

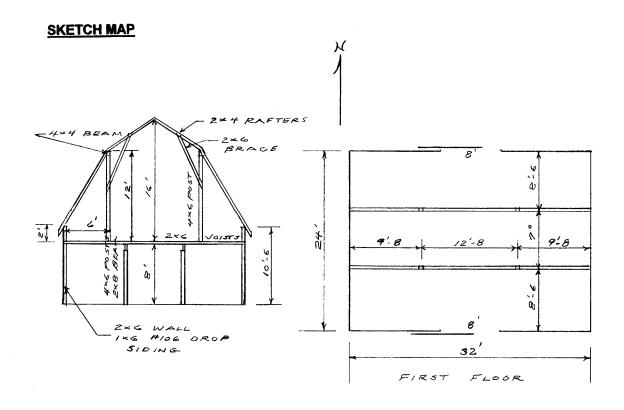

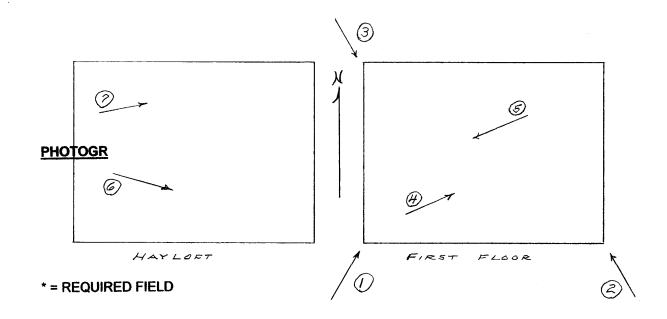

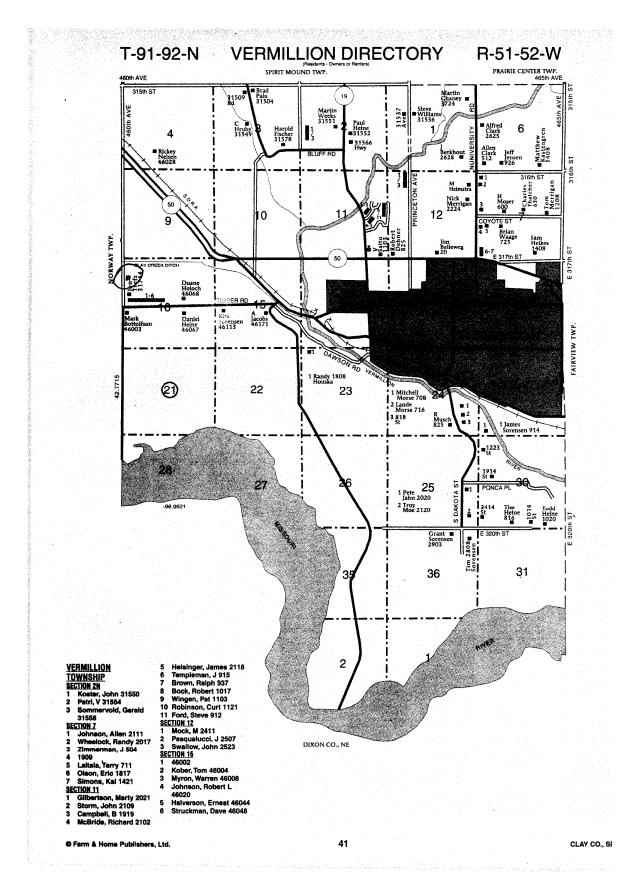

#### **HISTORY**

Section 16 was a School Section and could not be homesteaded. Any rent or sales of any part of this Section went to a county fund for rural schools.

The 1894 Clay County Atlas lists Ole Thompte as the owner.

The 1901, 1912 and 1924 Clay County Atlas lists Julia Hanson as the owner.

The 1937 Clay County Atlas lists Mrs. Anna Hanson as the owner and M. R. Hanson as the operator (renter).

The 1948 Clay County Atlas lists Anna Hanson as the owner.

The 1956 Clay County Atlas lists M. K. Hanson as the owner.

Iver Iverson immigrated from Homre, Norway. He was born Oct. 22, 1860 in Norway. He had two brothers who had immigrated earlier and changed their last name to Hanson, so Iver changed his last name to Hanson.

He married Anne Larson from Quandahl, Iowa. She was born July 2, 1866 and died October 23, 1947.

Their children were Albert Hanson, Martin Hanson, Sarah (Hanson) Gray, Ludwig Hanson, and Henry Hanson.

Ludwig (Lud) Hanson was born December 19, 1905, in Norway Township, Vermillion, South Dakota. He died October 7, 1978, in Yankton South Dakota. He is buried in the Meckling Cemetery.

Ludwig married Andrea C. (?) Hanson, April 19, 1937 at Julesberg, Colorado. She was born June 19, 1898 in Norway Township, Vermillion, South Dakota. She died February 23, 1972 in Norway Township, Vermillion, South Dakota. She is buried in the Meckling Cemetery.

Lud and Andrea lived on this farm. It was owned by Anne Larson, Lud's mother. Lud and Andrea bought the farm from Anne Larson's estate after she died.

Iver (Iverson) Hanson would have built this barn or had it built.
