ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Parts of the horse stalls have been removed. Roof covered steel roofing. Original 1x6 #1x6 drop siding has been covered with 1/2"x6" cedar lap siding.

INTERIOR NOTES: Has two rows of 4x6 posts, with 6x6 for a beam. 2x8 floor joists for hayloft floor. Six milk cow stanchions with feed troughs, granary and calf pen are still in place. Horse stalls have been converted into pens, but some evidence is still visible. Granary extends from first floor up through hayloft floor and 4'-6" into hayloft.

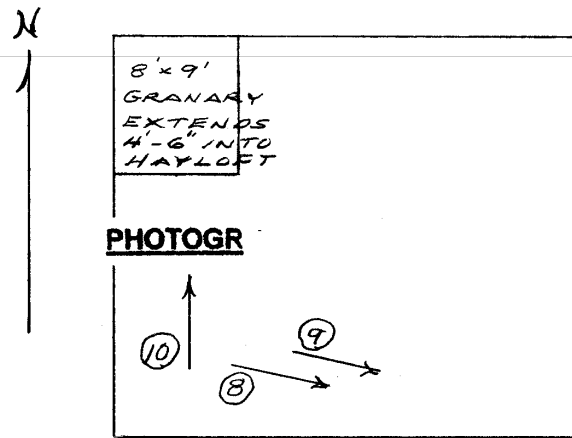
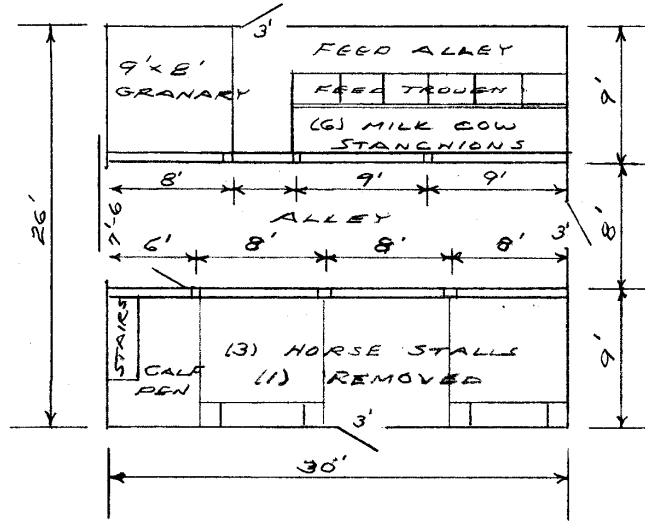
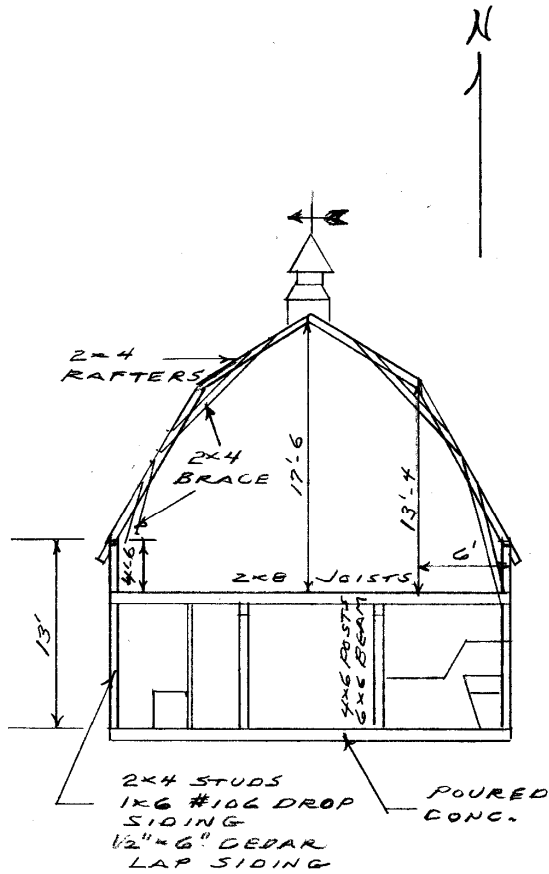
OTHER NOTES: 2x4 stud walls with 1x6 #106 drop siding and 1/2"x6" cedar lap siding added later. 2x4 rafters with 2x4 bracing from center of lower rafter down to bottom of wall in hayloft and 2x4 brace at hip on each rafter, 2' O. C.. Windows are 9"x12" four light. Small metal cupola.

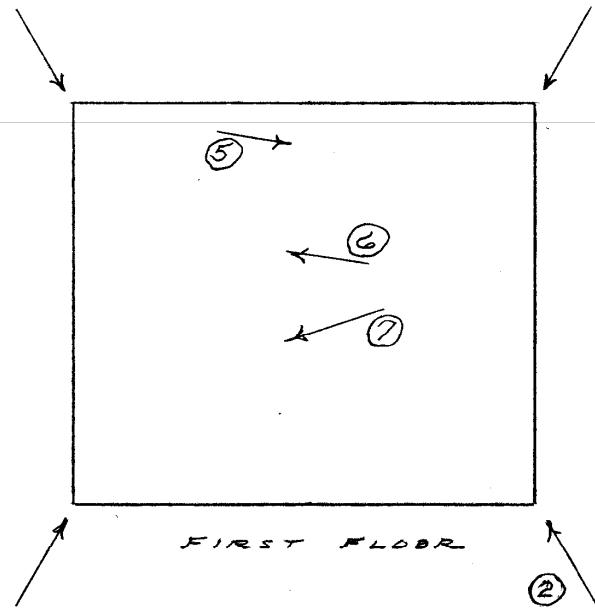

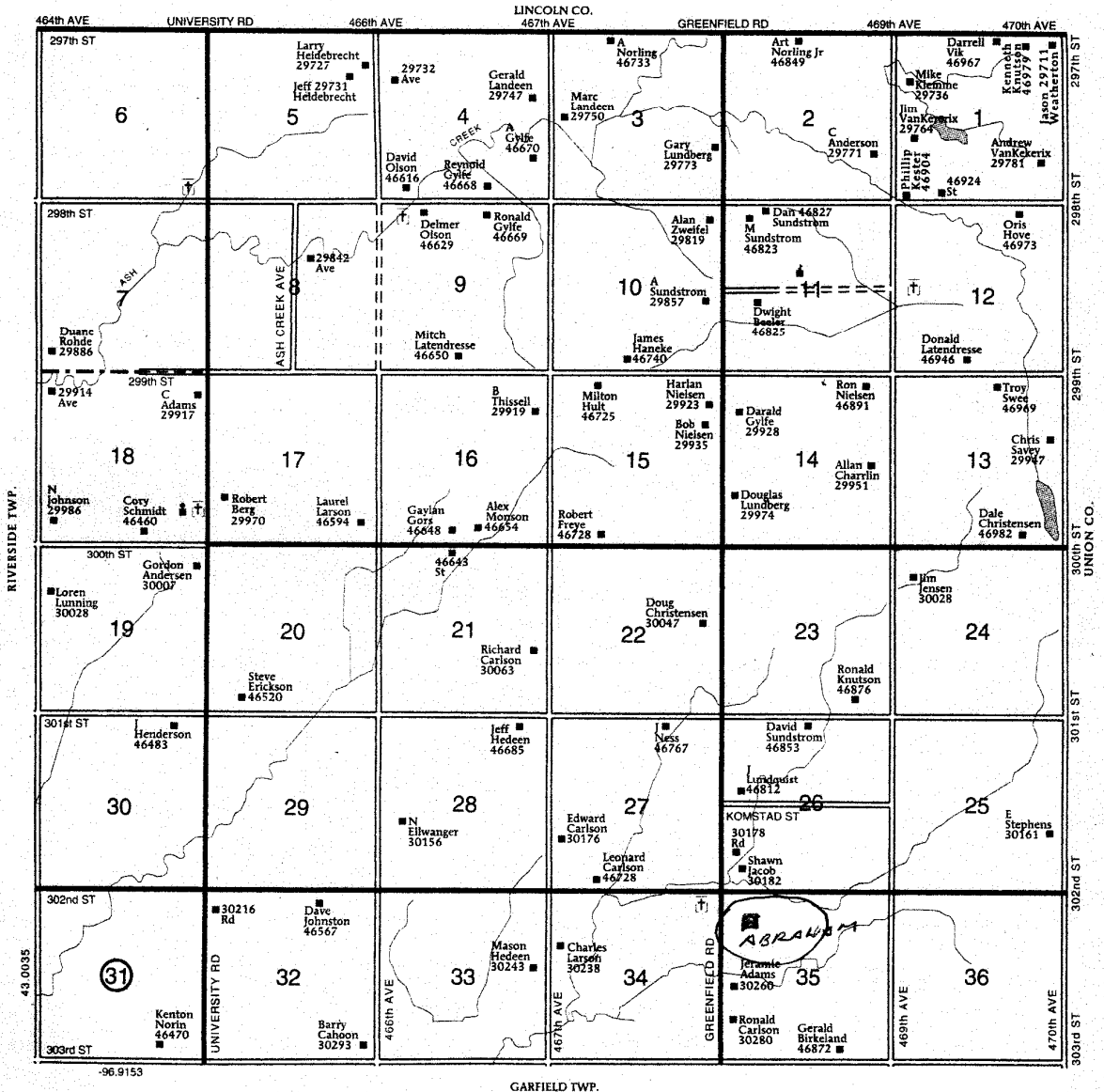

The 1894 Clay County Atlas lists P. Brannan as the owner.

The 1901 Clay County Atlas lists Martha Westberg as the owner.

The 1912 and 1924 Clay County Atlas lists Herman Westberg as the owner. It is very likely that Herman Westberg built or had this barn built.

The 1937 Clay County Atlas lists A. E. Odeen as the owner.

The 1948 Clay County Atlas lists Anna Odeen as the owner.

The 1956 Clay County Atlas lists Win Abraham as the owner.

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
