ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. All evidence of horse stalls and or milk cow stanchions has been removed. Asphalt shingles have been installed over cedar shingles on the roof. Cupola is gone.

INTERIOR NOTES: One row of 6x6 posts, and 6x6 beam support the 2x10 joists for the hayloft floor. The hayloft floor joists stop and are supported on a 2x4 solid wall, 14' from the North wall. The hayloft floor ends here and extends down to ground level. It is 31' - 6" from the ground up to the peak of the roof in this area.

OTHER NOTES: 2x6 stud walls with 1x6 #106 drop siding. Rafters are 2x6's with a 6x6 posts supporting the hip, 10' O. C. , (2) 1x6's brace on each hip 2' O. C. Asphalt shingles over cedar shingles. Windows are 8" x 10" four light.

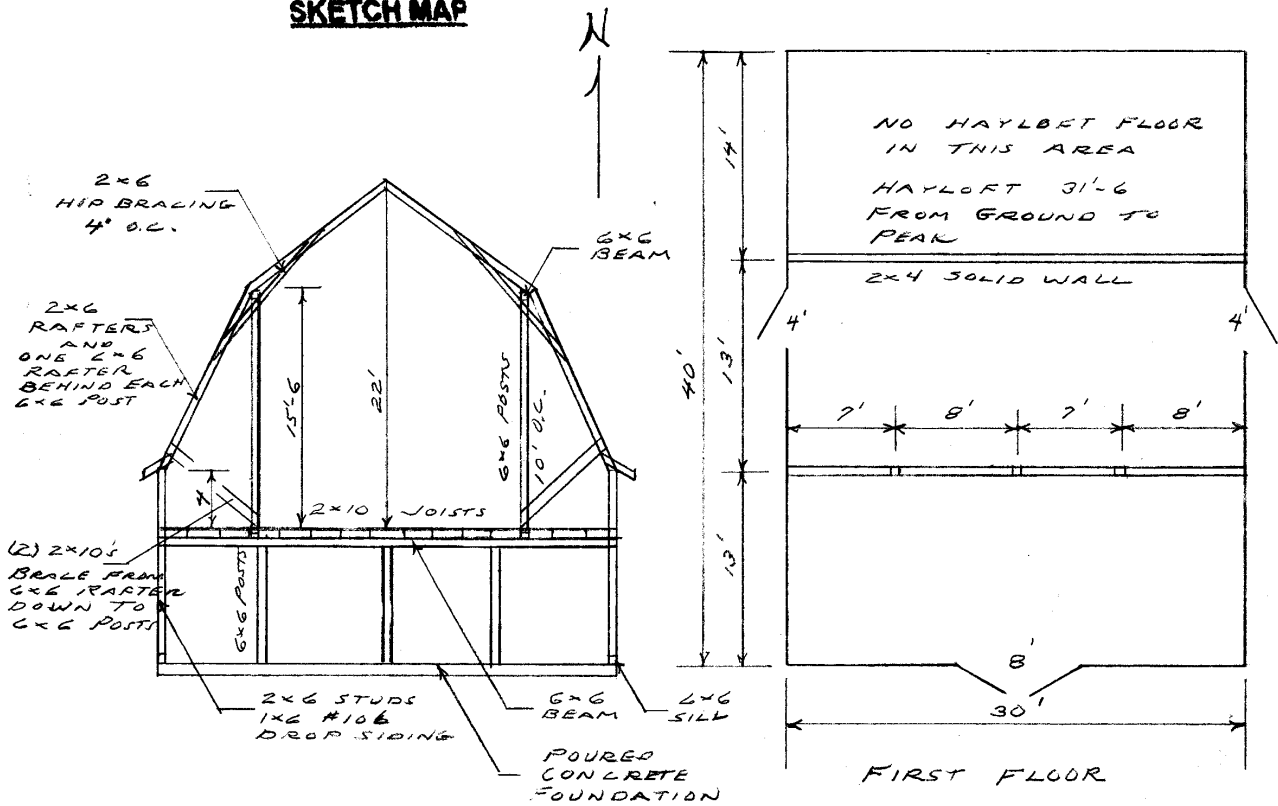

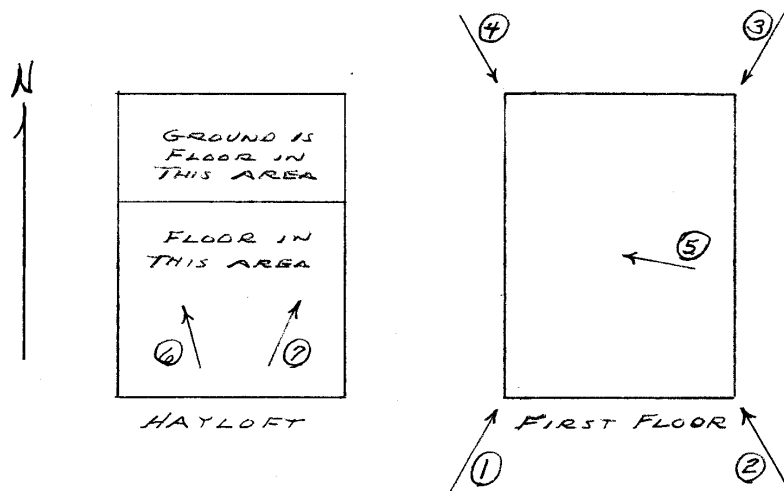
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**SKETCH MAP**

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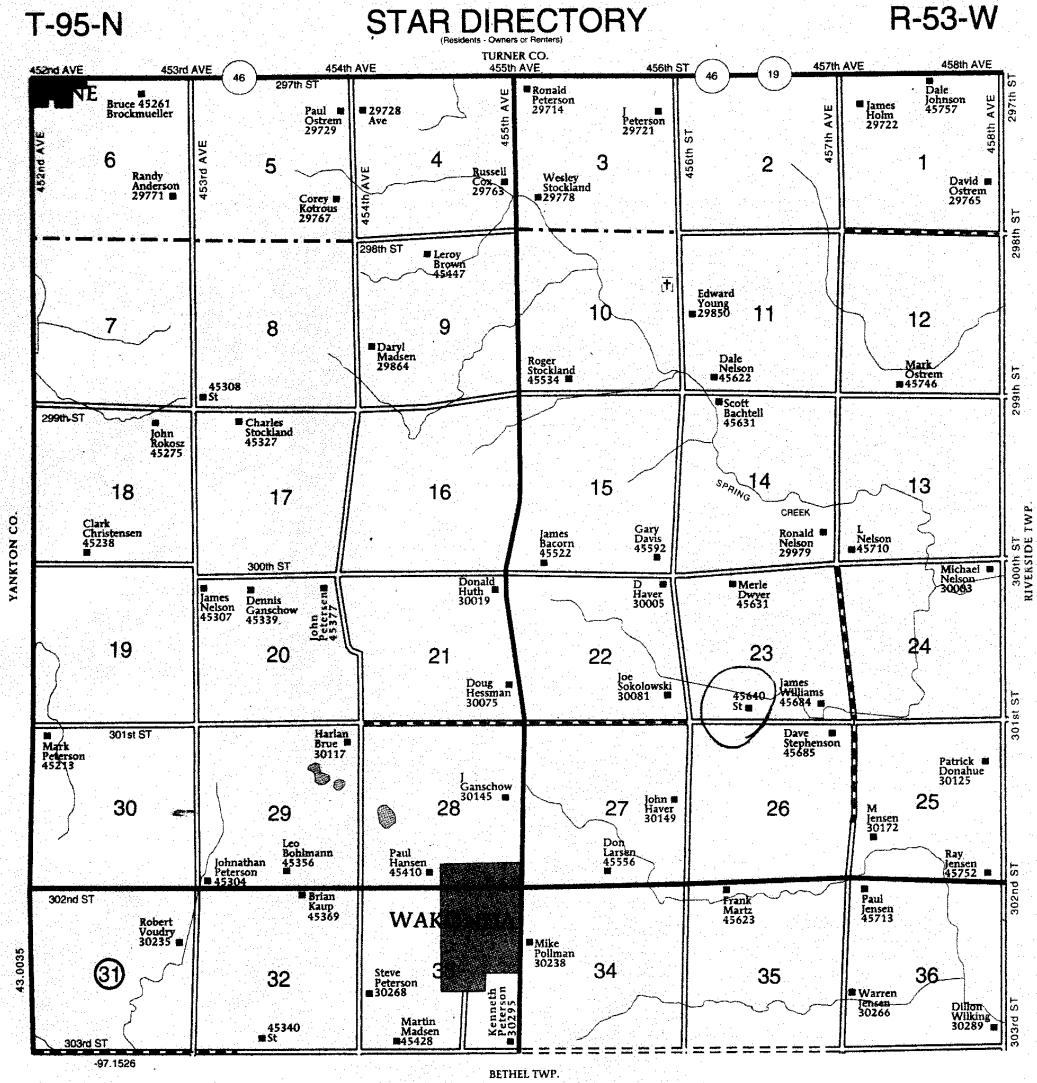
