ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Roof has been shingles with asphalt shingles. 1/2"x6" cedar lap siding has been added over the original 1x6 drop siding. Cupola removed when the barn was re-shingled.

INTERIOR NOTES: Has two rows 2x6 (spaced with short 2x6's or sides of stalls) posts and (3) 2x8's for beams to support hayloft floor. Floor joists are 2x8's. Has a staircase up to the hayloft. The 11'x14' milk room still in place. Horse stalls and milk cow stanchions are still in place.

OTHER NOTES: Windows were 9"x12" four light. Walls are 2x6 with 1x6 drop siding and 1x2"x6" cedar lap siding. Rafters are 2x6 with no bracing. 4x6 posts support the hip. Two 2x6's for a plate at the hip.

\*PHYSICAL NOTES: Barn is in good condition. The roof is leaking. Needs some repairs on the doors.

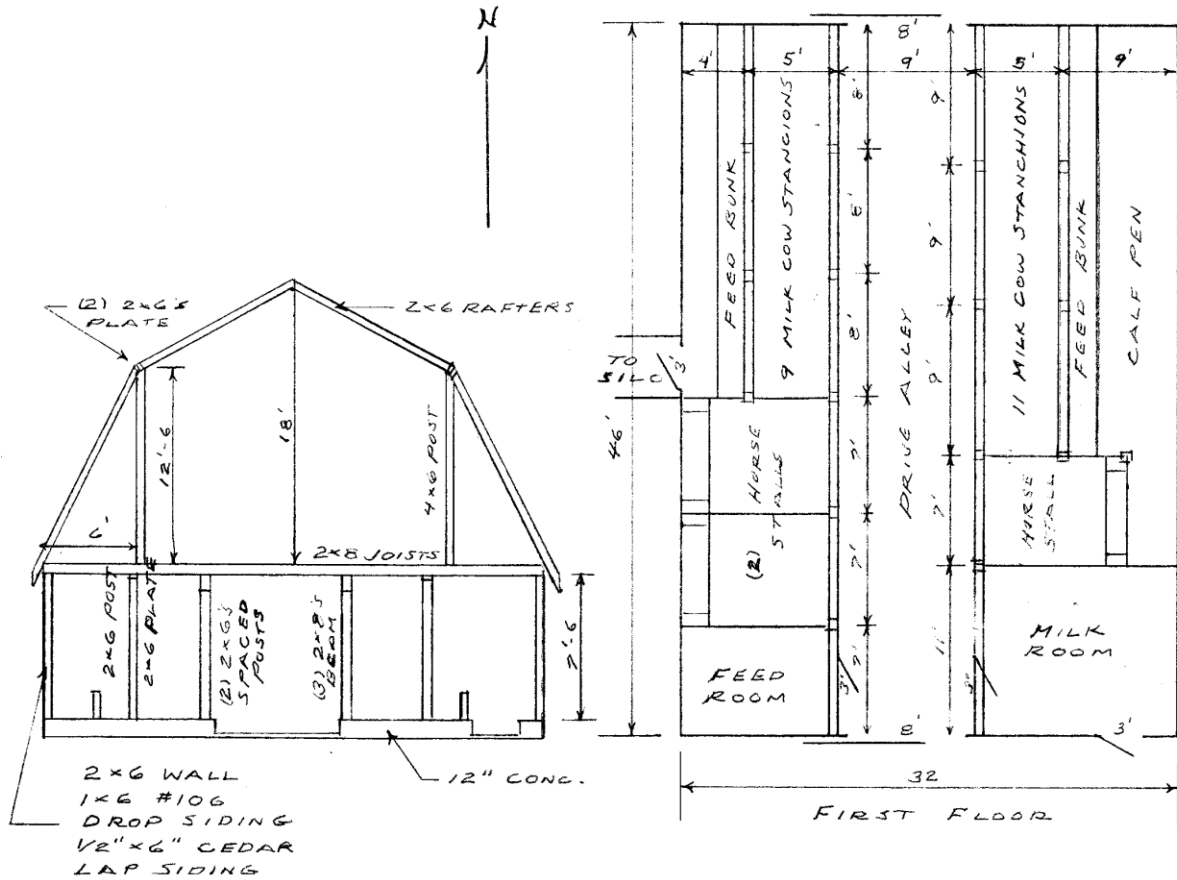

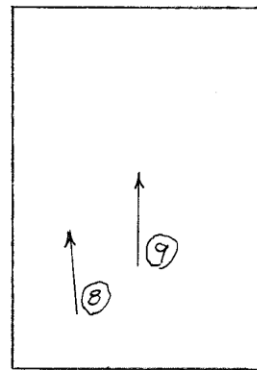

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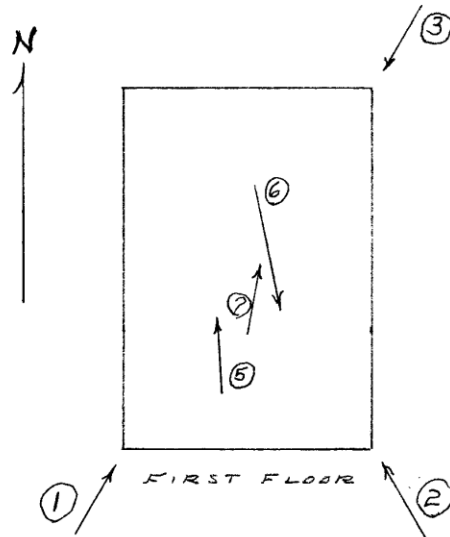
**SKETCH MAP**

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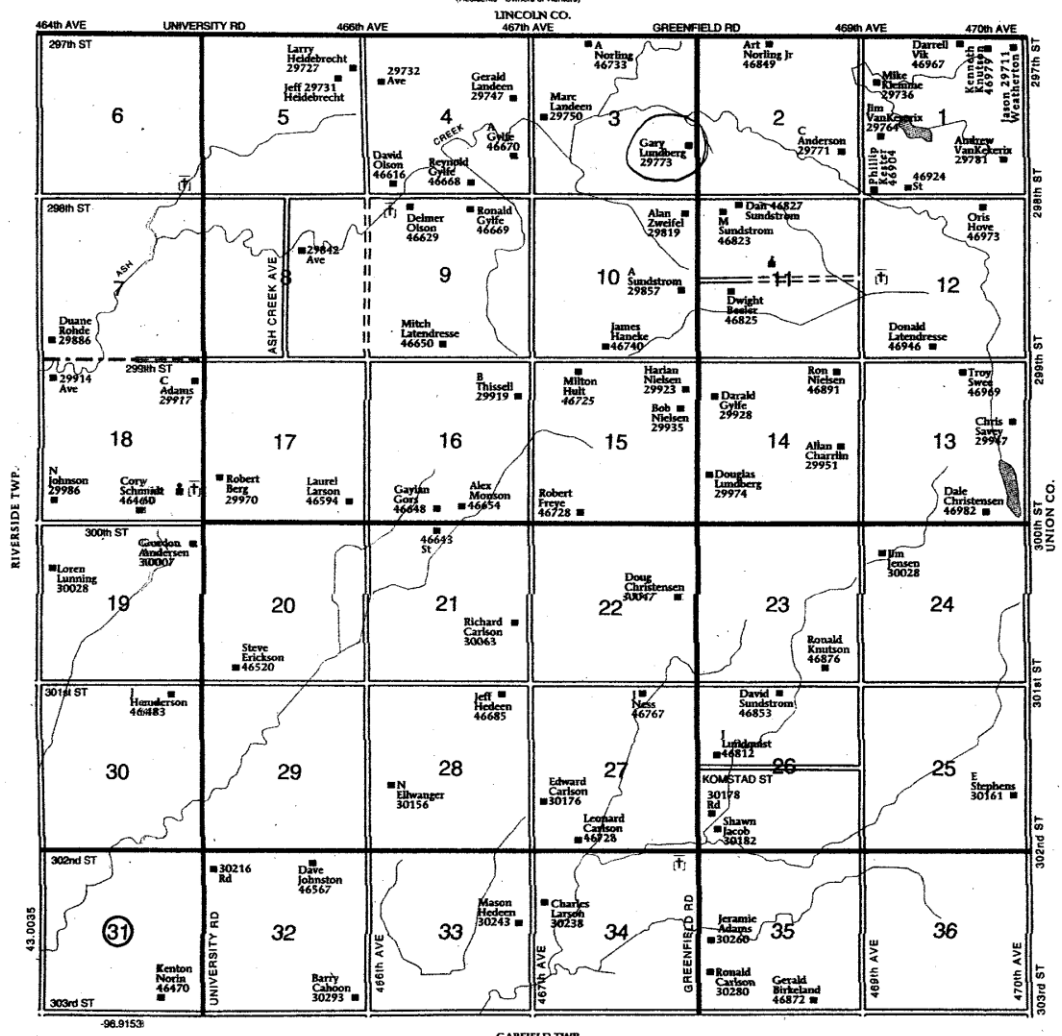
