ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. East and West lean-to's have been added later.

INTERIOR NOTES: All doors were latched from the interior except two doors with padlocks. I could not see the interior. I did crack two doors enough to see some detail. The center barn is the original barn and has rough sawn cottonwood 2x6 studs and 2x8 floor joists. The East lean-to has milled 2x4 studs and 2x6 rafters .

OTHER NOTES: Center barn has 2x6 studs with sheathing, both are rough sawn cottonwood. The East lean-to has milled 2x4 studs and 2x6 rafters with 1x8 sheathing. 1/2"x6" cedar lap siding on all exterior walls. Rafters on original barn are 2x6's. West lean-to is 2' lower to fit the slope of the land. It has 9' side walls.

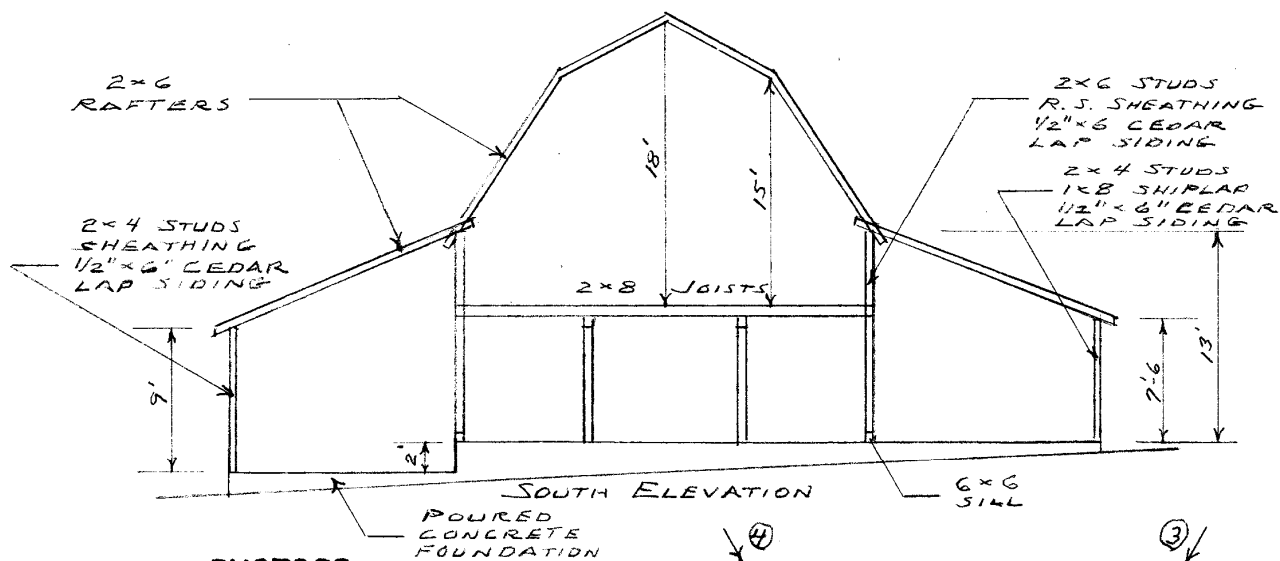

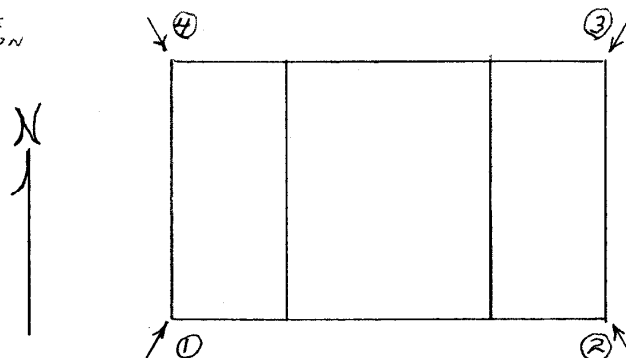

The 1912 and 1924 Clay County Atlas lists Eli Lewison as the owner.

The 1937 Clay County Atlas lists Eli Lewison as the owner and J. Schenepp as the operator (renter).

The 1948 and 1956 Clay County Atlas lists Ellen Mayem as the owner.
