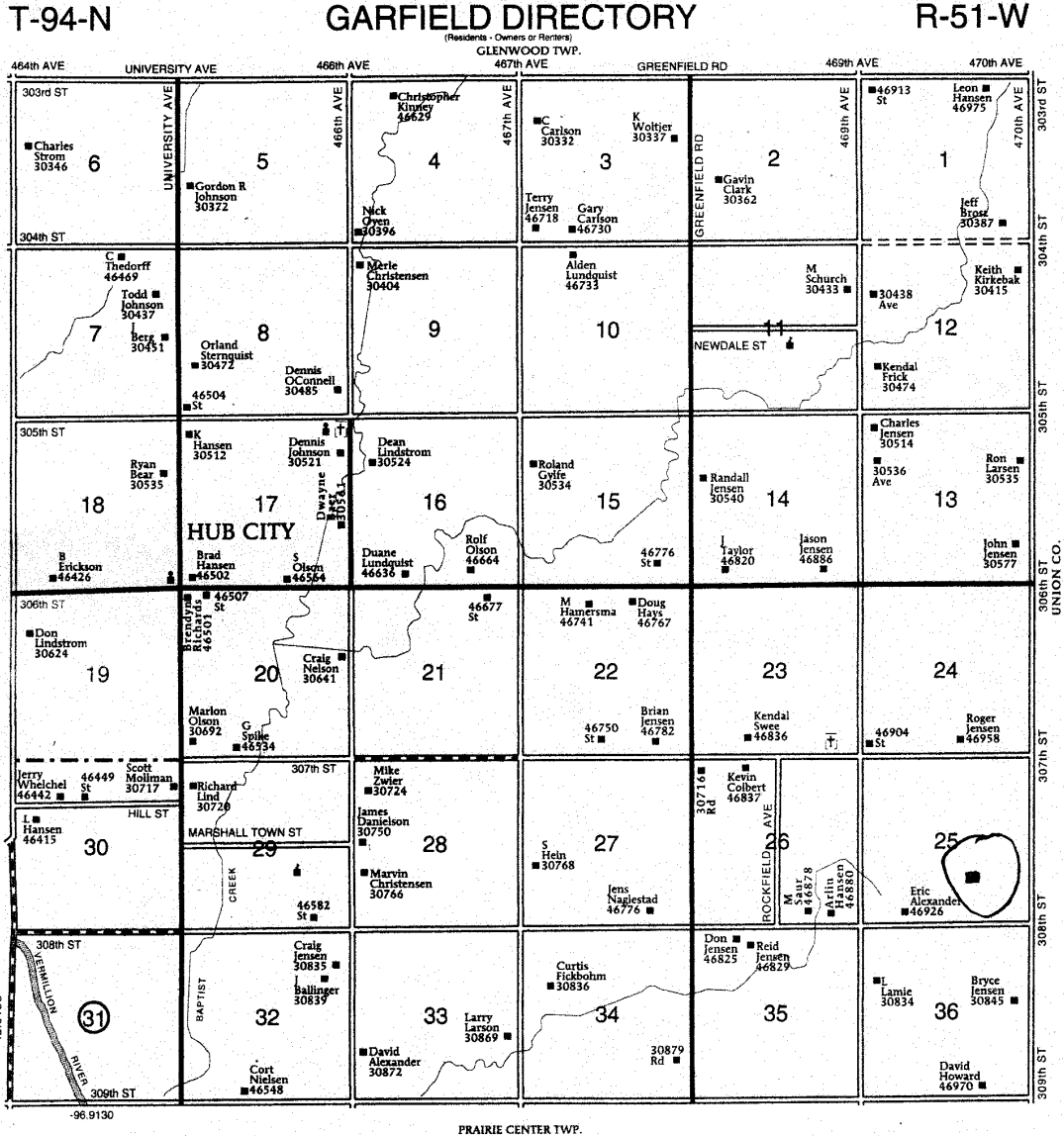
