ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Milk cow stanchions have been removed. One double horse stall removed.

INTERIOR NOTES: Has three rows of 6x6 posts with 4x6 for beams. 2x10 floor joists. Granary and three double horse stalls still in place. One double horse stall and the milk cow stanchions have been removed.

OTHER NOTES: 2x6 stud walls with 1x8 sheathing and 1/2"x6" cedar lap siding. Rafters are 2x6 with 2x6 bracing on each rafter at the hip. Two 2x6 for a plate at the hip. 2x6 bracing 6' O.C. from center of lower rafters down to the floor and from the top of wall down to the floor. Two short 1x10's bracing at hip and at bottom of lower rafter and top of the wall. Very ornate metal cupola. 9"x12" four light windows. This barn is very well proportioned. Width of barn to the height of walls and the roof are very pleasing architecturally.

\*PHYSICAL NOTES: Barn is in fair condition. Needs roofing now. Some siding is missing at the bottom of walls. Doors and windows need repair. Concrete foundation is crumbling in a few places.

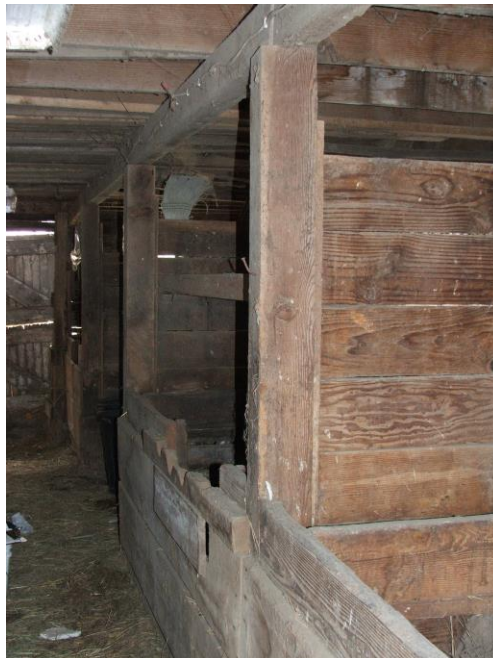

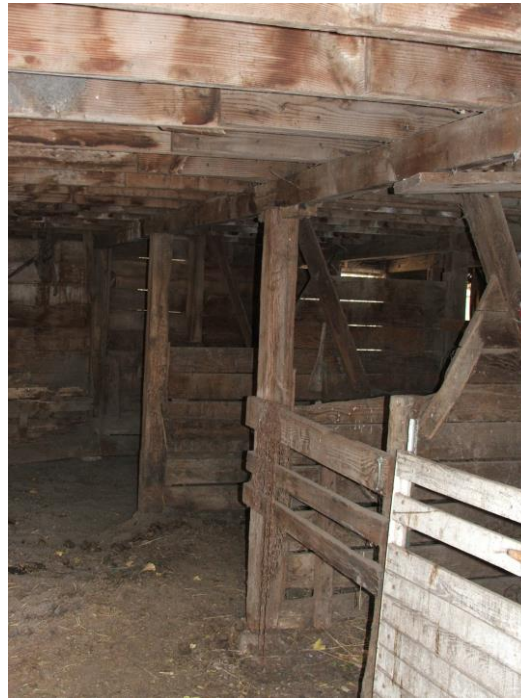

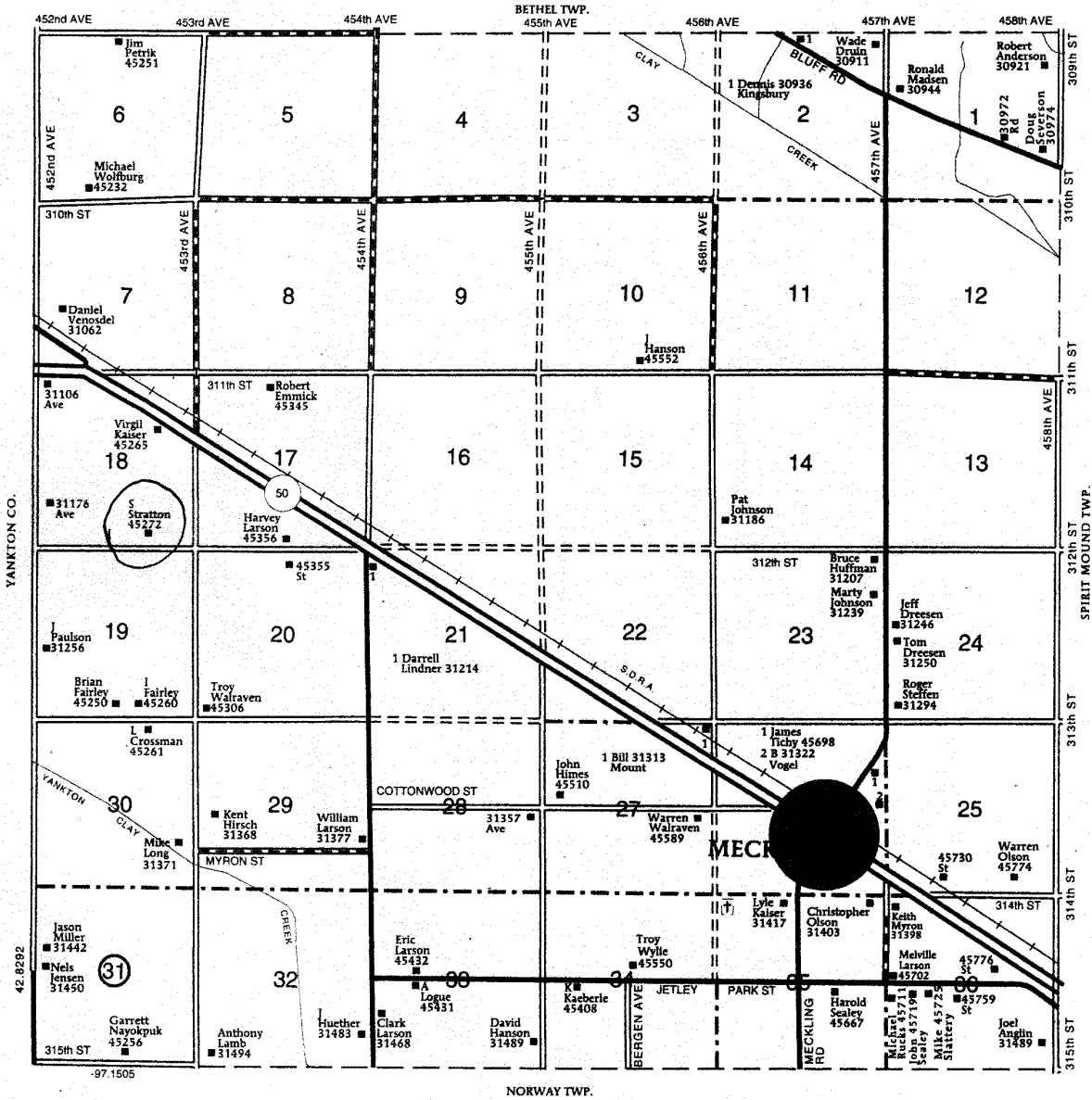

## **HISTORY**

Nathan Worley homesteaded this land. He actually homesteaded the S ½ of the SE ¼ and the S1/2 of the SW1/4 all in Section 18, Meckling Township.

Eric Lunde bought this farm in 1890. The barn was built between 1890 and 1900.

The 1901 Clay County Atlas lists Eric Lunde as the land owner.

The 1912 Clay County Atlas lists the owner as Eric Lunde Estate.

The 1924, 1937, 1948 and 1956 Clay County Atlas lists Ingrid Lunde (Mrs. Eric Lunde) as the owner. The 1937 Atlas lists A. Lunde as the operator (renter).
