







The 1894, 1901 and 1912 Clay County Atlas lists J. J. Mortvedt as the owner.

The 1924, 1937 and 1948 Clay County Atlas lists A. J. Mortvedt as the owner and in 1937 lists S. Peterson as the operator (renter).

The 1956 Clay County Atlas lists H. O. Peterson as the owner.
