



The 1937 Clay County Atlas lists Ina Jorgensen as the owner.

The 1948 Clay County Atlas lists Martin Madison as the owner.

The 1956 Clay County Atlas lists Martin Madison as the owner

W. H. Madsen was the most likely to have built this barn or hired it built. The materials and construction point to the 1920's
