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**ALTERED/MOVED NOTES:** Original site. Most evidence of horse stalls or milk cow stanchions has been removed. 12' x 26' of hayloft floor raised to 14' at the North end of center alley for machinery storage. 12' x 14' opening added on North wall. 12' x 36' pole barn lean-to added on the East side. Poured concrete has been added on the out side to hold old native rock foundation. Owner did not know if there ever was any mortar between the rocks. Roof and sidewalls covered with steel roofing Except the North wall.

**INTERIOR NOTES:** Two rows of 6x6 posts and 6x6 beams and one row of 4x6 posts and 6x6 beams to support hayloft floor The hayloft floor joists are 2x8's. Double 2x6 posts, 12' O. C. support roof hip. Two 1x6's brace roof hip. One 2x10 brace from top of wall in the hayloft down to the floor 8' O. C.

**OTHER NOTES:** 2x6 stud walls, 1x6 #106 drop siding with 1/2"x 6" cedar lap siding over old siding and now steel roofing over all but the North wall. Rafters are 2x6's. Windows are 8" x10"four light. There are painted stencils on the inside of original 1x6 # 106 drop siding. "Buy your lumber of (?) Fullerton Lumber Co. Vermillion, So. Dak." Owner says that there is the same stencil on a floor joist but we could not find it.

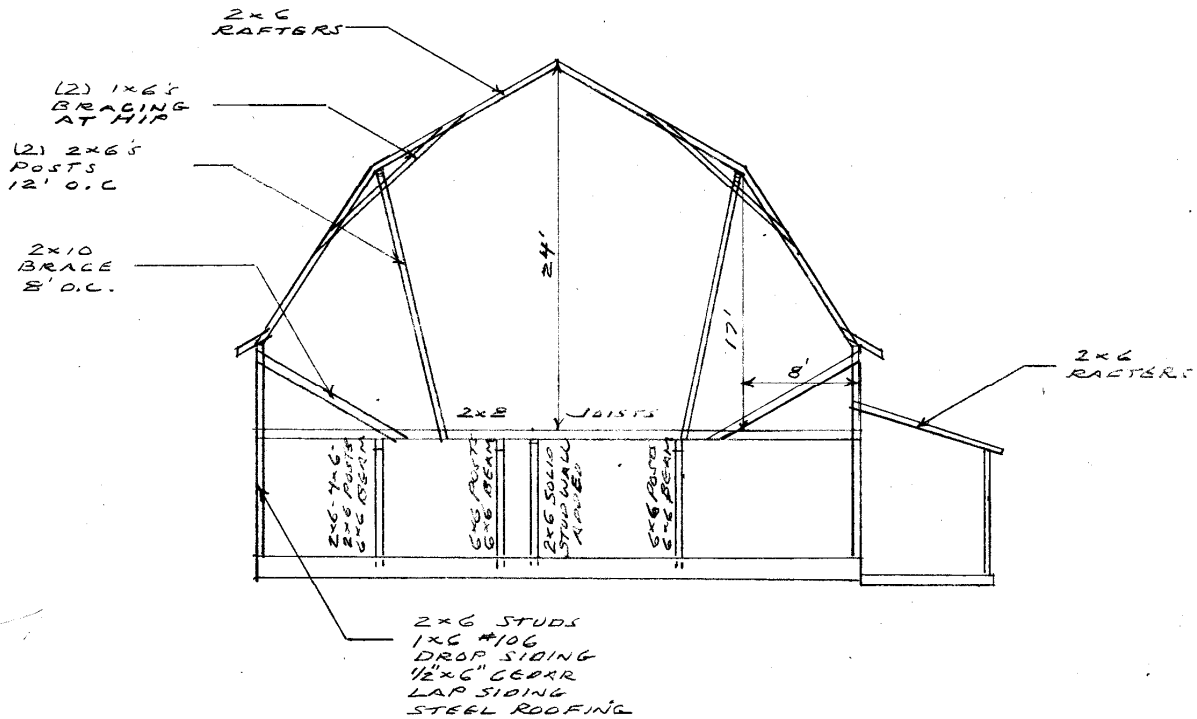

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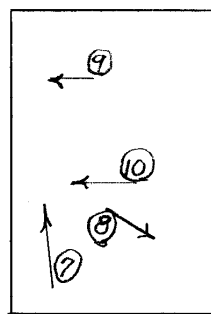
**SKETCH MAP**



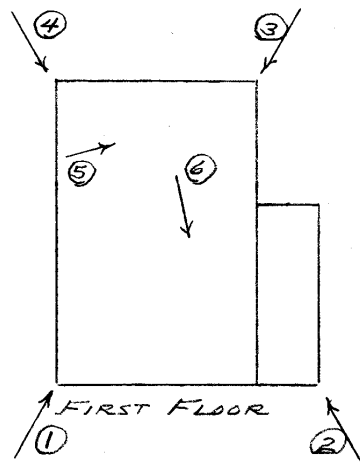
**SOUTH ELEVATION**

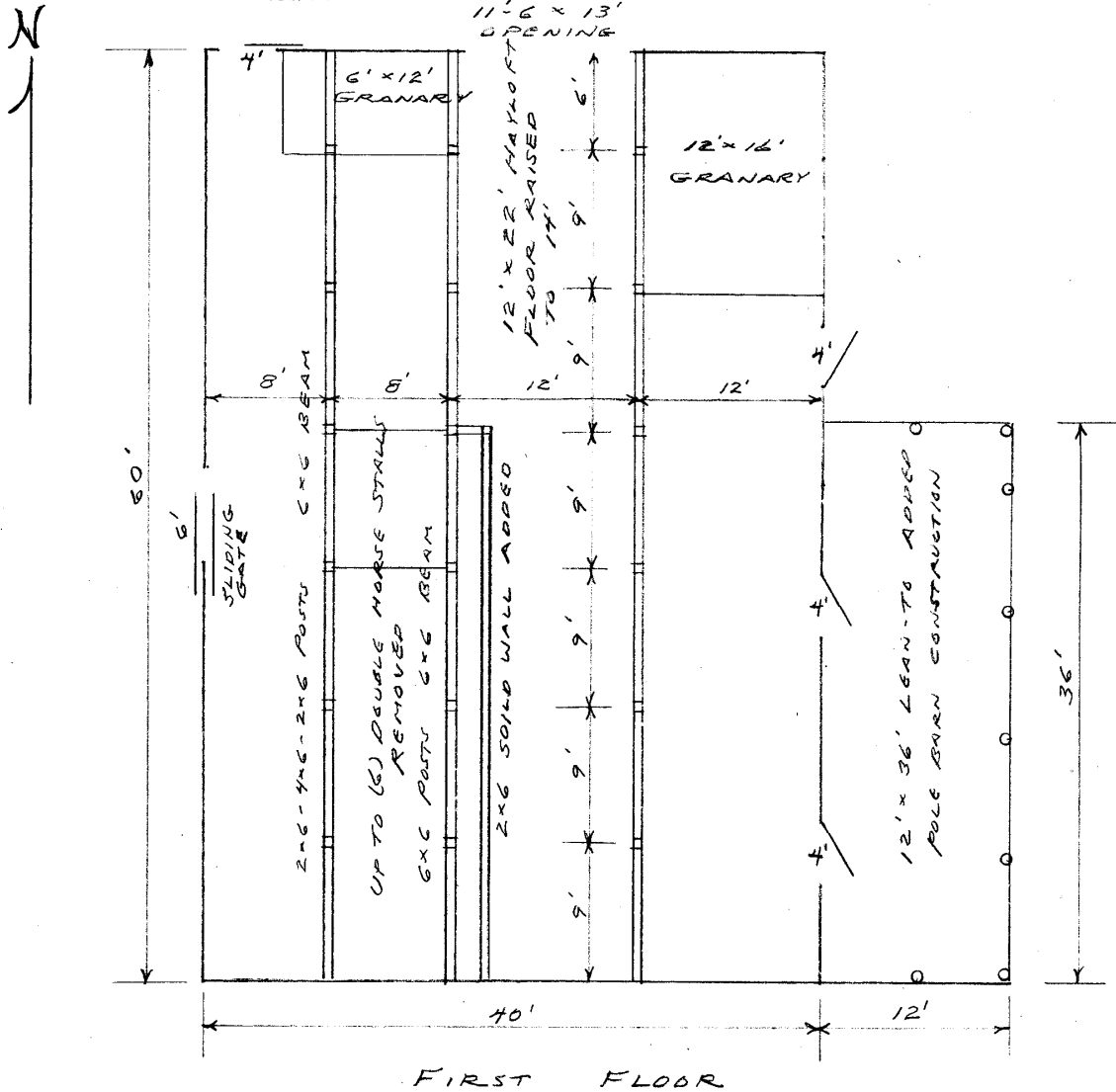
**FIRST FLOOR**

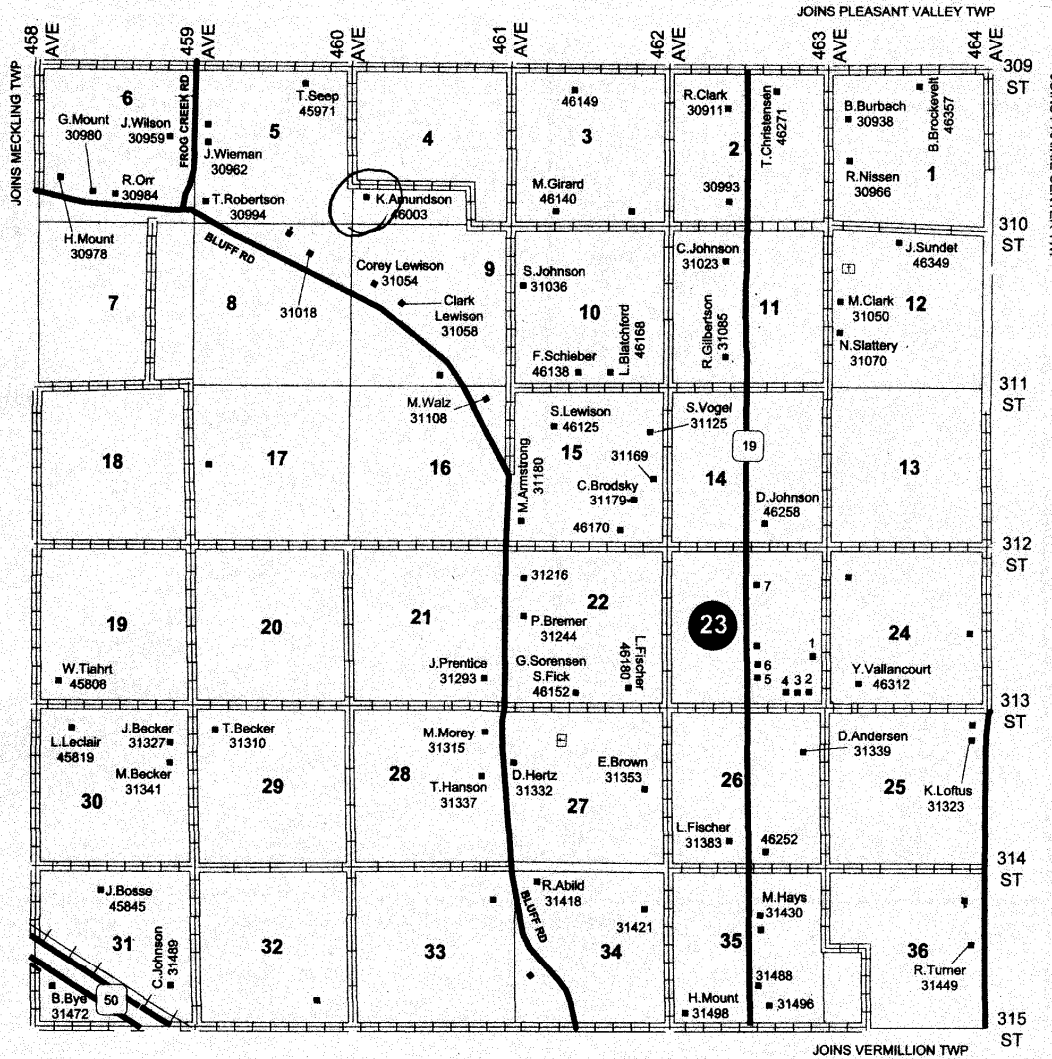

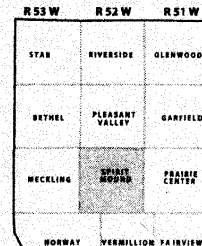
