

steel roofing. Horse stalls have been removed. Milk cow stanchions have been removed, but feed trough is still in place. Some of the 4x6 posts have been replaced with round posts.

INTERIOR NOTES: Has one row 4x6 posts and a 4x6 for the first 16' on South and two 2x6's North for a									
beam. Floor joists are 2x6's. All evidence of horse stalls is gone. Milk cow stanchions have been									
removed, but the feed trough is still in place. 4' x 12' granary is still in place in the SE corner.									
OTHER NOTES: All of the lumber, 4x6's, 2x4's, 2x6's, wall and roof sheathing is rough sawn									
cottonwood, except the 2x6 floor joists, which are milled lumber. Walls are 2x4, which appear to be used									
studs, with horizontal sheathing and ½" x 8" cedar lap siding. Rafters are 2x6 with sheathing, cedar									
Shingles and with 26" galvanized corrigated steel roofing. Windows are 9"x12" four light.									
*PHYSICAL NOTES: Barn is in good condition. Needs some work and needs tie bracing at the top of									
the East and West walls, which are bowing out slightly. Janet Beeman painted a barn quilt on the East									
gable end. No history on the design, just a design that Janet picked out. Janet is an art teacher in the Vermillion Public Schools.



This farm located in the NE ¼ of Section 5, Prairie Center Township, Clay County was homesteaded by Anders Johnson.

The 1894 Clay County Atlas lists N. L. Hoyne as the owner.

The 1901 Clay County Atlas lists August Hedlin as the owner.

The 1912, 1924 and 1937 Clay County Atlas lists Hans Christenson as the owner. The 1937 Atlas also lists G. Christenson as the operator (renter).

The 1948 and 1956 Clay County Atlas lists G. M. Christenson as the owner.
