ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Milk cow stanchions and horse stalls have been removed. Asphalt shingles applied over cedar shingles. Bottom 4' of 6"cedar lap siding has been replaced with 1x6 car siding.

INTERIOR NOTES: <u>Has two rows of 6x6 posts with 6x10 for beams. 2x10 floor joists. Granary and</u> feed room and stairs are still in place. Granary still in hayloft. All 2x6's, 2x10's, 6x6's, and 6 x10's are rough sawn cottonwood. Cottonwood lumber most likely came from saw mill on Wallace Cusick's farm by Burbank. Wallace Cusick was father of Harold Cusick. OTHER NOTES: 2x6 stud walls with 1x8 sheathing and ½"x6" cedar lap siding. Rafters are six plies


of ¾"x 1-1/2" cedar. Rafters are manufactured and each rafter has a stamp M. Slagle Co. Elk Point, So. Dak. 1x10 sheathing on roof. Asphalt shingles over cedar shingles. 8"x10" four light windows on first floor. Has two 8"x10" six light windows in West wall of hayloft.

SKETCH MAP












CAMERA DIRECTION: Gable end

# HISTORY

This farm located in the NW ¼ of the NW ¼ in Section 22, Fairview Township, Clay County was homesteaded by Timothy K. Hovey.

The 1894, 1901, 1912 and 1924 Clay County Atlas lists Carrie L. Burgess as the owner. Carrie L. Burgess most likely built or had this barn built as the construction is from about that period of time.

The 1937 Clay County Atlas lists Carrie L Burgess Estate as the owner and P. Ouellette as the operator (renter).

The 1948 Clay County Atlas lists Wallace L. Cusick as the owner.

The 1956 Clay County Atlas lists Harold Cusick as the owner.
