

#### **HISTORY**

This farm located in the SE ¼ of section 35, Meckling township, Clay County was homesteaded by Fredrick Branson.

The 1894 and 1901 Clay County Atlas lists Albert M. Edgerton as the owner.

The 1912 and 1924 Clay County Atlas lists Fred L. Demann as the owner.

The 1937 Clay County Atlas lists Albert M. Edgerton as the owner.

The 1958 and 1956 Clay County Atlas lists Caroline Sealey as the owner.

The Following Information Was Furnished by Jane Slattery

Fred Demann purchased the SE ¼ in Section on March 19, 1902 from Albert and Melinda Edergerton. According to Henrietta Sealey there was a shack still on the farm in 1909. The current home and barn were built between 1902 and 1909. A man, Herman Peterson or Johnson, built the house. The farm was passed on to Fred and Sophia's daughter Caroline and then to Caroline's son Harold Sealey.
