ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Four box stalls, one calf pen and a tack room have been installed. Walls have been covered with steel roofing. Original windows 4x24 four lite have been replaced with 9x12 four lite windows. South sliding door and hayloft door have been replaced with 2x4 frame covered with steel.

INTERIOR NOTES: Two rows 6x6 posts with 6x6 beam run North and South. 2x6 floor joists for the hayloft floor covered with 1x6 shiplap flooring. Granary in the hayloft in SW corner.

OTHER NOTES: Gothic round laminated rafters made with 1 x 2's five ply's thick. 1/2" plywood on the roof for roof sheathing with asphalt shingles. Barn appears to be a precut package, however I could not find any markings as to who the package may have come from. Date of construction confirmed by Connie Taggart (Cecil Schultz's daughter). Connie does not think that it was a kit barn.

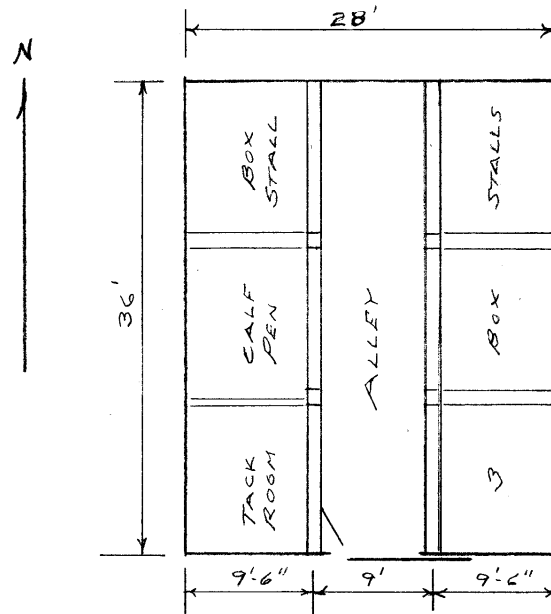
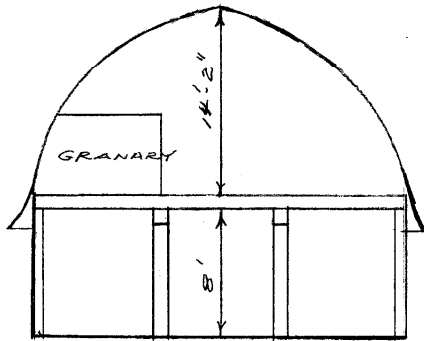

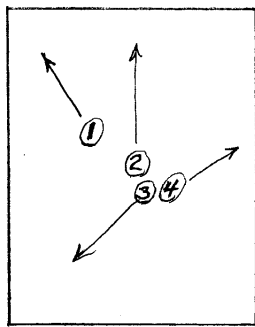

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**SKETCH MAP**

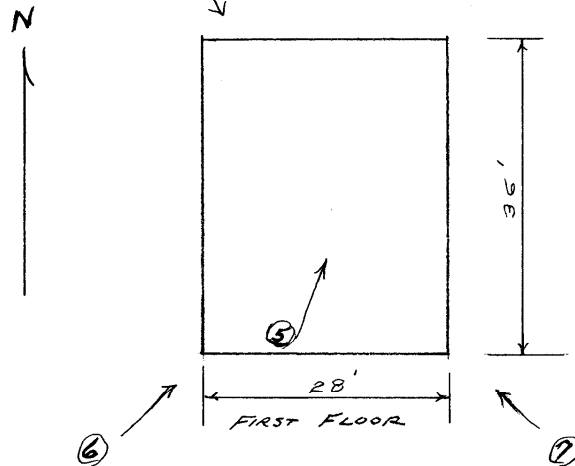

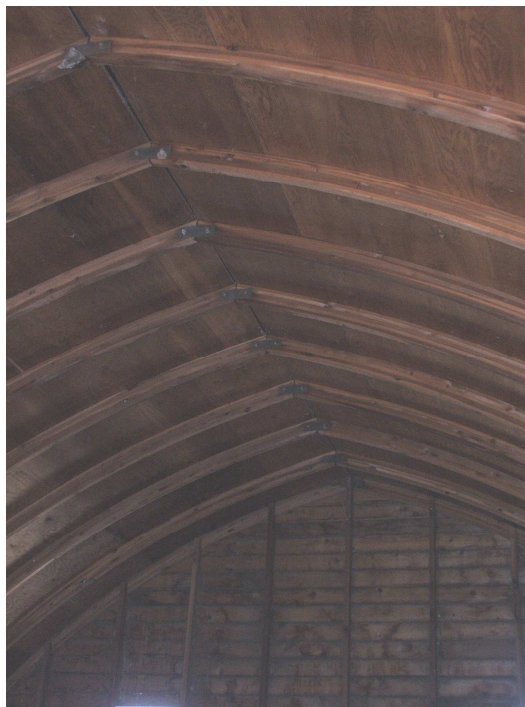

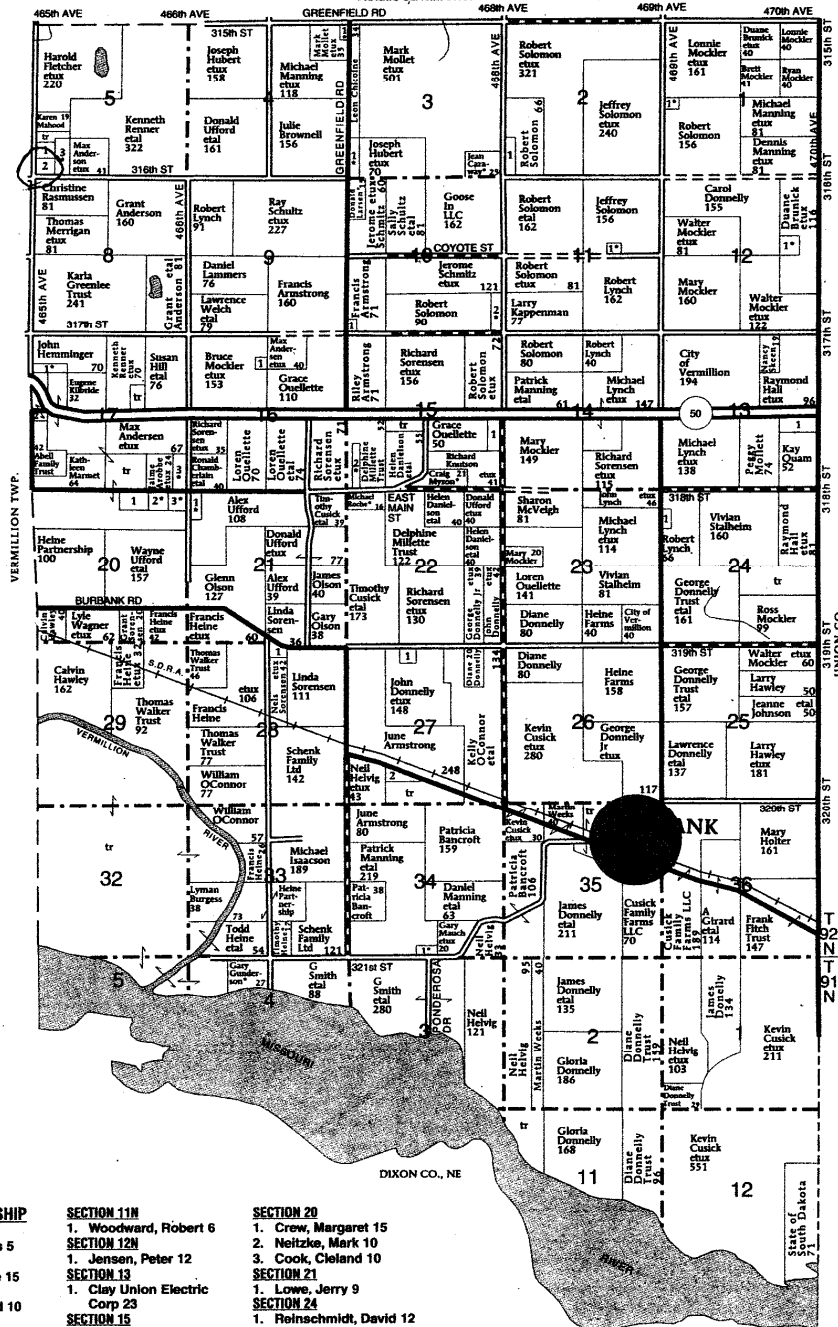

## **HISTORY**

This farm located in the SW ¼ of Section 5, Fairview Township, Clay County was homesteaded by Daniel B. Wadworth.

The 1894, 1901 and 1912 Clay County Atlas lists Daniel B. Wadworth as the owner. In 1912 the farm was called “Maple Grove Farm”.

The 1924, 1937, 1948 and 1956 Clay County Atlas lists Guy H. Brooks as the owner. The farm was called “Walnut Park” in 1937.

**The Following Is Furnished By**  
Connie (Schultz) Taggart

Cecil Schulz lived here for many years. He is 90 years old.  
He could not remember the year that he built the barn.  
He thinks that it was a precut package but is not sure.  
He doesn't remember where he bought the package if it was a package.

I discovered that Connie Taggart was his daughter. I visited with Connie and found out that Cecil built the barn with the help of his sons in 1965. It was not a package kit.

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
