ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Cedar shingles removed from roof and steel roof installed April 2012. Milk cow stanchions removed. 12'x12' granary in the NW corner has been removed.

INTERIOR NOTES: <u>Three rows of 6x6 posts and 4x6 beams. 2x8 floor joists</u>. Horse stalls are still in place. Floor joists have bridging to keep joists from tipping over. Used in homes, but I have not seen This in a barn before.


OTHER NOTES: 2x6 walls 12'-8" high on the East and West. 2x6 walls on the gable ends balloon

framed. Horizontal sheathing on all walls. Brick stamped steel siding on walls. 8"x10" four light

Windows with triangular boards on each to allow the window to tilt in at the top for ventilation. This Kept the wind directly off and above the livestock for ventilation and prevented rain from coming the barn.

*PHYSICAL NOTES: <u>Barn is in very good condition.</u> Steel siding needs painting and Pat Donahue said that he will be painting it this summer.








