Two rows of 4x6 posts w/ 6x6 beam to support center of 2x6 rafters in hayloft. Hayloft has 8 foot side walls North & South.

OTHER NOTES: 14 foot by 34 foot lean to on North side, may have been built later, can not tell.



Large hayloft door on the East side. Hay sling track, trolley and rope are still in hayloft.





Jacobson family owned the land and lived here in the 1930's. Ron Nelson owned the land and lived here later. Mrs. Jacobson told the present owners that the barn was built in 1922.

This farm located in the SE ¼ of Section 15, Bethel Township, Clay County was homesteaded by Jadhah Shooley.

The 1894 and 1901 Clay County Atlas lists Charles R. Grange as the owner.

The 1912 and 1924 Clay County Atlas lists George Jacobson as the owner.

The 1937 Clay County Atlas lists Iowa Joint Stock/Land Bank as the owner.

The 1948 and 1956 Clay County Atlas lists W. H. Jarmuth as the owner.
