





ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Any evidence of horse stalls or milk cow stanchions has been							
removed. Hayloft floor removed. Some of the 2x8 the floor joists raised to about 13' and are 8' O. C.							
2x8 joists spliced and brace top of wall up to the opposite hip, 2x6 bracing from the hip down to the raised							
floor joists. 10'-3" x 10'-6" double swing doors added in the south wall of West lean-to. 17' x 12'-9" sliding							
door added on the South wall of original barn. A 13'x 34' lean-to added on the East side later and another							
15'x34' lean-to added on to East side of first lean-to later. Roof covered with steel roofing.							
INTERIOR NOTES: No evidence of posts or beams to support hayloft floor. The hayloft floor joists were							
2x8's. Double 2x6 posts supported hip and are now used to brace the roof. They are cut off at the bottom							
of the raised floor joists.							
OTHER NOTES: 2x6 stud walls, 1x6 #106 drop siding and ½"x 8" cedar lap siding over old siding, on all							
four walls. Rafters are 2x6's. Windows are 9" x12"four light. All of the 2x6's and 2x8's are rough sawn							
cottonwood. The lean-to on the west side appears to have been built at the same as the barn. The first							
lean-to on the East was built later and the second lean-to was added to the first lean-to later still.							
*PHYSICAL NOTES: Barn is in good condition.



HISTORY

This farm located in the SE ¼ of Section 27, Spirit Mound Township, Clay County was homesteaded by Lars L. Dueland.

The 1894 Clay County Atlas lists Rasmus Thorson as the owner.

The 1901 Clay County Atlas lists Thorace M Thorson as the owner.

The 1912, 1924, 1937 and 1948 Clay County Atlas lists Iver Stalheim as the owner.

The 1956 Clay County Atlas lists Andy Stalheim as the owner.

Iver Stalheim Funeral Rites held Monday

Funeral rites for Iver Stalheim, a long time Clay County farmer, were held Monday at the farm home and the Pleasant Valley Lutheran Church. Mr. Stalheim passed away at the Saint Joseph's Hospital at Sioux City last Wednesday afternoon.

Funeral rites were conducted by Rev. A. M. Turmo, with burial in the Bluff View Cemetery. The Elmore-Wagner Funeral home was in charge of the arrangements.

Iver stalheim was born June 14, 1866, in Norway, a son of Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Stalheim. He was united in marriage in January of 1900 to Inger Twite and to this union were born two daughters and one son. Mrs Stalheim passed away January 30, 1947.

Mr. Stalheim was a member of the Pleasant Valley Luthern Church. He was taken to the Sioux City hospital last week.

He is survived by daughters, Mrs. Sena Young and Mrs. Ida Abild of Wakonda, Andrew Stalheim, a son of Spirit Mound Township and a brother Ole of Norway.

Pallbearers for the deceased were Hans Christopherson, Harry Hinchliff, Knute Rygh, Alfred Brunick, Evertt Lewison and Will Hope.
