

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



This farm located in the SW ¼ of Section 15, Prairie Center Township, Clay County was homesteaded by Ole Johnson.

The 1894, 1901, 1912 and 1924 Clay County Atlas lists Ole. J. Opland as the owner.

The 1937 Clay County Atlas lists Hilma Opland and Ogla Hybertson as the owners and J. Hybertson as the operator (renter).

The 1948 and 1956 Clay County Atlas lists John Hybertson as the owner.
