





1894 Clay County Atlas lists F. D. & C. E. Swenson as the owners.

The 1901, 1912, 1924, 1937 and 1948 Clay County Atlas lists Charles E. Swenson as the owner. The 1937 Clay County Atlas also lists F. Peterson as the operator.

The 1956 Clay County Atlas lists Gladys Swenson as the owner.
