


INTERIOR NOTES: Walls and ceiling covered in original barn. 2x6 studs extend 4-1/2' into hayloft. Hay track and slings still in hayloft. ³/₄" sheathing is diagonal on gable ends, horizontal on the East and West sides. !/2x6" Cedar lap siding on exterior walls.

OTHER NOTES: <u>Quilt pattern recently added on North side.</u> Quilt pattern from Donna Henriksen's grandmother called "Star Burst"




