ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Most evidence of horse stalls has been removed.

INTERIOR NOTES: Two rows of 6x6 posts, and 6x6 beam support the 2x8 joists for the hayloft floor. 9' x 12' granary are still in the NE corner. 10' x 12' granary still in place in the NE corner of the hayloft.

OTHER NOTES: 2x6 stud walls, sheathing and 1/2"x6" cedar lap siding. Sheathing is horizontal on three walls, but diagonal on the North gable end wall. Rafters are 2x6's with a 2x6 brace supporting the hip 4' O. C. (2) 1x6 braces on each hip, 2' O. C. Windows are 8" x 10" four light on the first floor and 8"x 10" four light over 8"x 10" four light in the hayloft. Very ornate cupola from the 19-teens.

*PHYSICAL NOTES: Barn is in fair condition. Needs new roof.

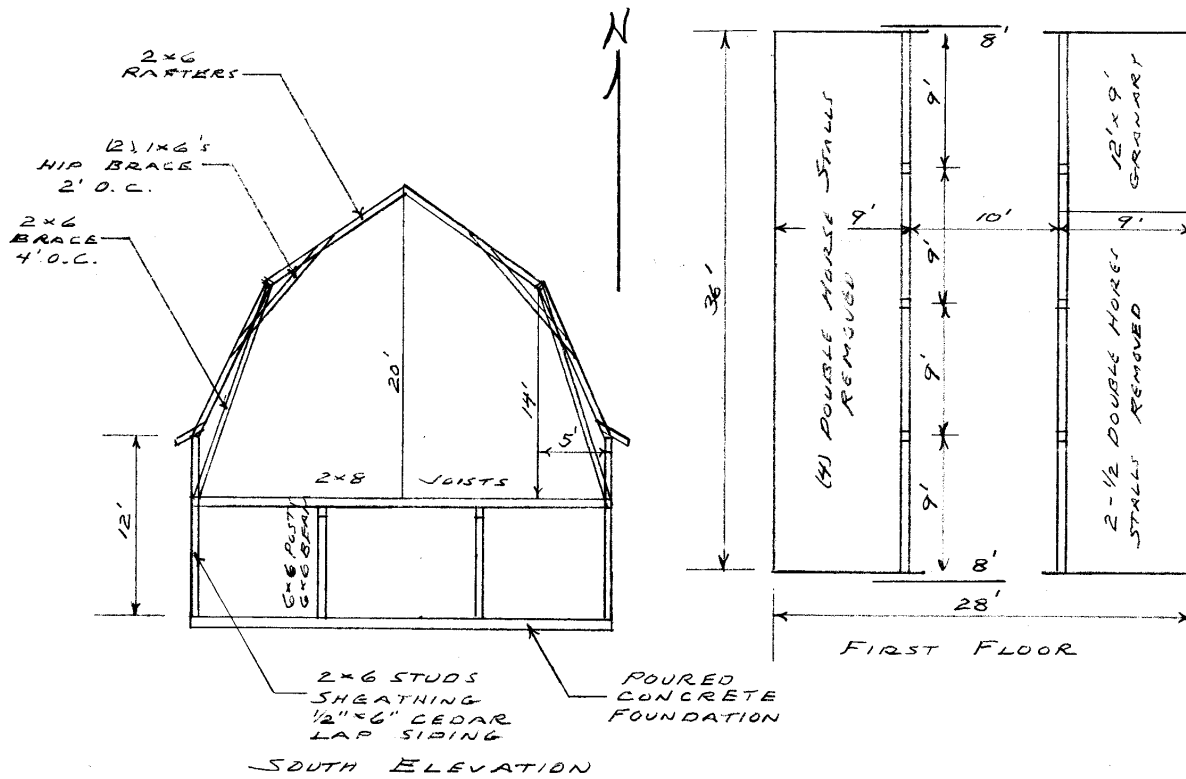

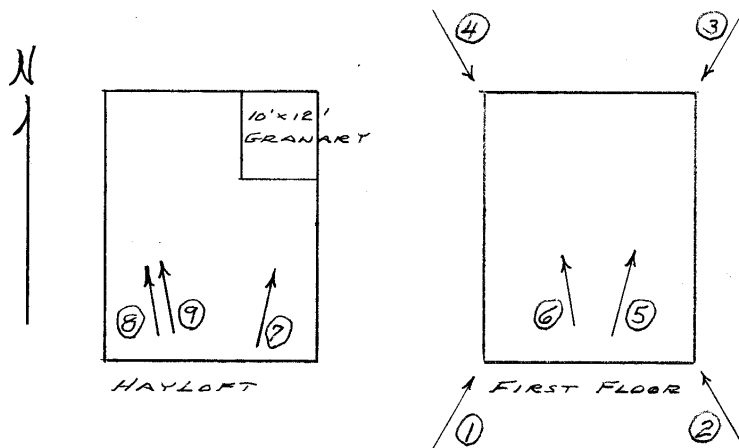
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SKETCH MAP

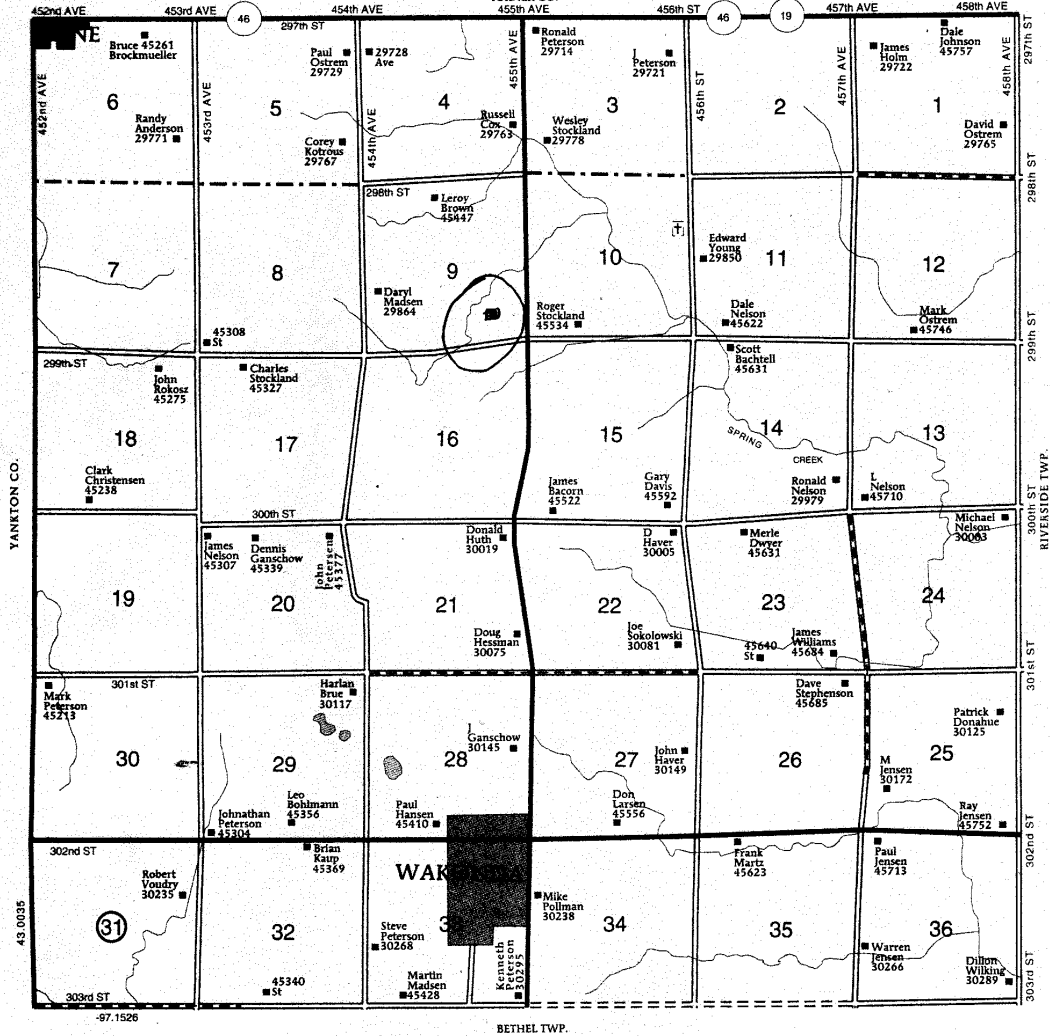

The 1948 and 1956 Clay County Atlas lists H. E. Babb as the owner.
