ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Any evidence of milk cow stanchions has been removed. 24' x 35' lean-to added to the West side. The exterior walls have been covered with 1-1/4"x26" corrugated, galvanized steel roofing applied vertically. Windows have been covered with the steel roofing. Roof covered with 1-1/4" x 26" corrugated Galvanized steel roofing.

INTERIOR NOTES: Two rows of 4x6 posts, and 4x6 beam support the 2x6 joists for the hayloft floor. Two rows of 4x6 posts and a 4x6 beam support the center of the rafters in the hayloft. Three double horse stalls are still in place on the East wall.

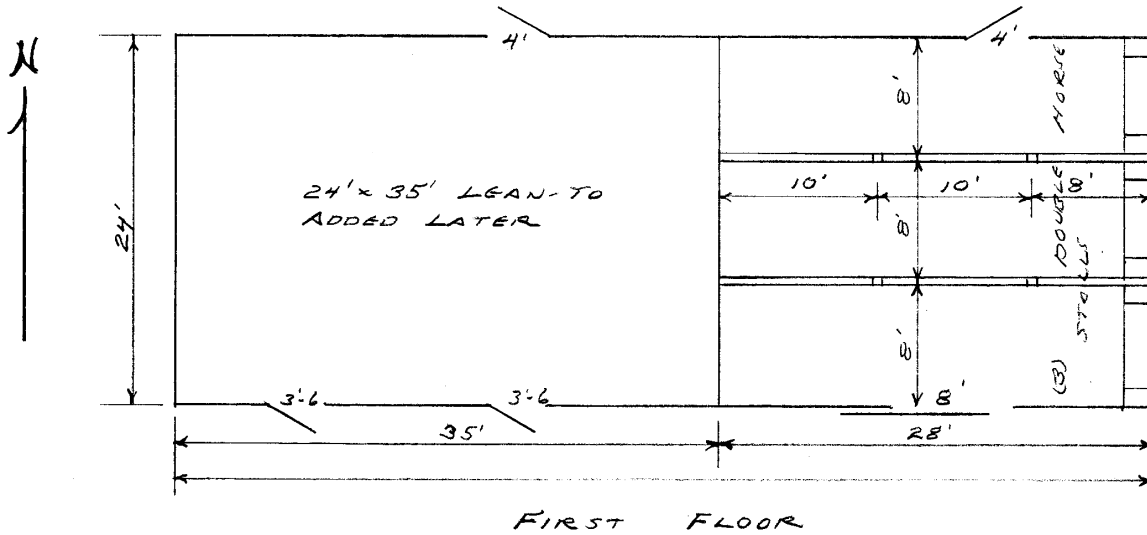
OTHER NOTES: 2x6 stud walls, with 1x8 #106 drop siding. Rafters are 2x6's. Windows were 8" x10" four light.

*PHYSICAL NOTES: Barn is in fair condition. Lean-to roof is falling in.

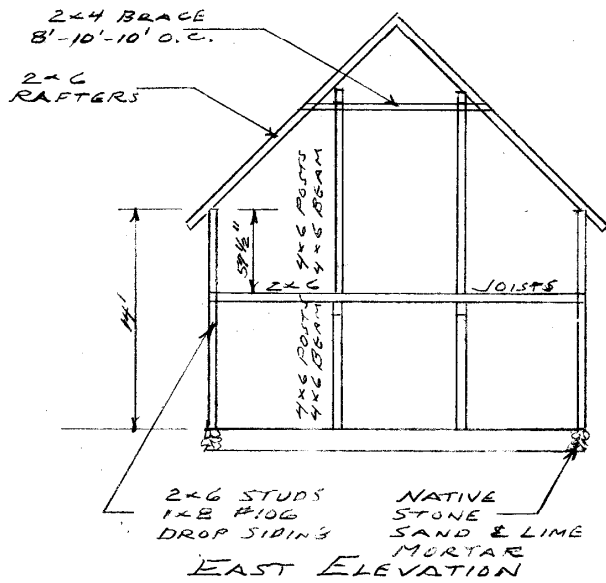

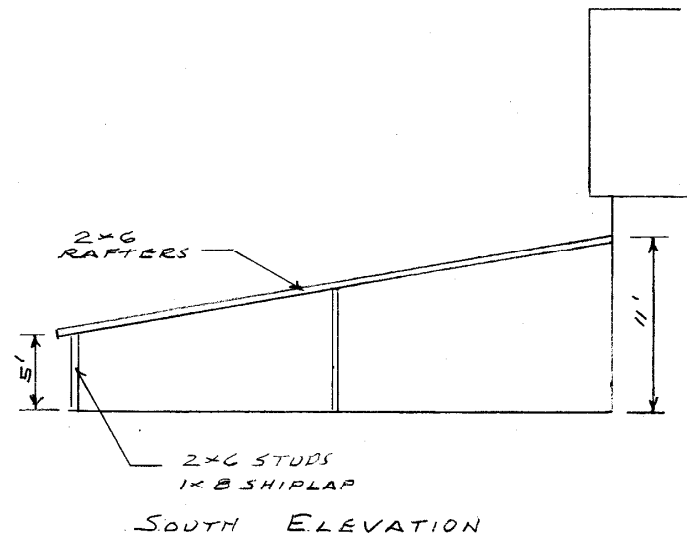
SKETCH MAP



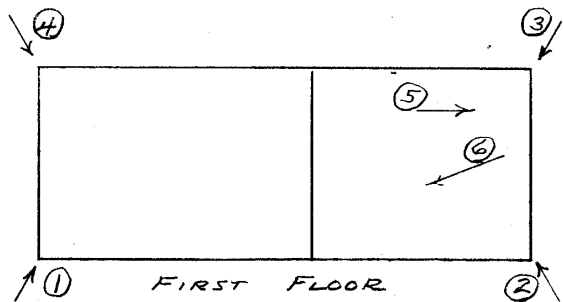
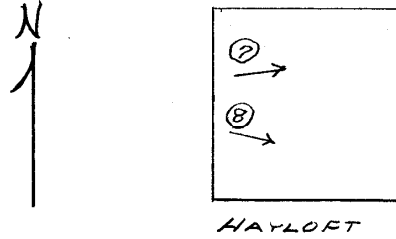
FIRST FLOOR

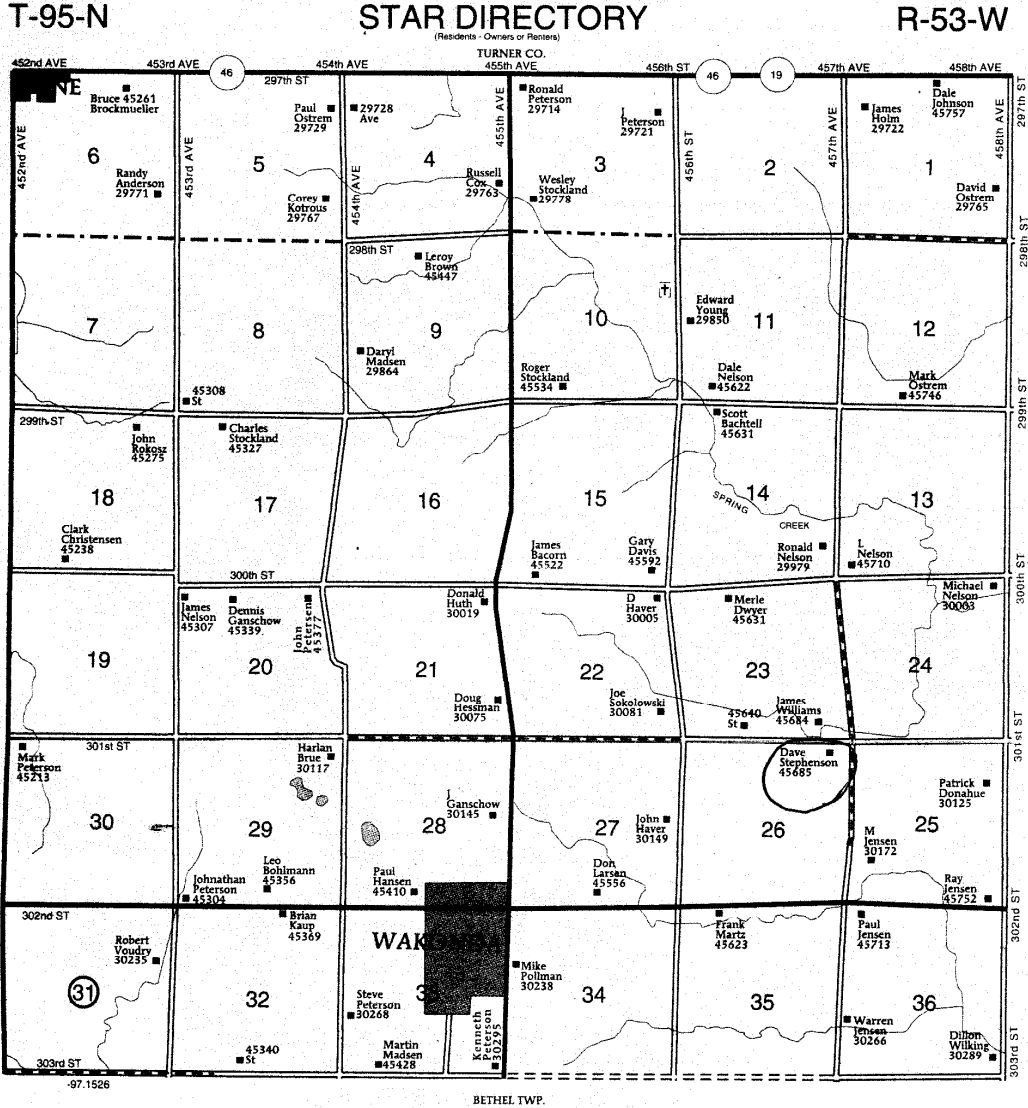
