



HISTORY

This farm located in the NE ¼ of Section 15, Pleasant Valley township, Clay County was homesteaded by Renwick Russell.

The 1894 and 1901 Clay County Atlas lists Renwick Russell as the owner.

The 1912 and 1924 Clay County Atlas lists William Gregoire as the owner.

The 1937, 1948 and 1956 Clay County Atlas lists Raoul J. Gregoire as the owner. In 1937 the farm was called "Golden Valley".

The Following Is From Richard (Dick) Gregoire

William Gregoire bought land from Renwick Russell. Year? Wm. Gregoire built barn in 1914. House in 1916. Richard (Dick) Gregoire bought land from Raoul (R. J.) Gregoire in 1965.
