ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Most evidence of horse stalls in the main barn have been removed. All evidence of any milk cow stanchions has been removed. Roof and exterior walls have been covered with steel roofing. An 8' x 8' "hot" room added in SE corner of center barn area. This may have been added or was remodeled from a granary. The 1/2"x 6" cedar lap siding may have been removed when the steel roofing was applied to the exterior walls.

INTERIOR NOTES: Two rows of 4x6 posts, 4x6 beams and 2x8 floor joists support the hayloft floor. 8'x8' granary still on the NE corner of center area of barn. Part of one divider for a horse stall is still along the South side in the center barn area next to the "hot" room.

OTHER NOTES: 2X6 stud walls with 1x8 diagonal sheathing on three exterior walls of the center barn with the North wall having horizontal sheathing up to hayloft floor. The North and South lean-tos have 2x4 studs with 1x8 horizontal sheathing and all of the exterior walls have 1/2" x 6" cedar lap siding and steel roofing. The windows are 8" x 10" four light. Foundation is native rock with mortar. The mortar appears to be Portland mortar.

*PHYSICAL NOTES: Barn is in good condition.

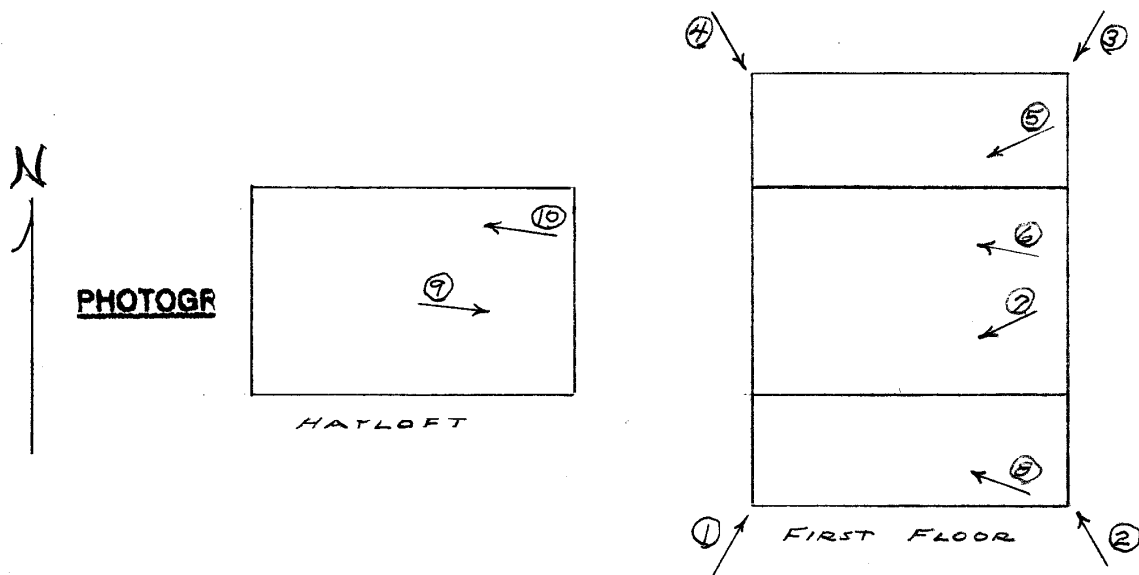
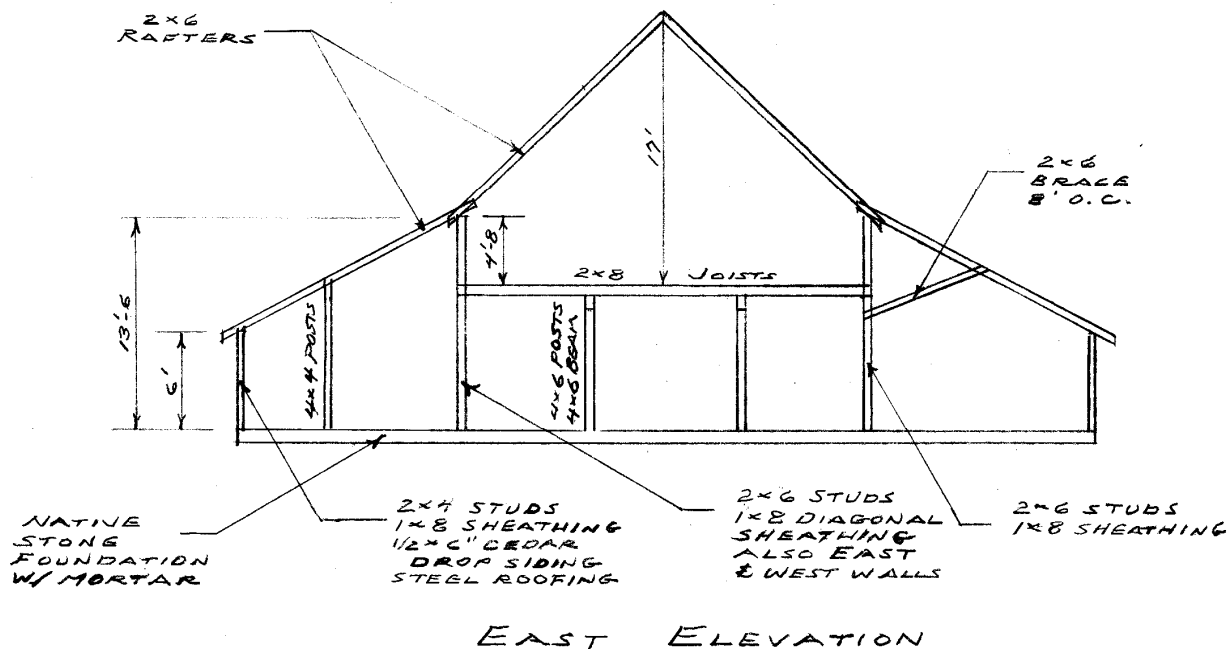

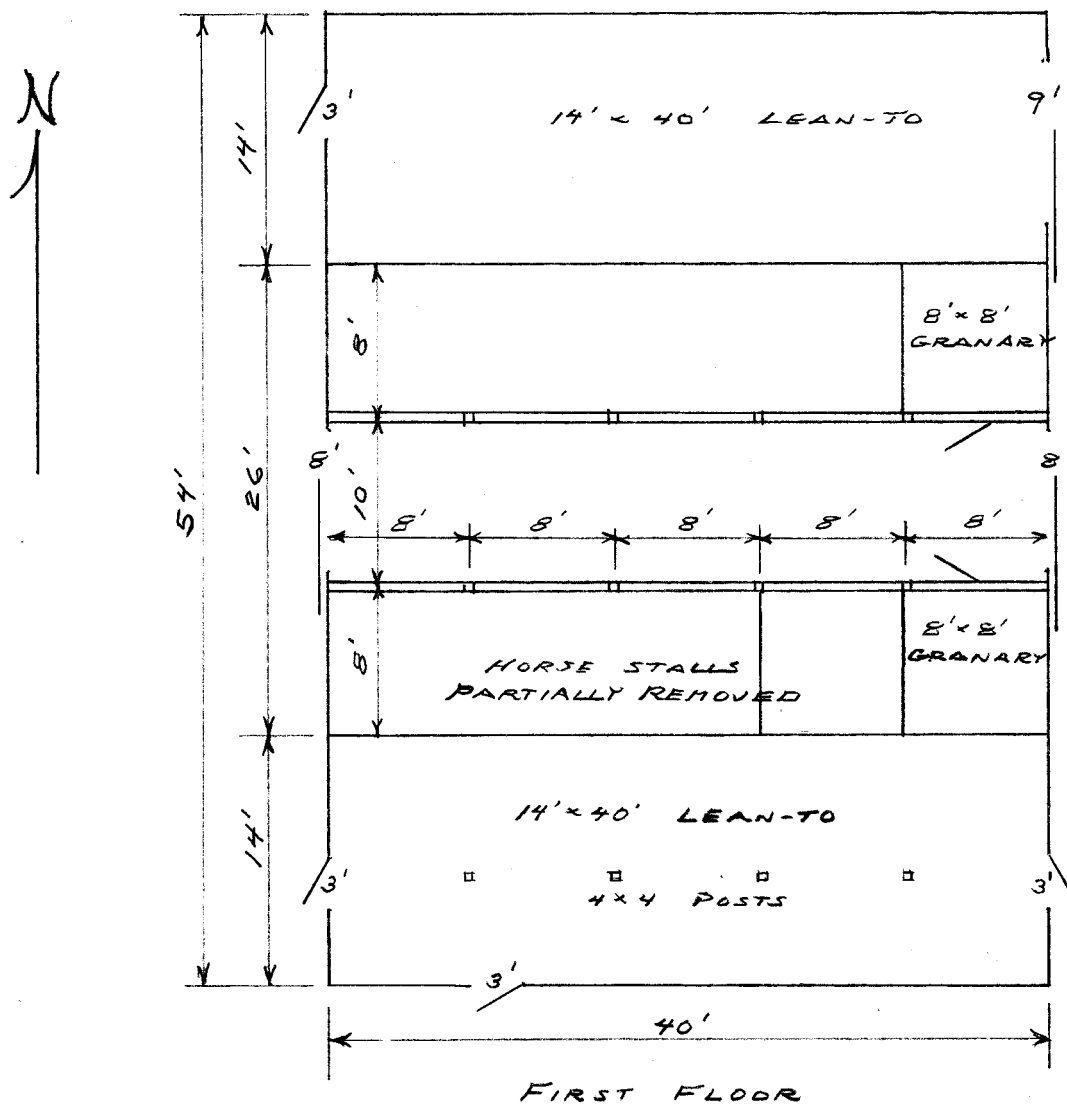
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SKETCH MAP

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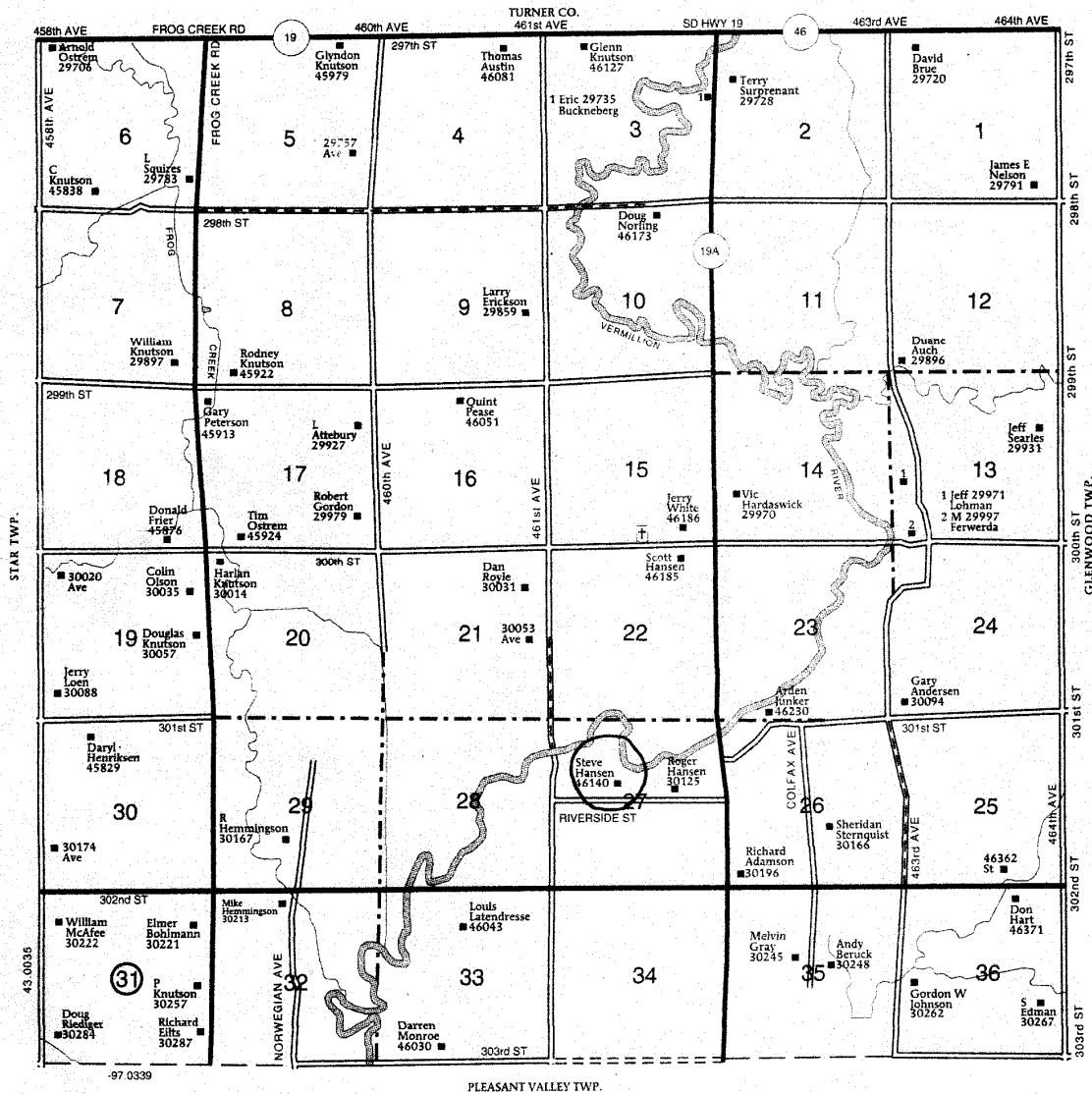
