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ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Any evidence of milk cow stanchions or horse stalls has been removed. Roof has been shingled with asphalt shingles. Large hayloft door has been framed in and sided to match rest of barn. Windows added at top of this door for light in hayloft. Metal cupola has been removed.

INTERIOR NOTES: Has three rows of 6x6 posts with (3) 2x8's for a beam. Floor joists are 2x8's. Solid 2x6 wall divides North 28' from the South 26'. Some walls still in place for horse stalls, but not enough evidence to know layout. Some of the walls appear to have been remodeled using existing material.

OTHER NOTES: 2x6 stud walls with sheathing and 1/2"x6" cedar lap siding. Rafters are site built from 3/4" x 1-3/4" four ply. These are 2' O.C. Another rafter is site built from 3/4" x 12" about 9'-6" long, four plies thick. These are 6' O.C. Windows are 8"x10" four light over 8"x10" four light, except for four on the South wall and two on the East wall, which are 8"x10" four light.

***PHYSICAL NOTES:** Barn is in very good condition. Owners plan on painting the barn in 2013. Roof will need re-roofing soon. Owners plan on putting steel roofing on roof.

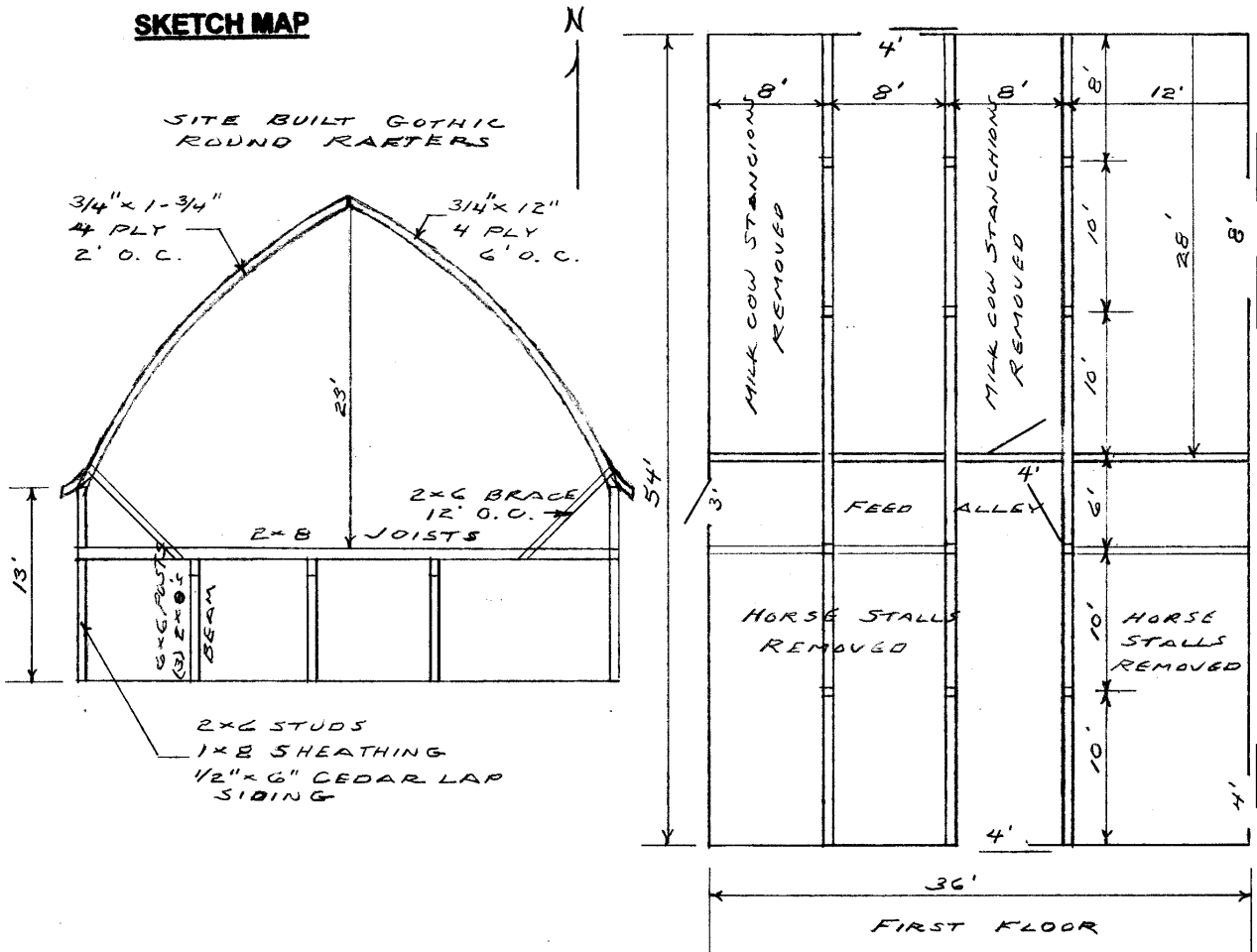

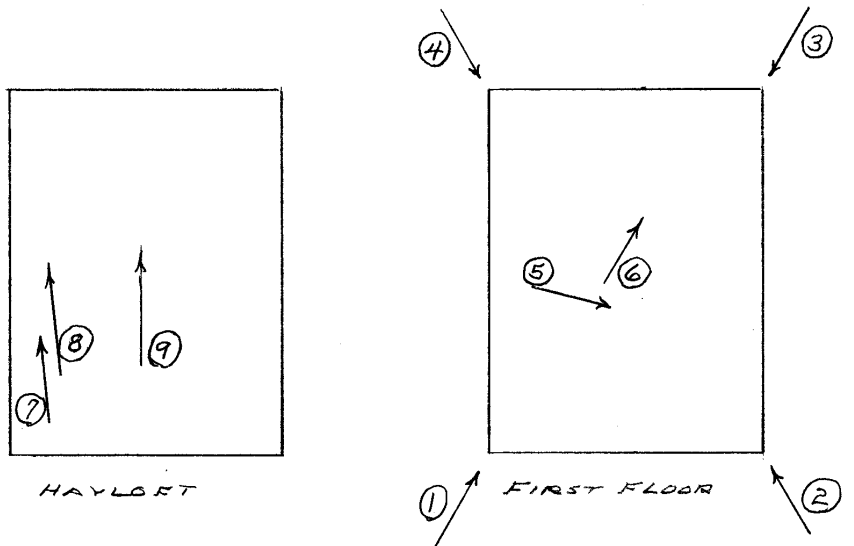
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SKETCH MAP

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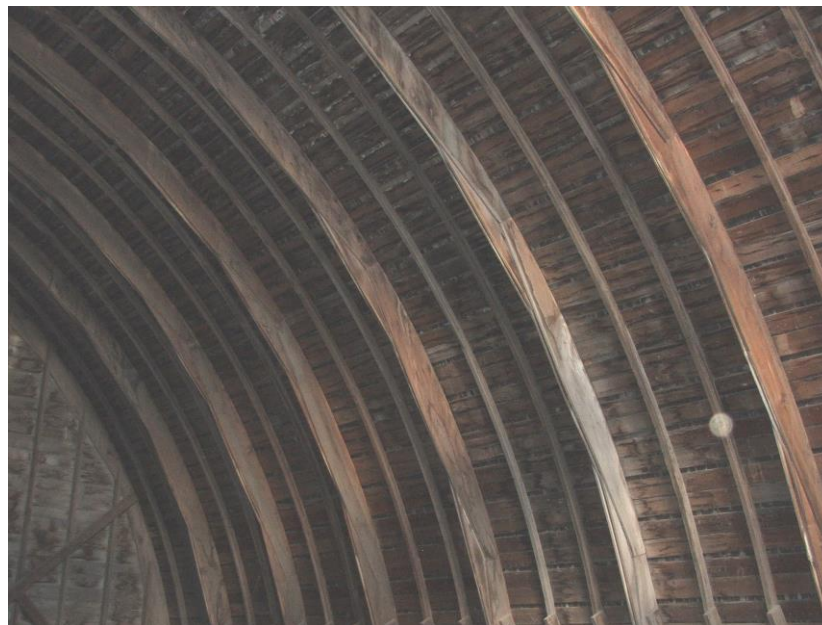

four ply 1x12, 6' O. C.



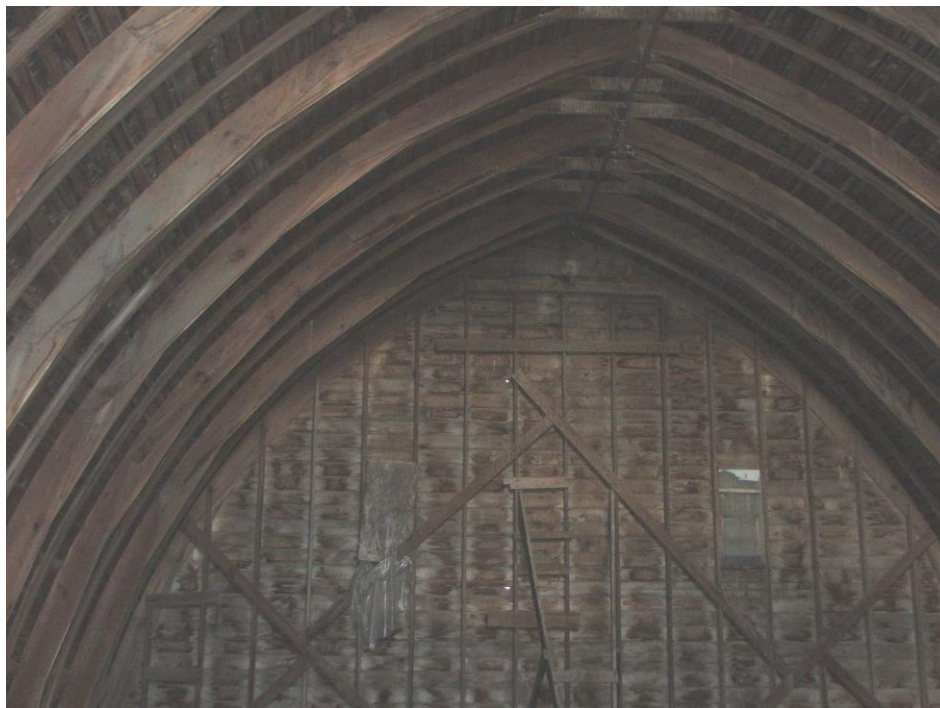

note 2' O.C. and 6' O. C.

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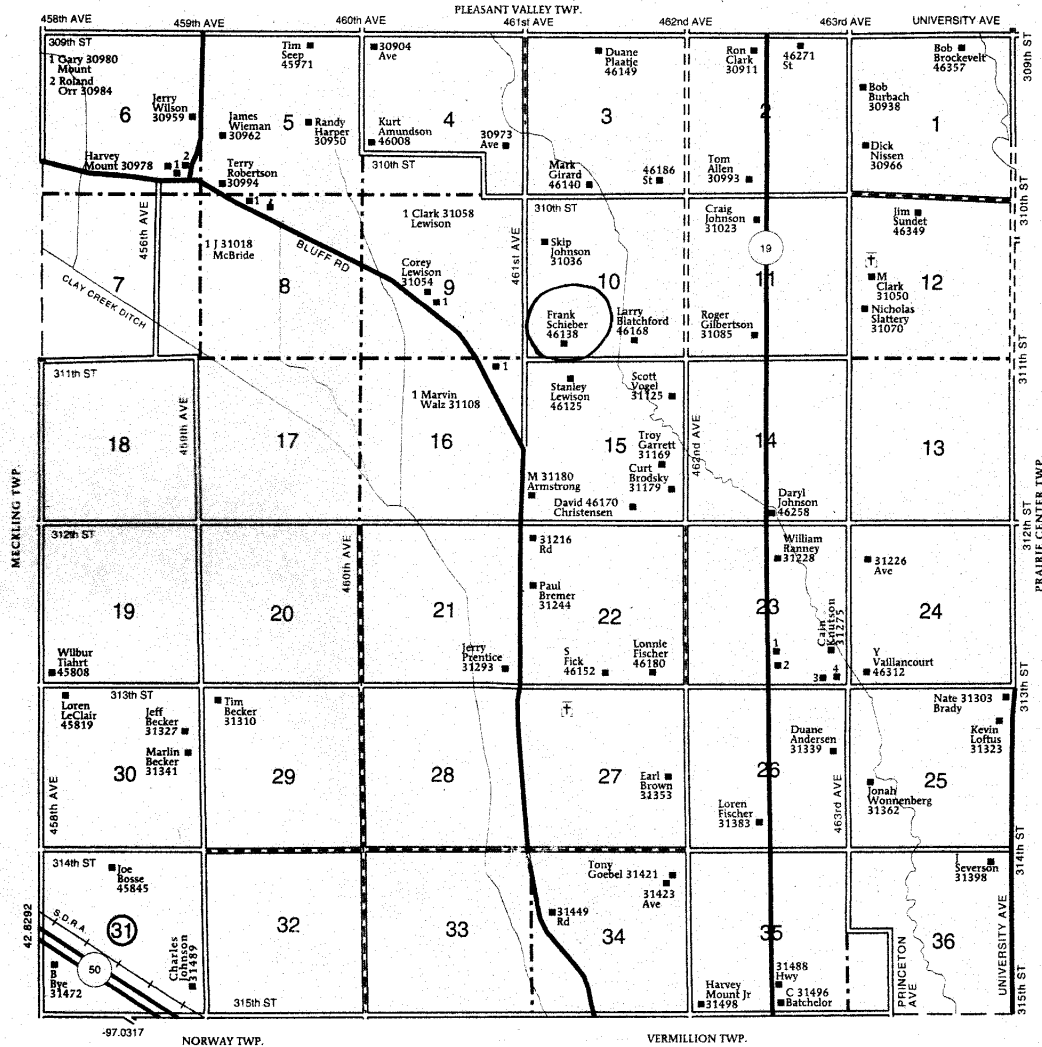

HISTORY

This farm located in the SW ¼ of Section 10, Spirit Mound Township, Clay County was homesteaded by John Anderson.

The 1894 Clay county Atlas lists D. C. Shull as the owner.

The 1901, 1912, 1924 and 1937 Clay County Atlas lists Christian Nelson as the owner.

The 1948 Clay County Atlas lists Anna Nelson as the owner.

The 1956 Clay County Atlas lists J. H. Hood as the owner.

Christian (Chris) Nelson would have built or had this barn built.

Christian Nelson is a (first generation Norwegian). His parents immigrated to the United States and he was born in the United States.

His daughter married John Hood and they lived here and farmed for several years.
