ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Any evidence milk cow stanchions has been removed. Steel roofing has been installed over cedar shingles on the roof. 9' x 7' overhead door installed in the East wall of the lean-to. Most of the 4"x24" four light windows have been replaced with 9"x12" four light vinyl windows.

INTERIOR NOTES: Two rows of 6"x6" posts, and 6x6 beams support the 2x8 joists for the hayloft floor. Four double horse stalls are still in place on the North wall. 4' wide stairs in the NE corner. Do not know what that area was used for, on the South wall. 40' hay feed rack built on the North wall of lean-to. 2x6 floor joists in the lean-to.

OTHER NOTES: 2x6 stud walls with 1x6 #106 drop siding on all four walls of the barn. Wall between the barn and the lean-to is 2x6 with 1x8 shiplap. Rafters are 2x6's. 2x6 bracing from the hip down to the floor 8' O. C. and 2x6 bracing at the hip 2' O. C. Original windows are 4"x24" four light. Most of the windows have been replaced with 9"x12" four light vinyl windows. Metal cupola still in place.

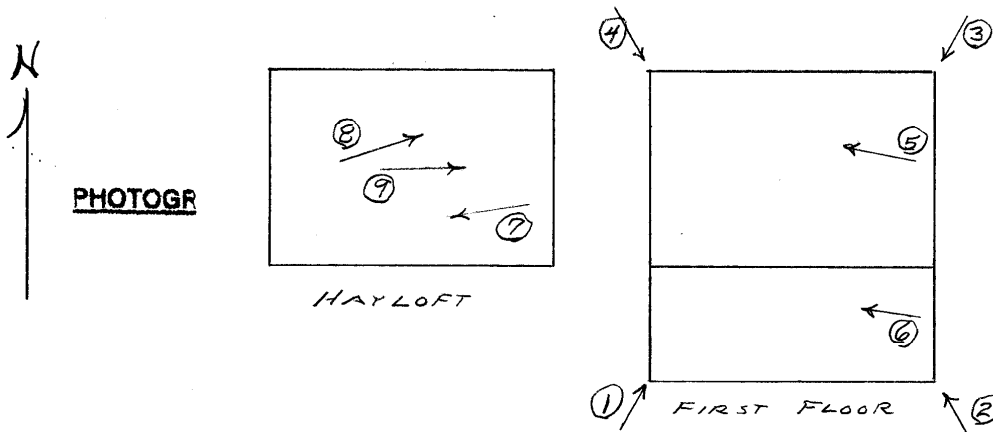
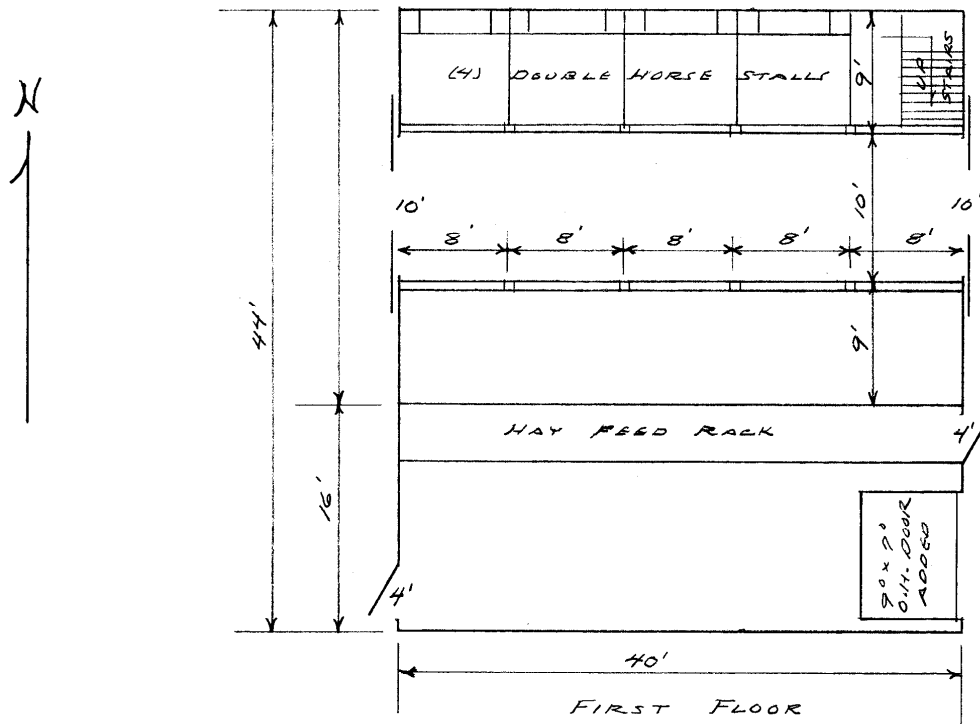

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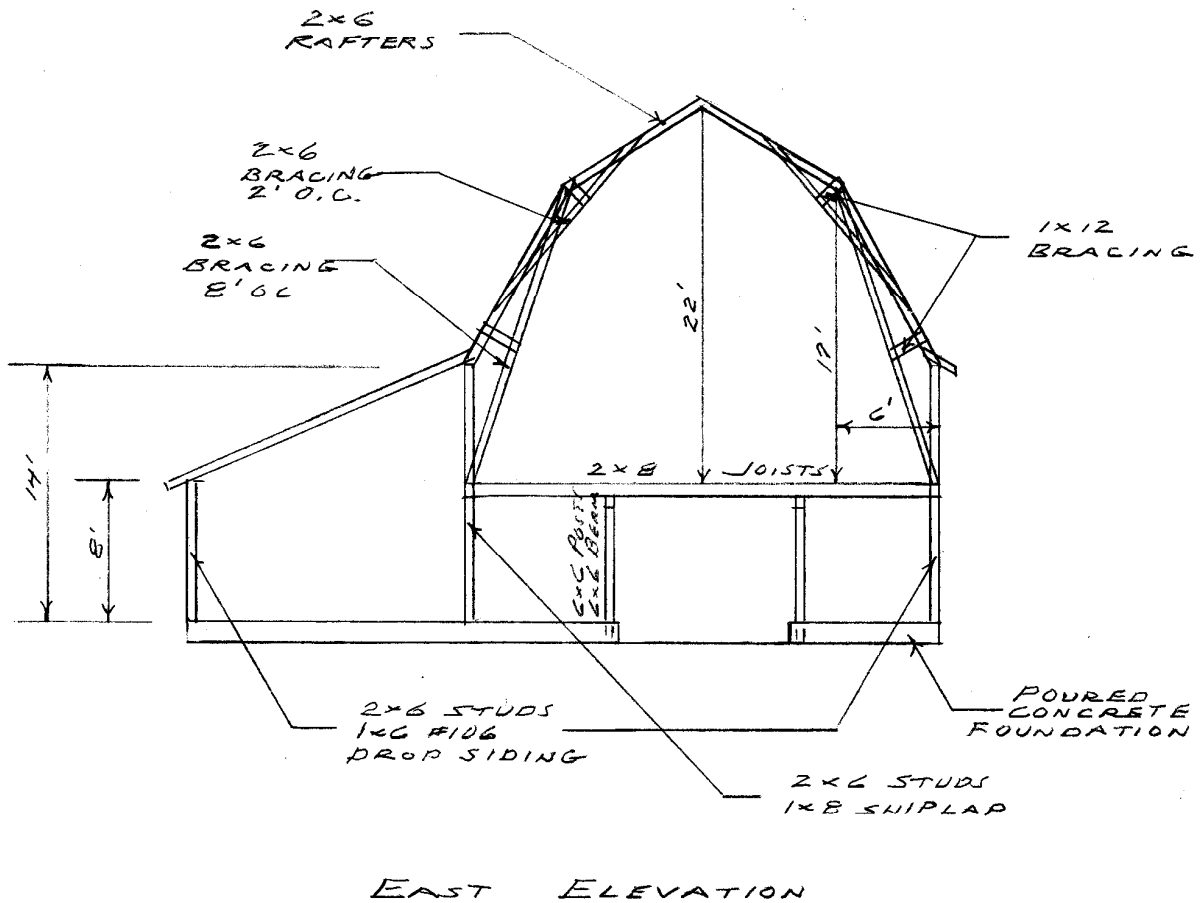
SKETCH MAP

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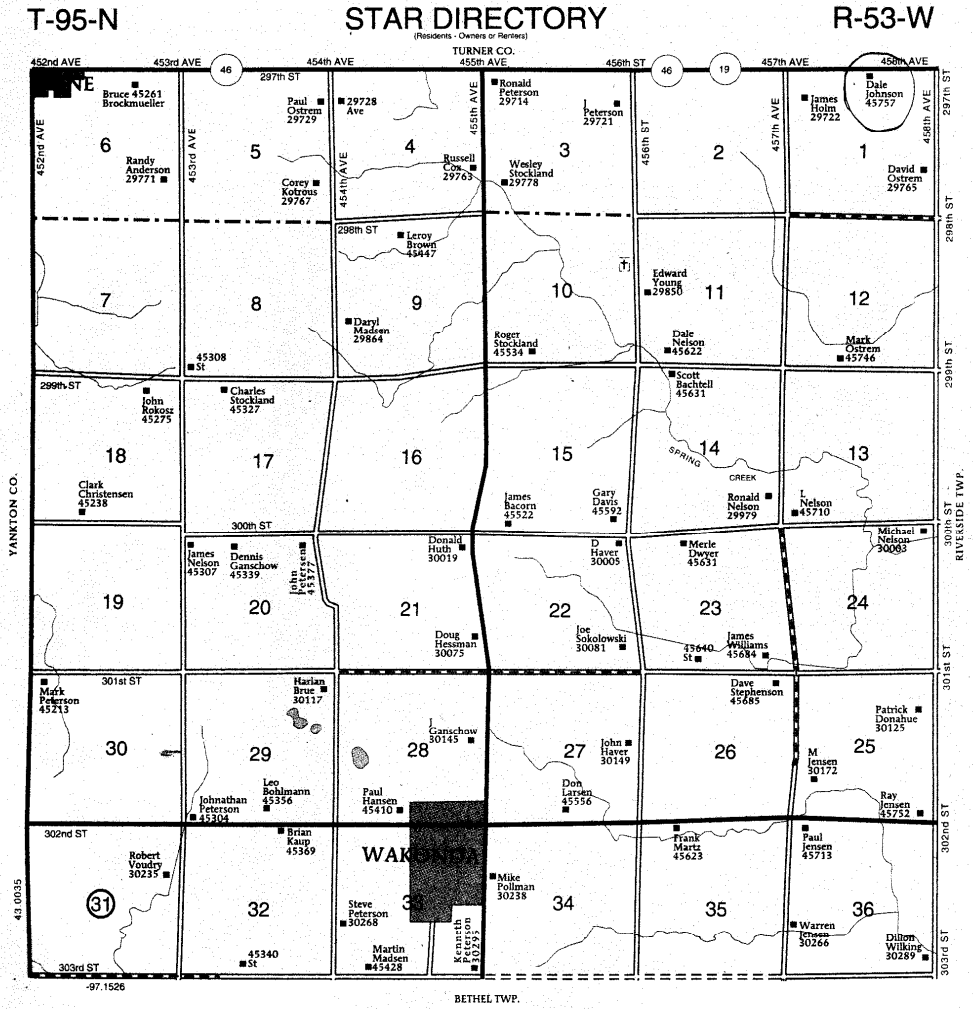
