



The 1901 Clay County Atlas lists J. F. S. Harvey as the owner.

The 1912 Clay County Atlas lists Ira S. Myron as the owner.

The 1924 Clay County Atlas lists J. E. Davis as the owner. The farm was named the "Walnut Grove Farm".

The 1937 Clay County Atlas lists L. Ellison as the owner.

The 1948 and 1956 Clay County Atlas lists M. L. Ellison as the owner.
