ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Any evidence of milk cow stanchions has been removed.
Horse stalls were in the West side and all except part of a single and a double horse stall have been
removed. Siding has been removed when steel roofing was applied on the walls. Granary was removed
from the NW corner and a door was installed in the NW corner. Asphalt shingles over cedar shingles.

INTERIOR NOTES: Has a 2x6 solid wall dividing the West 26' from the East 24'. Two rows of 6x6 posts
and 6x6 beams in the West side. This was where the horse stalls were located. One row 6x6 posts and a
6x6 beam in the East side and (2) 2x6's for a beam but no posts.

OTHER NOTES: Walls are 2x6 with 1x8 sheathing and steel roofing. Rafters are 5 plies of 1x12 x 6'6"
cedar laminated and cut to roof arc on the outside. These rafters are 8' O. C. except 5' O. C. from gable
ends. Horizontal 2x4 purlins 2' O. C. support vertical three ply 1x4 cedar that are 2' O. C. 2x6x 5'
horizontals purlins are between the last rafter and the gable ends.

*PHYSICAL NOTES: Barn is in fair condition. Roof is leaking and rotting out the hayloft floor.

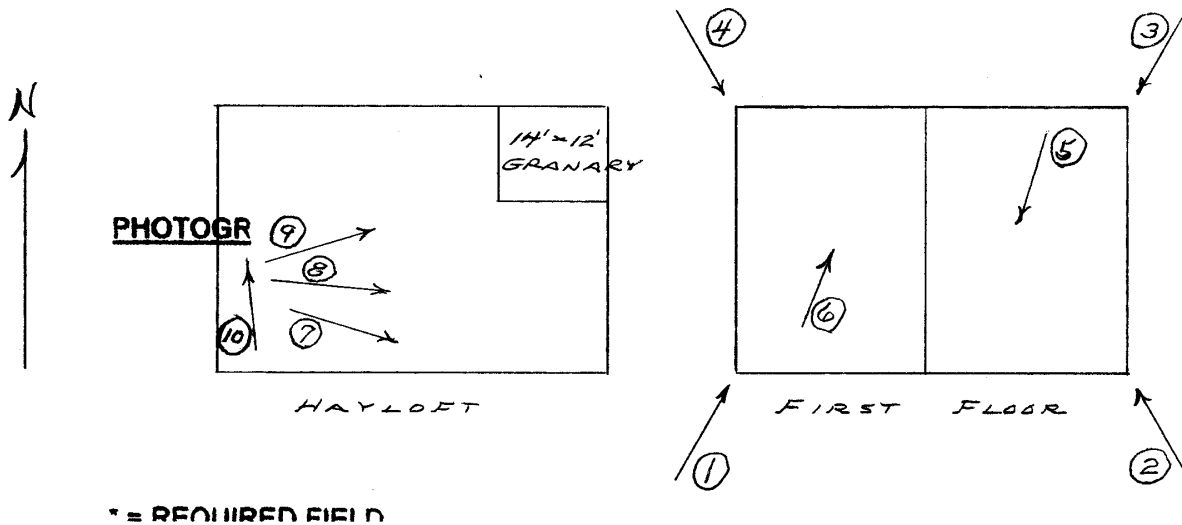
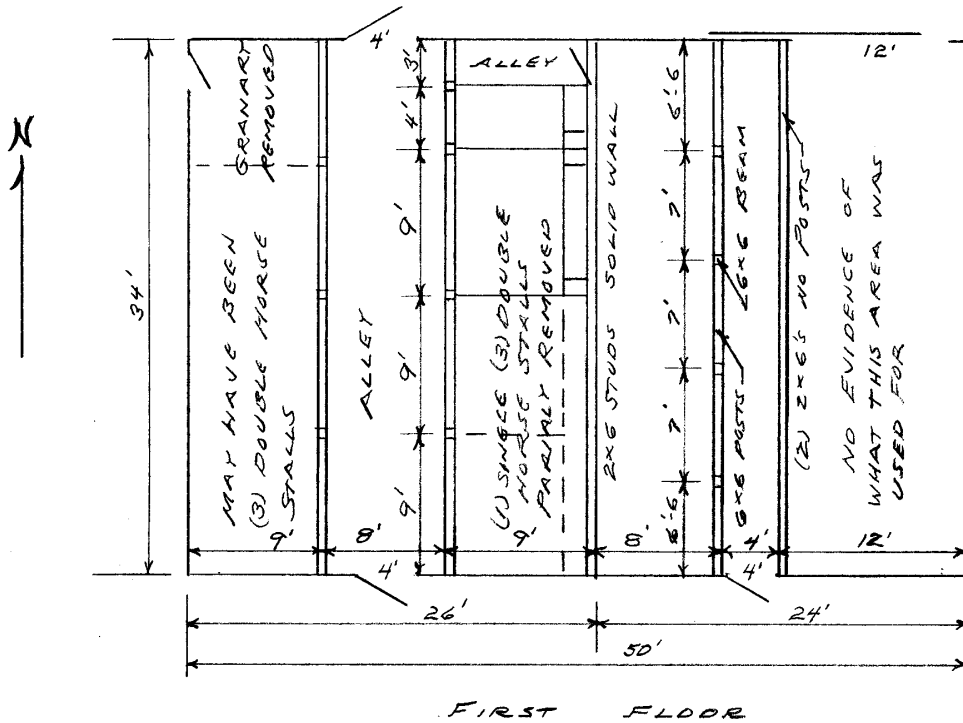

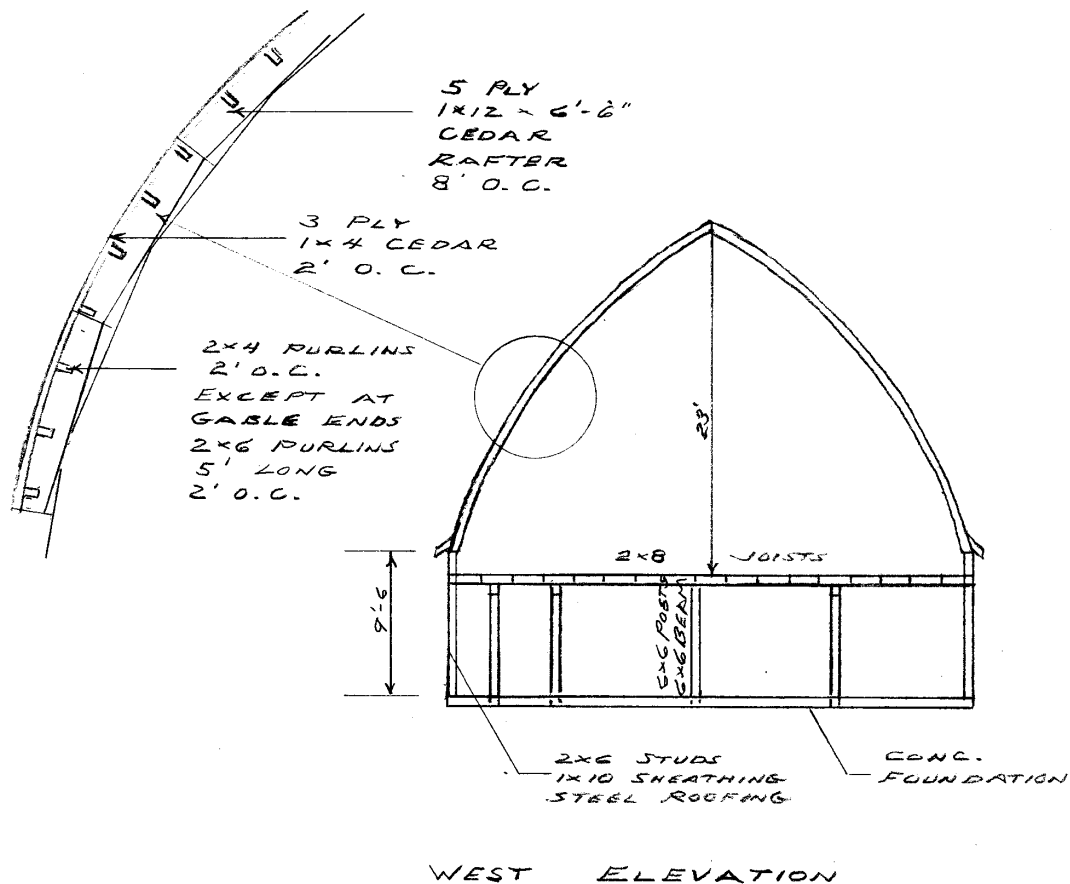
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SKETCH MAP

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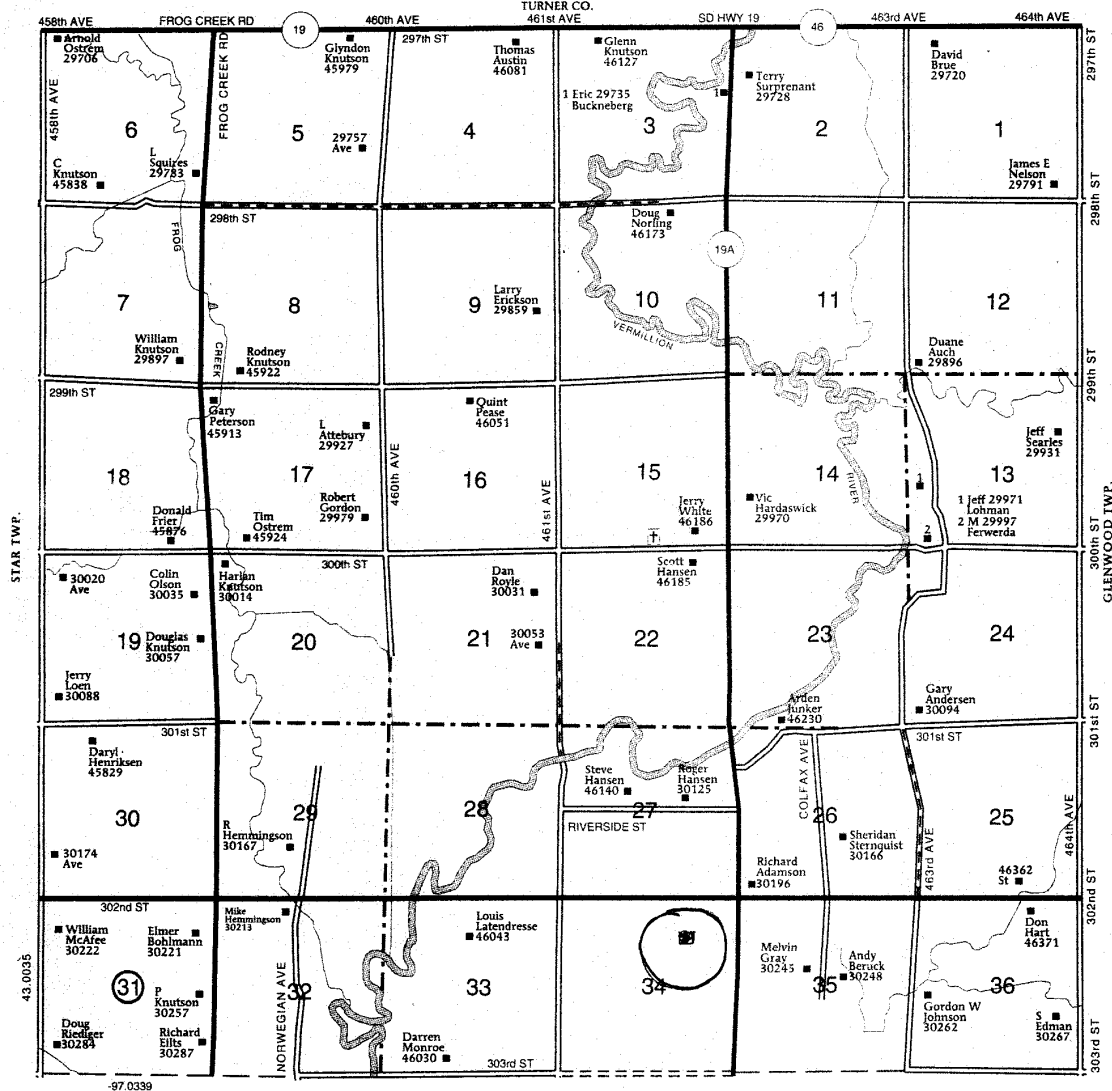
