ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Roof covered with galv. steel roofing. Side walls covered with red ptd. steel roofing. Any evidence of horse stalls removed. Five box stalls built on the North side of main barn. Any evidence of milk cow stanchions has been removed. Some of the beams have been replaced with (4) 2x8's and 6x6's. South lean-to has been added later.

INTERIOR NOTES: Has two rows of 4x6 posts with 4x6 for beams. Some beams have been replaced with (4) 2x8's or 6x6's. 2x8 floor joists. Granary and tack room still in place. All double horse stalls and the milk cow stanchions have been removed.

OTHER NOTES: 2x6 stud walls with 1x12 diagonal sheathing on some walls and horizontal on other walls. Walls are covered with steel roofing so I couldn't see any siding. Floor joists are 2x8's. Rafters are 2x6's. One row of 2x6's 4' O.C. with 2x6 plate support the rafters on each side in hayloft. 20' x 29' area on North is a hayloft from ground level to the peak. Appears to be the first part of the barn built.

*PHYSICAL NOTES: Barn is in good condition.

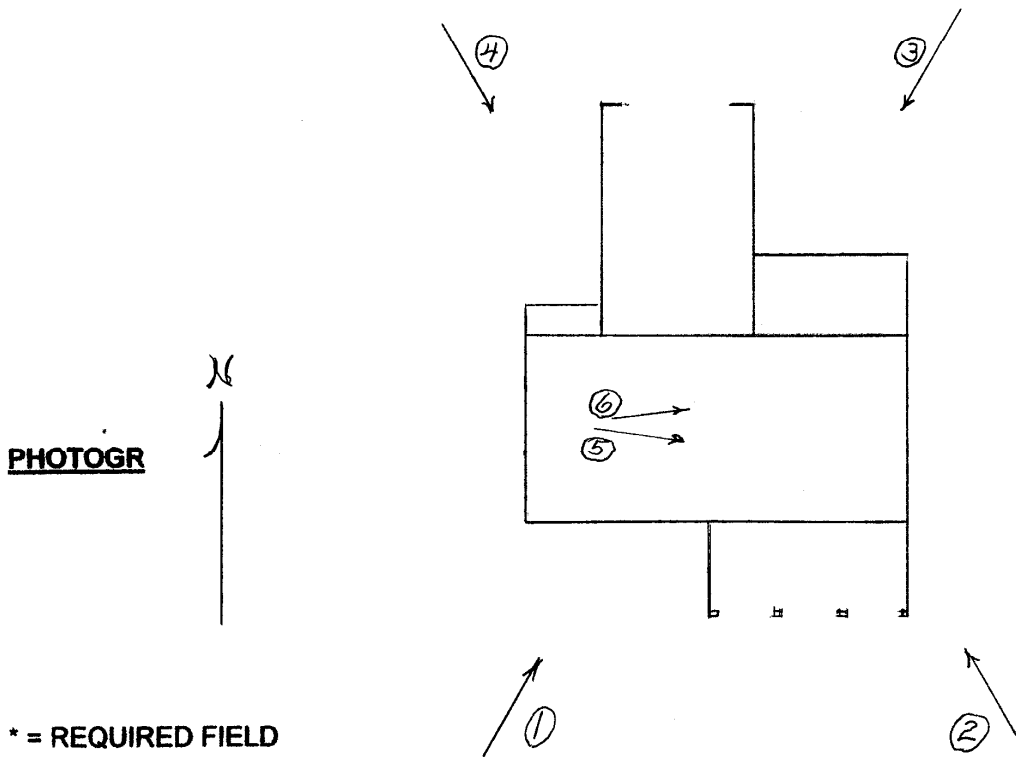
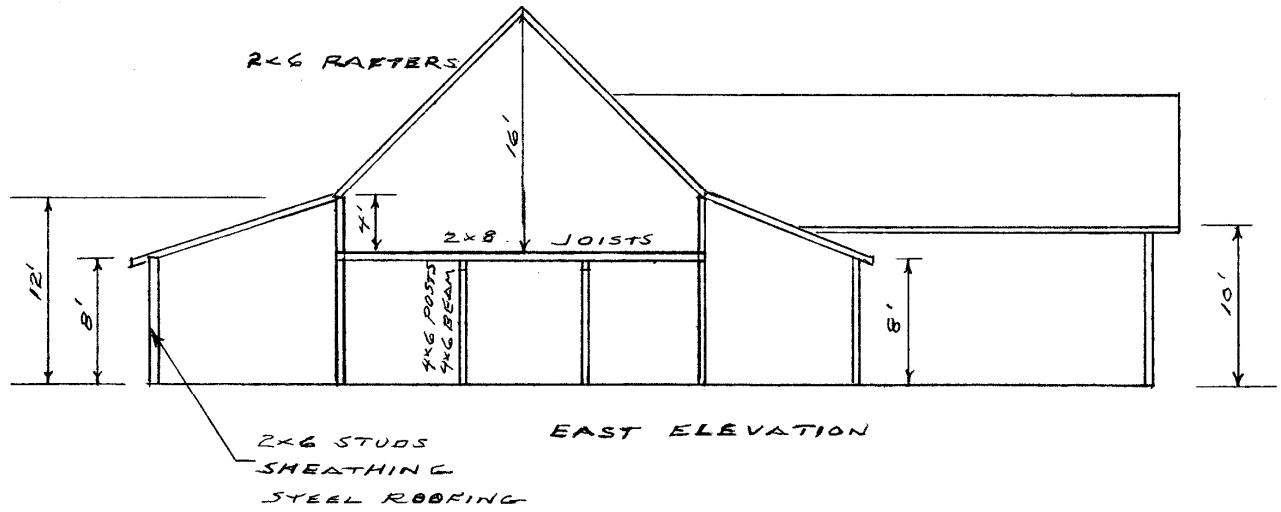

SKETCH MAP

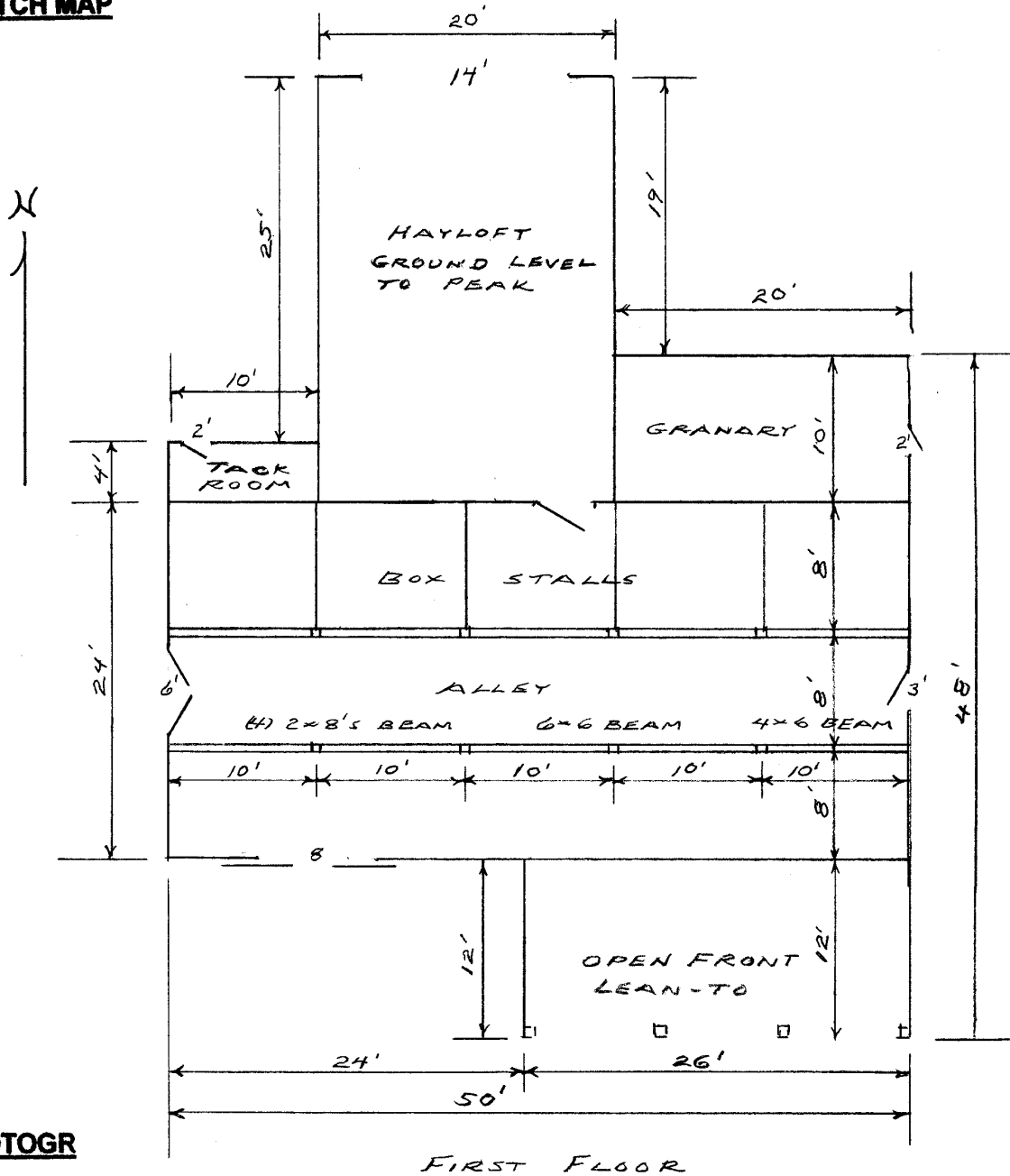

HISTORY

This farm located in the SE ¼ of Section 24, Garfield Township, Clay County was homesteaded by Claus Madsen.

The 1894, 1901, 1912, 1924, 1937 and 1948 Clay County Atlas lists Carl H. Henrickson as the owner.

The 1956 Clay County Atlas lists T. F. Emigh as the owner.

This farm was known as the “Rock Pine Stock Farm”. Carl Henrickson was known as a breeder of Shorthorn cattle and Chester White hogs.

This barn was built about 1900.
