





#### **History**

This farm located in the SW ¼ of the SE ¼ of Section 22, Prairie Center Township, Clay County was homesteaded by Jens Julius Hoestendahl. He homesteaded the whole SE 1/4

The 1894 Clay County Atlas lists Jens Julius Hoestendahl as the owner.

The 1901 Clay County Atlas lists Hans J. Hvestendahl as the owner.

The 1912 Clay County Atlas lists Jens J. Huestendahl as the owner.

The 1924 Clay County Atlas lists P. C. Huestendahl as the owner. (note differences in spelling, might be the same family, just changed the spelling or it was recorded in error.)

The 1937 and 1948 Clay County Atlas lists J. W. Mahan as the owner.

The 1956 Clay County Atlas lists J. M. Erickson as the owner.
