



HISTORY

This farm in the SE ¼ of Sec 21, Glenwood Twp. was homesteaded by Peter Gamberg in 1872. He would have received a land patent on this farm after at least 5 years. However his father and mother homesteaded in Section 9, Glenwood Twp. in 1871, but did not receive their patent until 1884. Unless history has the wrong dates.

The 1894, 1901, 1912 and 1924 Clay County Atlas lists Peter Gamberg as the owner.

The 1937 Clay County Atlas lists Mary (Marie?) Gamberg as the owner.

The 1948 Clay County Atlas lists E. W. Carlson as the owner.

The 1956 Clay County Atlas lists Nora Silkenson as the owner.

Peter Gamberg would have built or hired someone to build this barn. This is based on the materials used and the construction of this barn.

The following is from the

Beresford Centennial Book 1884 - 1984

Peter Gamberg, the son of Lars Peter and Ingra (Frowald) Gamberg was born in Helsingland, Sweden in 1844. He came to America and homesteaded in Clay County, S. D. in 1872, living there until moving to Beresford in 1911. He was married to Marie Johnson. They had four children; Charles, Amanda, Elon and Arthur. Peter died in 1922 and Marie in 1943.

Charles, born in 1883, married Etta Veborg. They had no children. Both are deceased.

Amanda (1884- 1975) married Willard Lee Johnson. They had no children. Both homesteaded in western South Dakota and later built a home in Beresford. Willard had a gas station at the corner of 2nd Street and Hemlock.

Elon, born in 1887, married Ella Johnson. Both are deceased. They farmed his father's homestead and then moved to Oregon. They had two sons. Harold married Eleanore Hanson and they had two children, James who is deceased and Barbara (Mrs. Don Overholsor). James married Ethel Evjen and they had four children; William, Richard, Thomas and Mary (Mrs. Micheal Delk). Both Harold and LuVern Gambergs live in Lebonon, Oregon.

Arthur (1891-1974) married Emma Louisa Strommesen. They had one daughter, Mary Ann, who married Keith Fittje. They have two children Andrea and Brian and live in Sioux Falls.
