ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Any evidence of horse stalls and milk cow stanchions has been removed. Roof has been covered with steel roofing, except the South side, which is cedar shingles. Most of the walls have been covered with 1-1/4" x 26" galvanized corrugated steel was applied vertically. North 14'x 48' lean-to added later. South 16' x 48' lean-to added later, snow caved the roof in and the lean-to was removed. Posts in the main barn have rotted off and have been replaced with treated 6x6's

INTERIOR NOTES: The original barn had two rows of round posts and (2) 2x6's for a beam.

The floor joists for the hayloft floor are 2x6's. 2x6 posts 4' O. C. support the center of rafters in hayloft. Two 8'x8' granaries still in the SW corner of the first floor.

OTHER NOTES:2x6 stud walls with 1x6 #106 drop siding and 1-1/4"x 26" vertical steel, except the Westwall. North lean-to is pole barn construction.5" posts 6' O. C. with 2x6 girts 24" O. C. and steel siding.

Windows are 8"x10" four light. Rafters are 2x6's. An interesting note, most of the rafters are rough sawn lumber with a milled 2x6 nailed along side of some. The South wall is rough sawn lumber, but the West, North and East walls are milled lumber.






SKETCH MAP




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WEST ELEVATION






