





The 1894 Clay County Atlas lists John Halver as the owner.

The 1901 and 1912 Clay County Atlas lists John L. Gaylord as the owner

The 1924, 1937, 1948 and 1956 Clay County Atlas lists Myrtle Shepard Lee as the owner. In 1937 M. Buckinberg was listed as the operator (renter).
