ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Wood farrowing pens removed. Pits were installed and  
owner replaced the wood pens with farrowing crates. Roof covered with steel roofing.  
18' x 48' lean-to added on the West side. Two metal cupola's removed when steel roofing was  
installed.

INTERIOR NOTES: All of the wood pens removed. Two rows of 4x4 posts have been removed and  
replaced with adjustable steel posts to support the 4x6 beams. Two rows of 4x4 posts 8' O. C. with  
two 2x4's for a beam support the roof hip. Four 10' x 8' granaries in North end of hayloft.

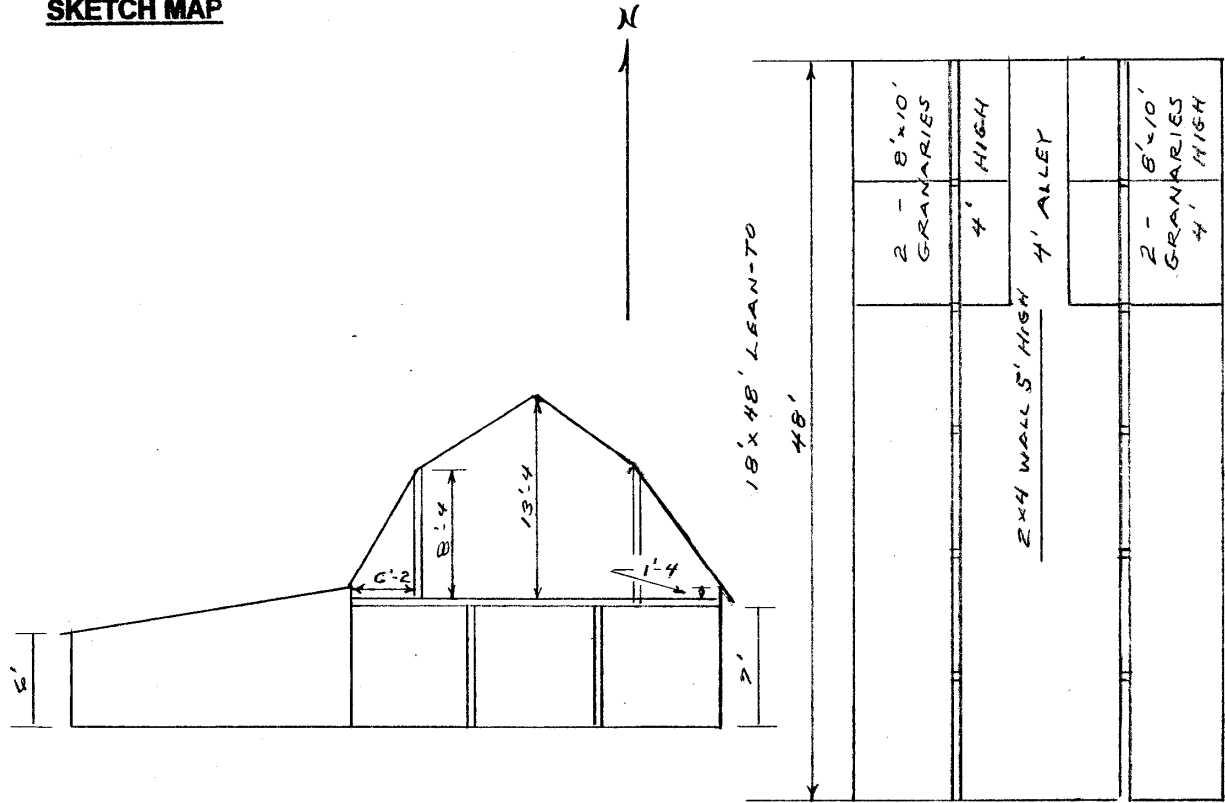
OTHER NOTES: East and West walls are 2x4 stud walls 9' high. The North and South walls are 2x4  
stud walls ballooned framed. 1x6 Pattern #106 drop siding on all walls. 4"x24" four light windows.  
Two rafter spaces below each cupola are boarded up to create a chimney to draw air from the first  
floor for ventilation.

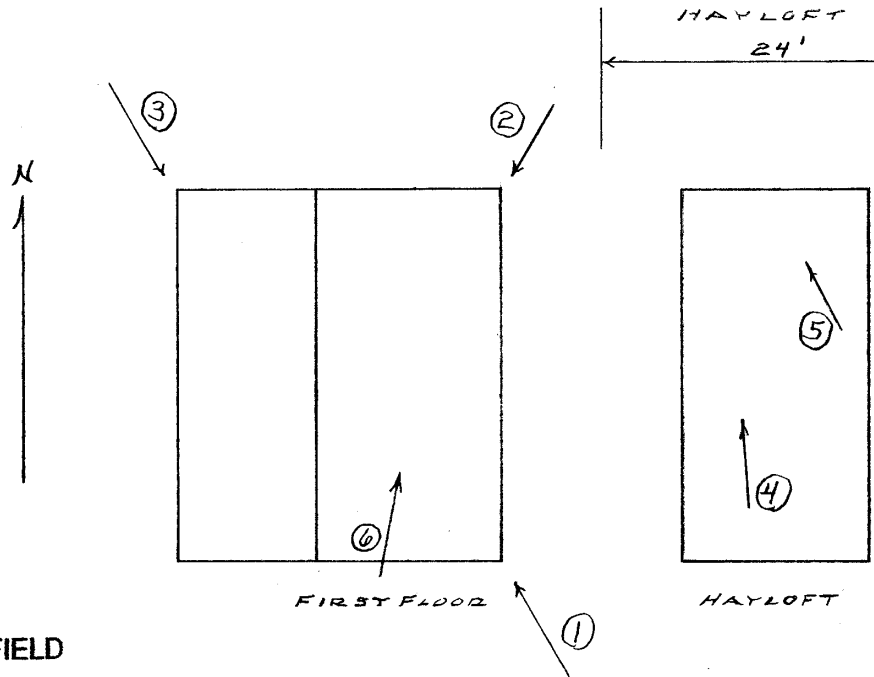
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**SKETCH MAP**

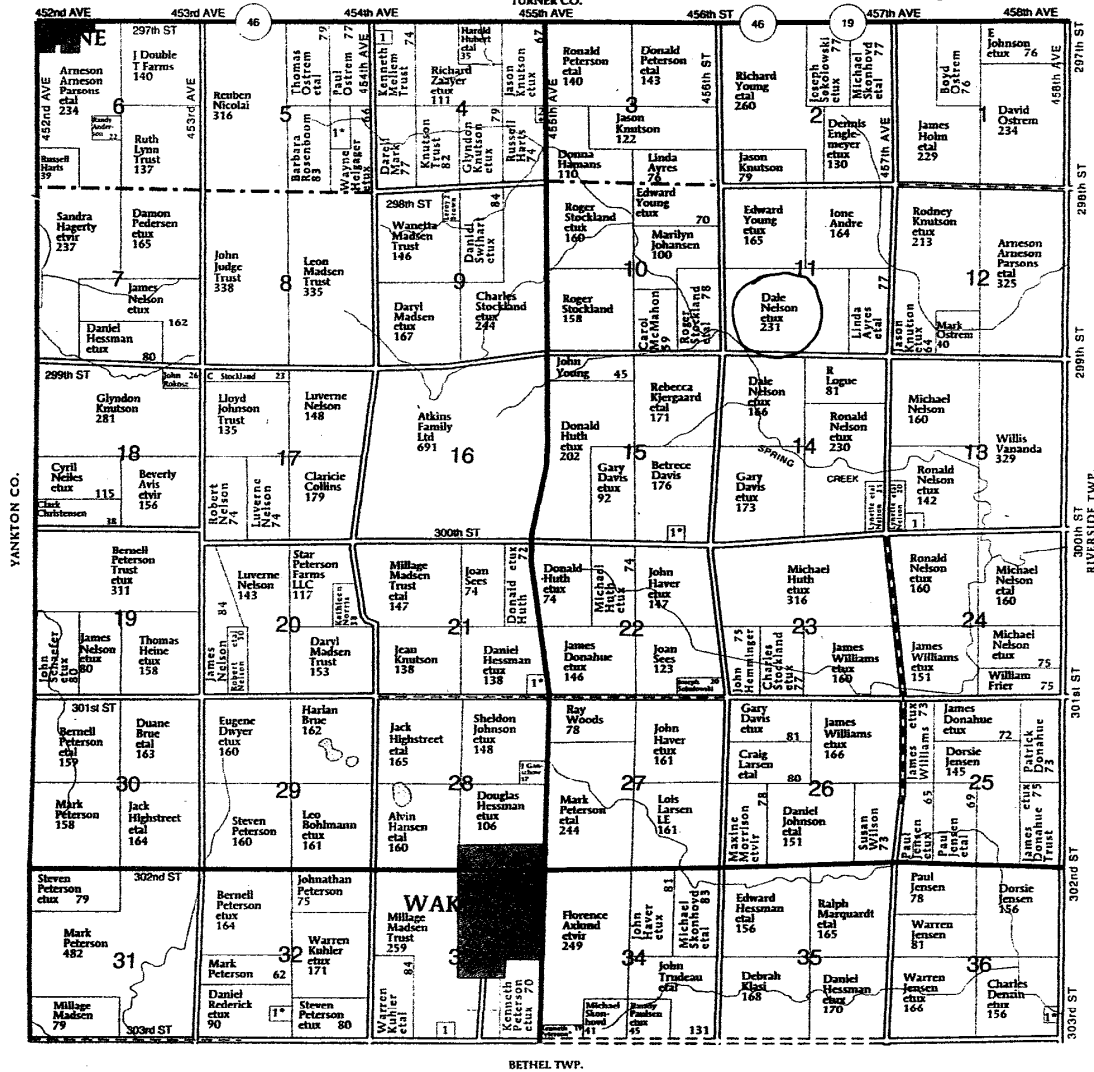
