ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Lean-to added to the West and North sides. Foundation is poured concrete on the West lean-to and North addition. A lot of the 1x6 siding has been replaced with 1x8 shiplap. Roof has asphalt shingles over the cedar shingles.


INTERIOR NOTES: <u>Horse powered elevator.</u> Grain leg has a moveable spout at the top to direct grain to multiple grain bins.

OTHER NOTES: Walls are 2x4 with 1x6 #106 drop siding, but most of the siding has been replaced with 1x8 shiplap.

*PHYSICAL NOTES: <u>Elevator / granary is in good condition. The tilting floor for the wagon unloader</u> and the horse powered grain leg are being restored. Some of the sliding doors need some maintenance. Power will be an electric motor.








1 CAMERA DIRECTION: Looking NE, SW corner







HISTORY

This farm located in the S ¹/₂ of the NE ¹/₄ of Section 21, Fairview Township, Clay County was homesteaded by Franklin Taylor.

The 1894 Clay County Atlas lists Franklin Taylor as the owner.

The 1901 Clay County Atlas lists W. A. Ufford as the owner.

The 1912 Clay County Atlas lists Franklin Taylor as the owner.

The 1924, 1937, 1948 and 1956 Clay County Atlas lists Margaret E. Ufford as the owner and the farm was called "Wayside Farm". It was a stopping place in the horsepower and wagon days. They had a scale to weigh grain or livestock and they bought and sold grain.
