ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Any evidence of milk cow stanchions or horse stalls has been removed. Roof has been covered with steel roofing. Walls have been covered with vertical steel roofing. Concrete foundation and floor appears to have been poured later.

INTERIOR NOTES: Has two rows of 6x6 posts, with 6x6 for a beam. 2x6 floor joists for hayloft floor. 4x4 posts 8' O.C. in hayloft that slant up from posts and beam under floor to about 3' below hip. (2) 1x6's brace each hip. 2x6 brace 8' O.C. center of top rafter down to bottom of lower rafter. (2) 1x6's brace rafters down to bottom of wall in hayloft floor. These are centered between 4x4 posts.

OTHER NOTES: 2x6 stud walls with 1x6 #106 drop siding and vertical steel roofing. Studs are 16" O. C. All 2x4 rafters, 2x6 studs, floor joists, bracing 4x6 sills and 6x6's are rough sawn cottonwood. Windows are 14"x20" two lights wide and appear to have been added a later date. Rafters are also 16" O. C. 6x6 posts in North and South walls to support ends of 6x6 beams. 2x6 and 2x4 beams support rafters 3' down from hip.

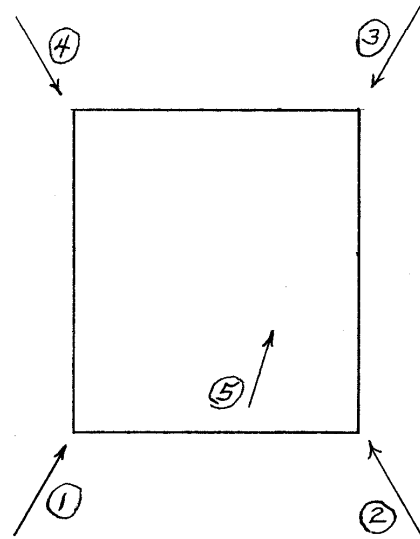
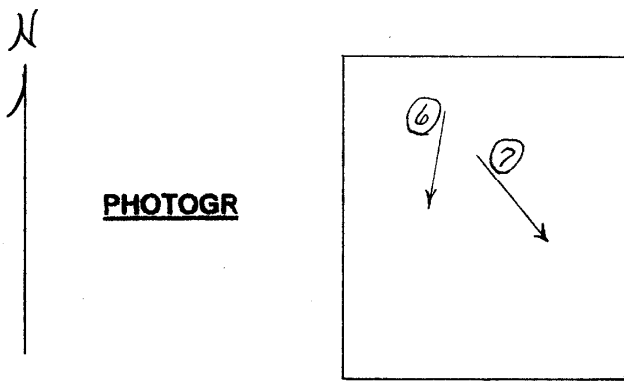

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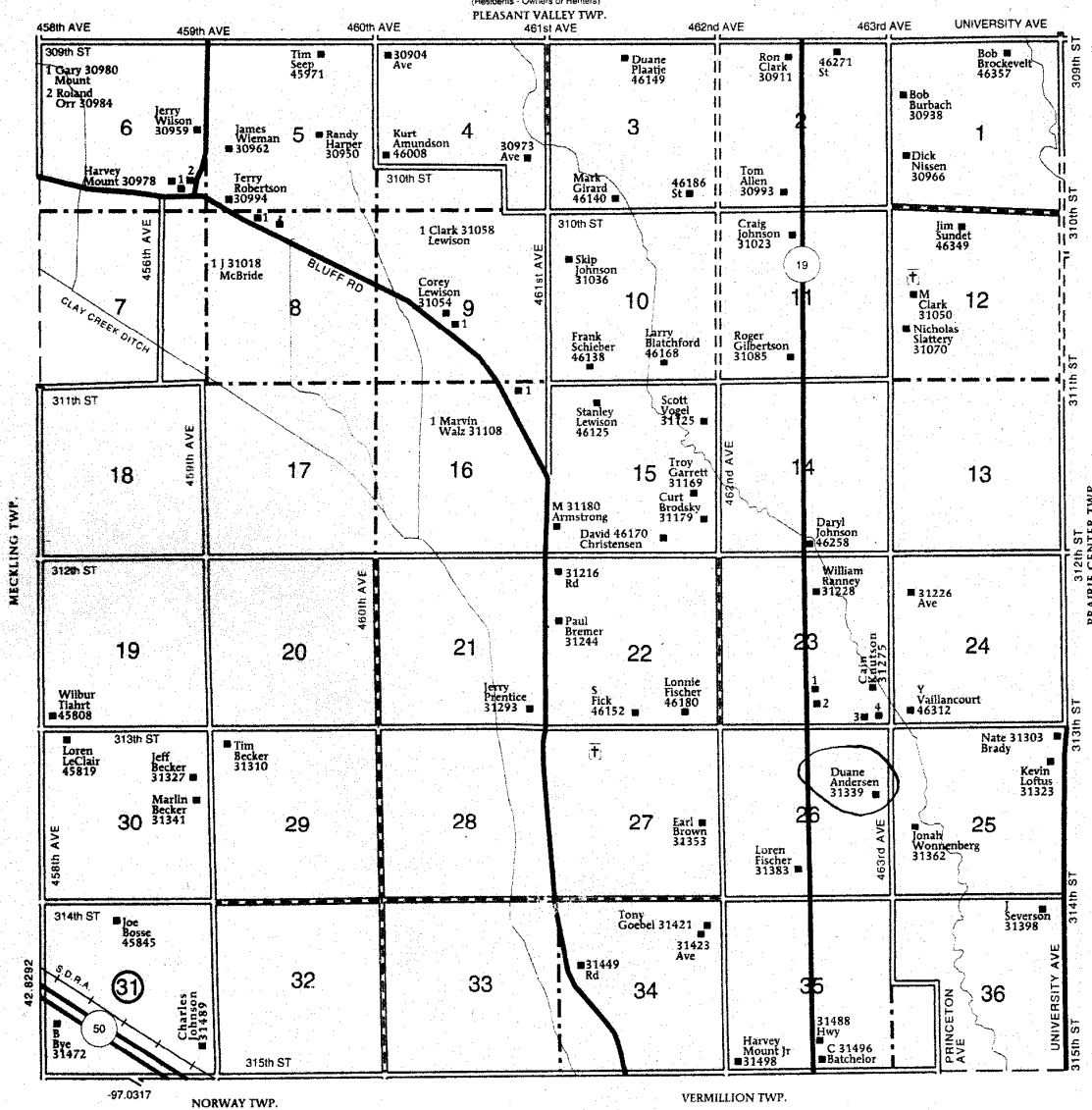
