ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. 8' x 12' granary added in NE corner of hayloft. Steel roofing over cedar shingles on roof. Horizontal steel roofing over sheathing on walls. Old siding removed. 8' sliding door on North wall has been framed in.

INTERIOR NOTES: <u>Two rows of 4x6 posts and 4x6 beams</u>. 2x6 floor joists for hayloft floor. 8' x 12' granary in the SW corner of hayloft, may have been added later.


OTHER NOTES: 2x6 stud walls with 1x8 horizontal sheathing on all four walls and horizontal steel roofing. Rafters are three ply, 1x8 cedar, 2x8 and 1x8 cedar all 5' – 2-1/2" long. These laminated round rafters were site built. 24 - 9"x12" four light windows. Steel roofing applied horizontally on the roof over the old cedar shingles.







Hayloft, looking NE, 1x8-2x8-1x8 3 ply site built CAMERA DIRECTION: round laminated rafters.






