ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site.
Lean-to added on the North. 1-1/4" x 26" corrugated steel roofing applied vertically on north wall.
Cupola is gone. 1-1/4" x 26" corrugated galvanized steel roofing applied on the North slope of the roof including the lean-to.

INTERIOR NOTES: The original barn has two rows of 4x6 posts and a 4x6 for a beam. The floor joists are 2x6's for the hayloft floor. Five double horse stalls are still in place in the along the south wall. Three milk cow stalls are still in place. A tack room is still in place. A 6'x 14' granary, hay feed racks and a 10' x 14' pen are still in place in the lean-to.

OTHER NOTES: 2x4 stud walls in lean-to and 2x6 stud walls in the original barn, with 1x6 #106 drop siding. Rafters are 2x6's on original barn and 2x6's on lean-to. A 2x6 brace in the hayloft from top of wall down to floor, 4' O. C. 6x6 sills on original barn and 4x6 sills in lean-to. Windows are 4" x 24" four light, except two 8"x10" four light on the South wall and two 9"x 12" four light on the East wall.

*PHYSICAL NOTES: Barn is in poor condition.








SKETCH MAP



HISTORY

This farm located in the NW ¼ of Section 8, Glenwood Township, Clay County, was homesteaded by Aaron Noble.

The 1894 and 1901 Clay County atlas lists S. M. Peterson as the owner. Name was Swen Mangus Peterson as per granddaughter Cheryl Walsh.

The 1912, 1924, 1937, 1948 and 1956 Clay County atlas lists S. V. Peterson as the owner, but the 1948 Clay County Atlas lists S. Victor Peterson as the owner. Name was Swen Victor Peterson as per granddaughter Cheryl Walsh. Swen Victor Peterson raised and trained horses and mules.
