ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Moved to this site in 19__ . Owners do not know where the barn came from or who lived here then or when this barn was moved. Roof covered with steel roofing. Horse stalls and stanchions have been removed. Two rows 6x6 beams, but the posts have been removed. Three 6x6 posts in the center with 6x6 beam out and under original beams to support floor. Has been remodeled into a hog farrowing barn with slatted floor. 12' lean-to added to the south side

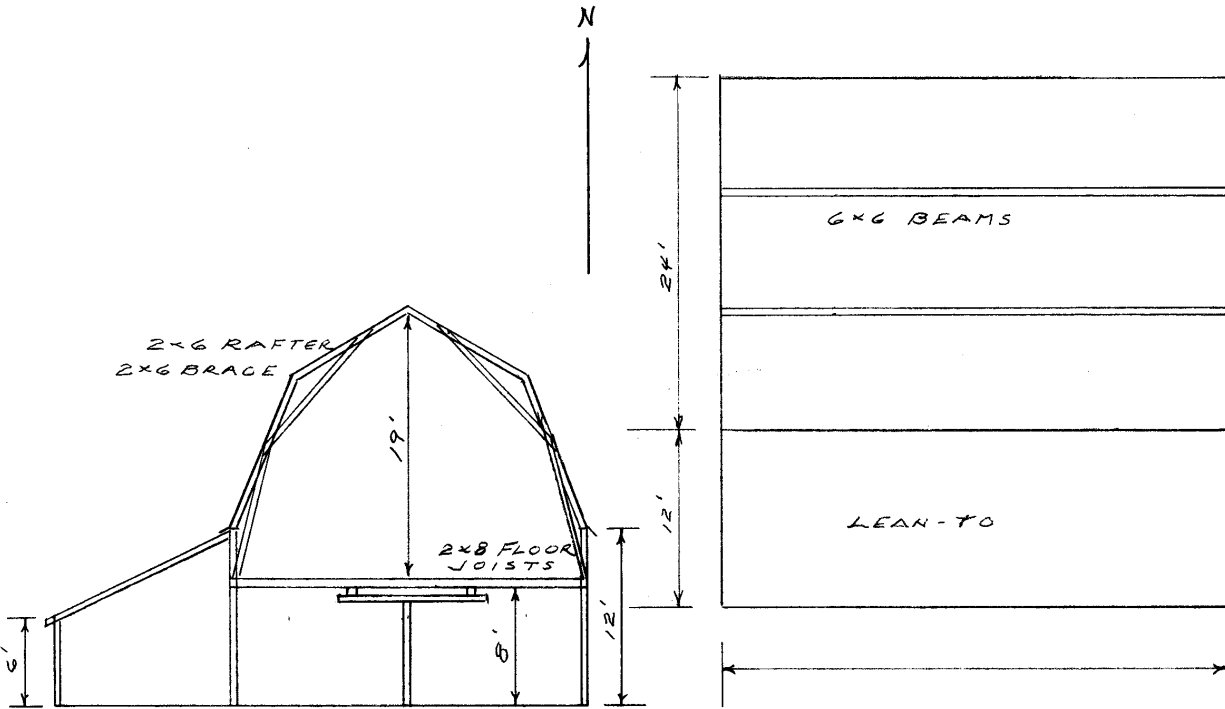
INTERIOR NOTES: _____

OTHER NOTES: 2x6 stud walls 12' high with sheathing & 1x6 pattern #106 siding. 2x6 rafters with 2x6 bracing, 3/4" sheathing, cedar shingles and steel roofing. Braced rafted system. 9"x12" four light windows.

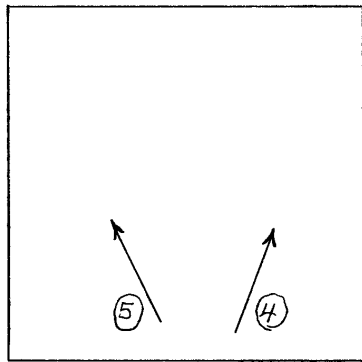

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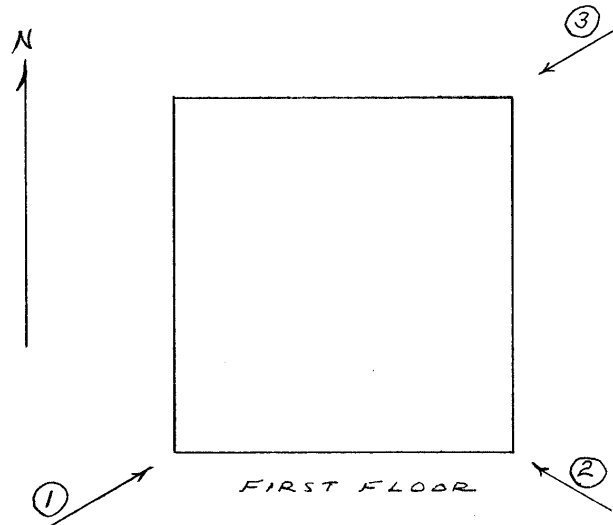


6x6 POSTS REMOVED

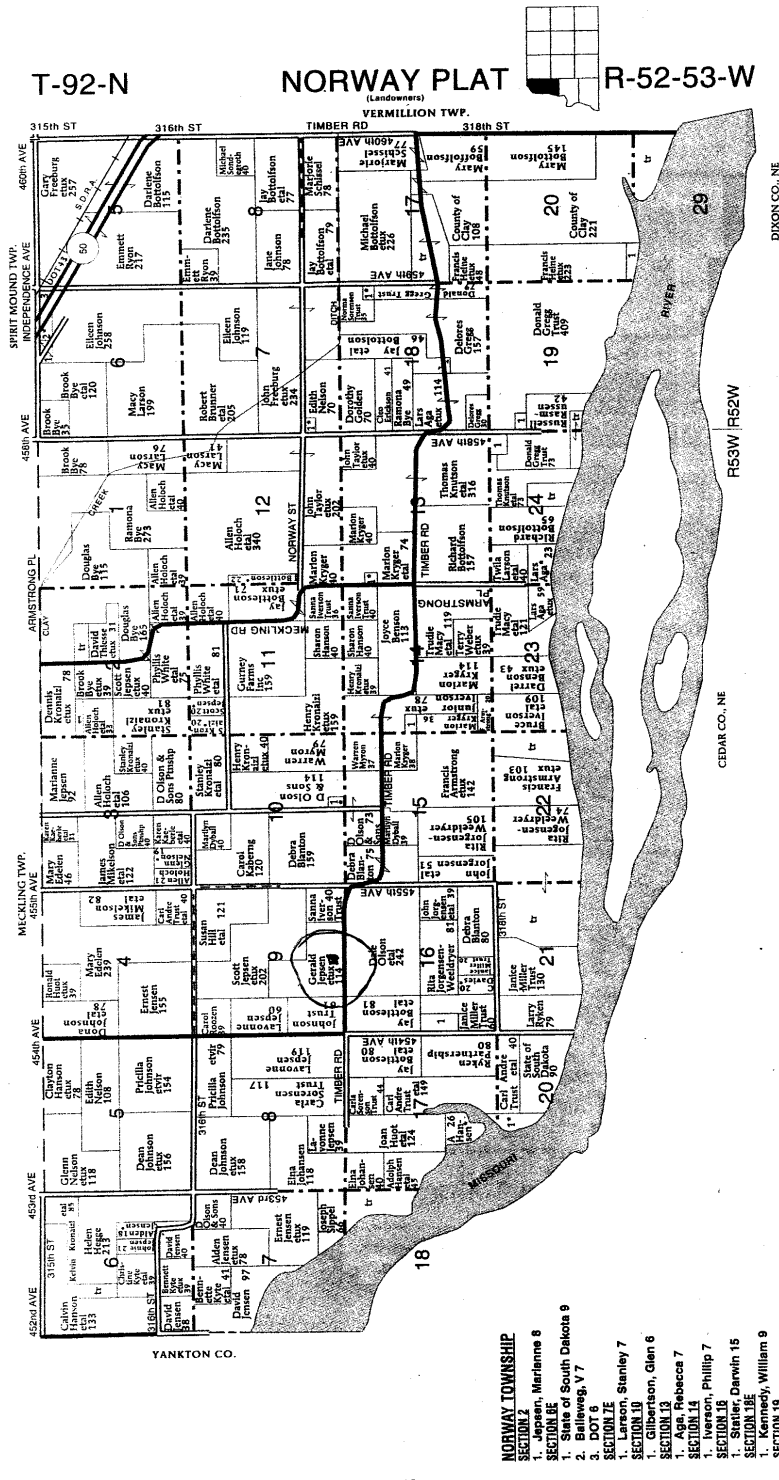
