ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Horse stalls have been removed, but one complete stall is still on the West side.

INTERIOR NOTES: Two rows of 6x6 posts and 6x6's for beams. Floor joists for the hayloft floor are 2x8's. Three granaries on the West wall. These granaries are all 10' East to West, two are 8' North to South and the North granary is 14'. These granaries are 13' high and extend into the hayloft 6'.

OTHER NOTES: The East and North walls are 6" x 8' poured concrete. The South and West walls and above concrete walls on the East and North are 2x6 stud walls, 1x8 diagonal sheathing and 1/2" x 6" cedar lap siding. Rafters are 2x6's with a 2x6x4' brace at the hip and a 2x6 brace from top of wall down to the floor 10' O. C. Barn had no cupola. 10' x 11' double sliding doors at ground level into hayloft.

*PHYSICAL NOTES: Barn is in fair condition. A section of the North concrete wall has fell in.

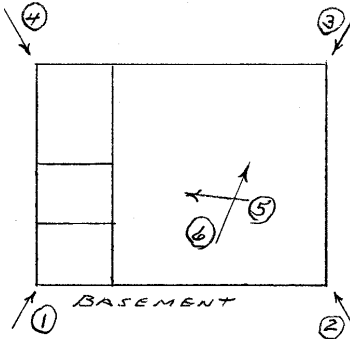
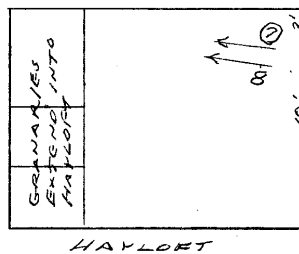
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SKETCH MAP

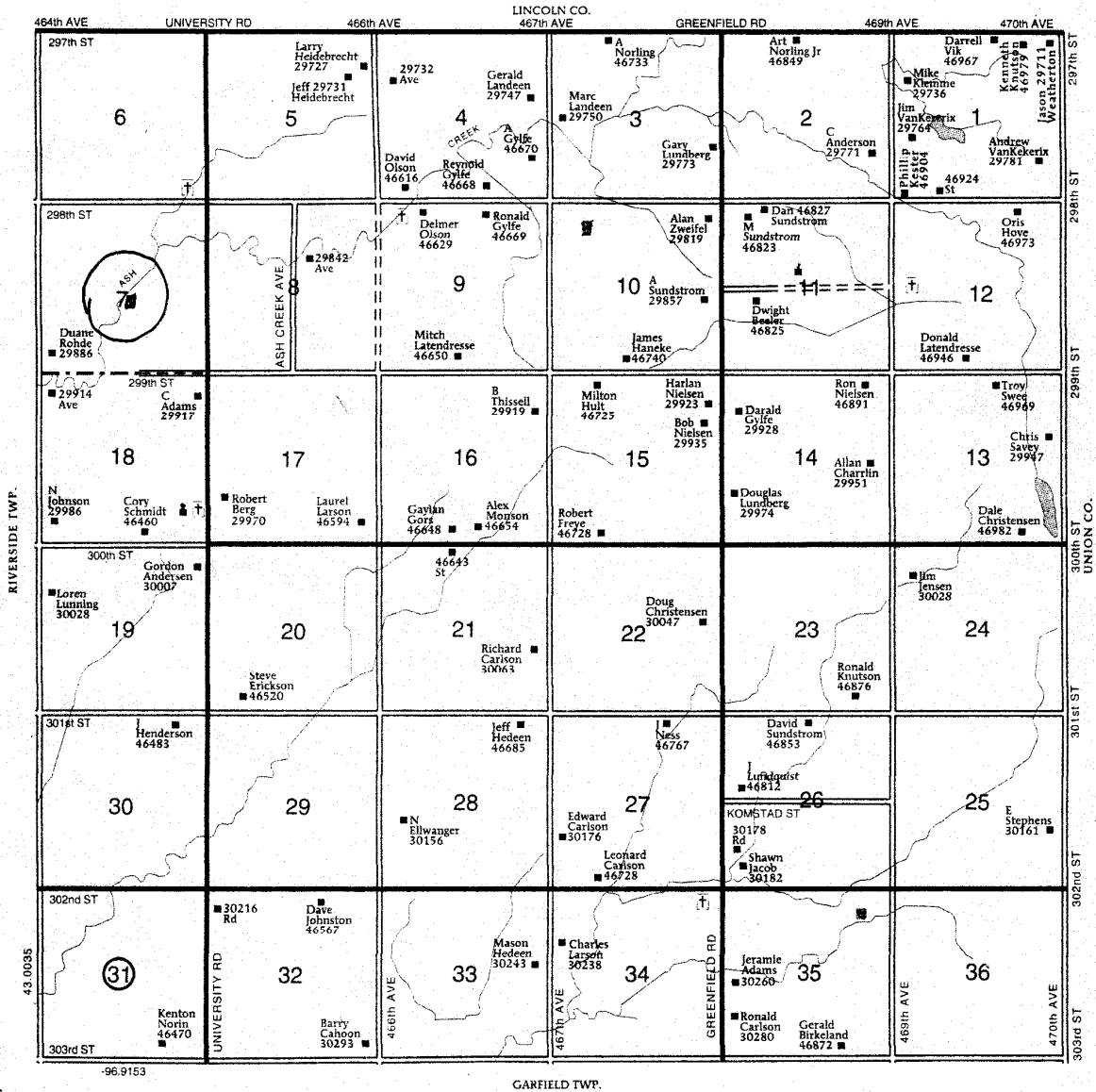
