ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Roof covered with asphalt shingles over cedar shingles. All evidence of milk cow stanchions and horse stalls has been removed. Original 1x8 #106 drop siding covered with 1/2"x6" cedar lap siding later.

INTERIOR NOTES: Two rows of 4x6 posts with 4x6's for beams support 2x 8 joists for hayloft floor. 8' x8' granary still in the SW corner. One row 4x4 posts, 8' O. C., with 4x4 beam supporting 2x6 floor joists, 4' O. C., in North lean-to.

OTHER NOTES: 2x6 stud walls with 1x8 #1x6 drop siding and 1/2"x6" cedar lap siding. Rafters are 2x6's with 2x6 bracing at the roof hip. A 2x6 brace from the center of lower rafter down to hayloft wall at the floor level. This bracing is 2' O. C., which is very unusual. Windows were 8" x10" four light over 8"x 10" four light, double hung. No cupola. 14' x 32' lean-to on the North appears to have been built at the same time as the barn. 2x6 studs, 2x6 rafters and bracing, 2x8 floor joists, 4x6 posts and roof sheathing are all rough sawn cottonwood.

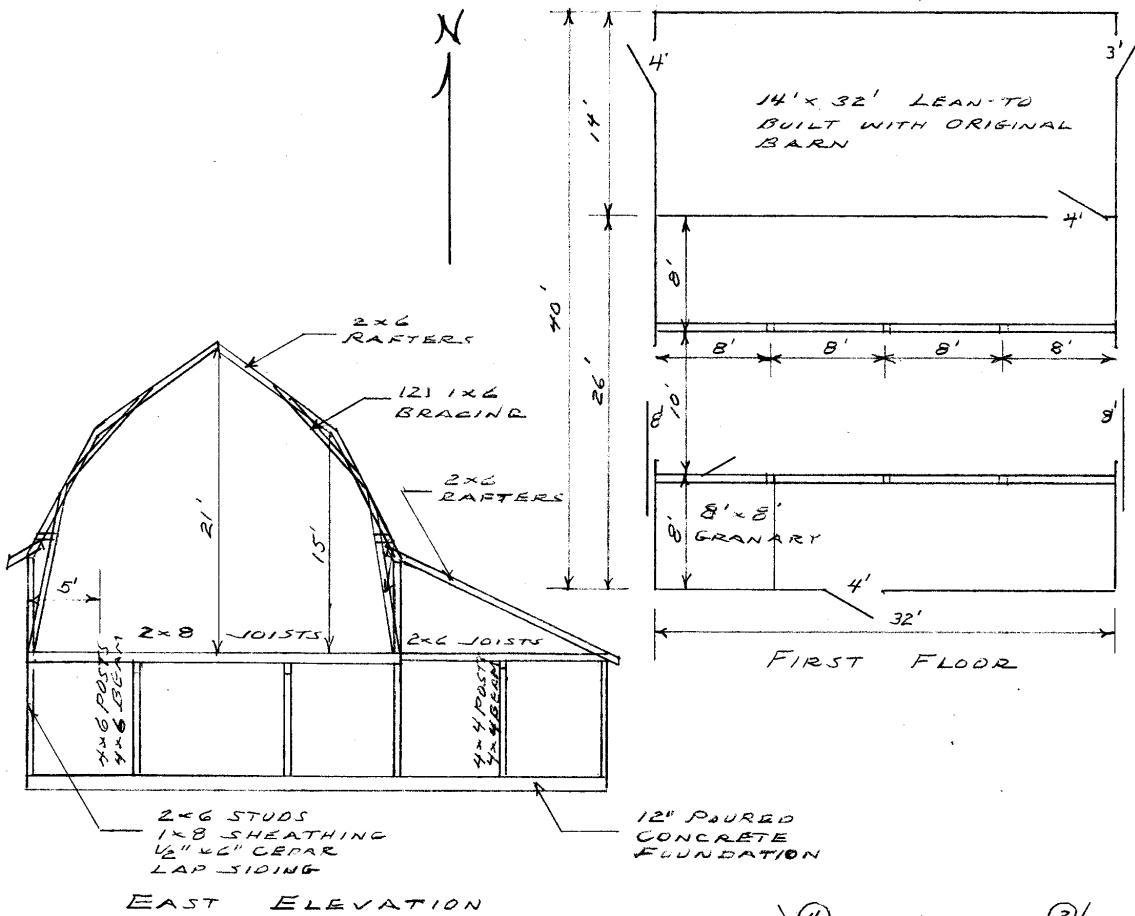

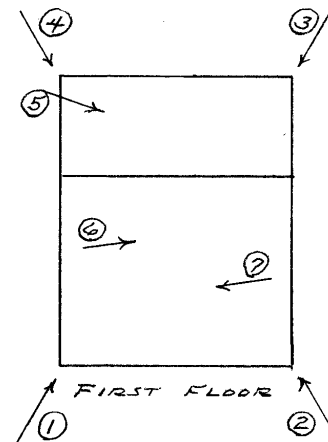
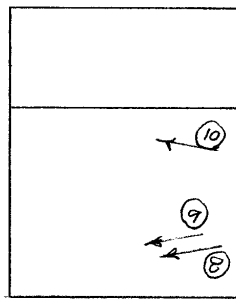
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SKETCH MAP

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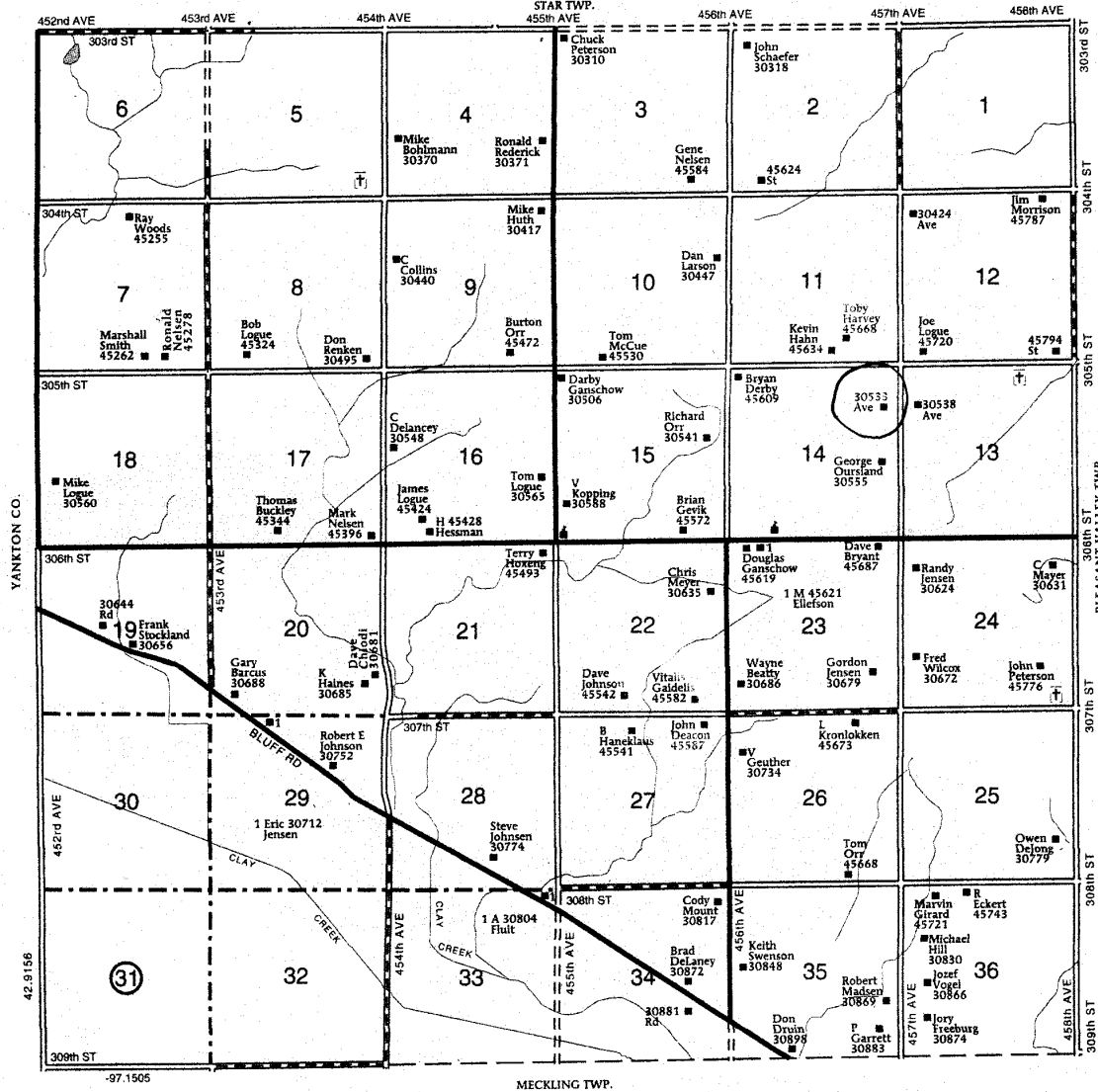
