ALTERED/MOVED NOTES: Original site. Milk cow stanchions have been removed. Roof has been covered with steel roofing. The West row of 6x6 posts and 6x8 beam have been removed, but are still in in the barn.

INTERIOR NOTES: Four rows 6x6 posts with 6x8 beams. 2x10 floor joists. Two rows 6x6 posts and 6x6 beams supporting the roof hip in the hayloft. Posts in the hayloft are 12' O.C. from the North and South gable ends with 10' O. C. in the center. Two 2x10's brace from the 6x6 rafter behind each post down to the bottom of each 6x6 post.

OTHER NOTES: 8"x10" four light windows over 8"x10" four light window, double hung for ventilation. 2x6 walls 13'-6" high on the East and West walls with horizontal sheathing. 2x8 walls 16' high on the gable ends with 2x6 wall above to rafters with diagonal sheathing. 1/2"x6" cedar lap siding on all walls. Two 6x8x22' timbers with a scarf joint in the center make each beam on each of the four (40') long beams. Metal cupola.

*PHYSICAL NOTES: Barn is in very good condition. Very well built barn. Needs painting and Patrick Donahue said it will be painted this summer.

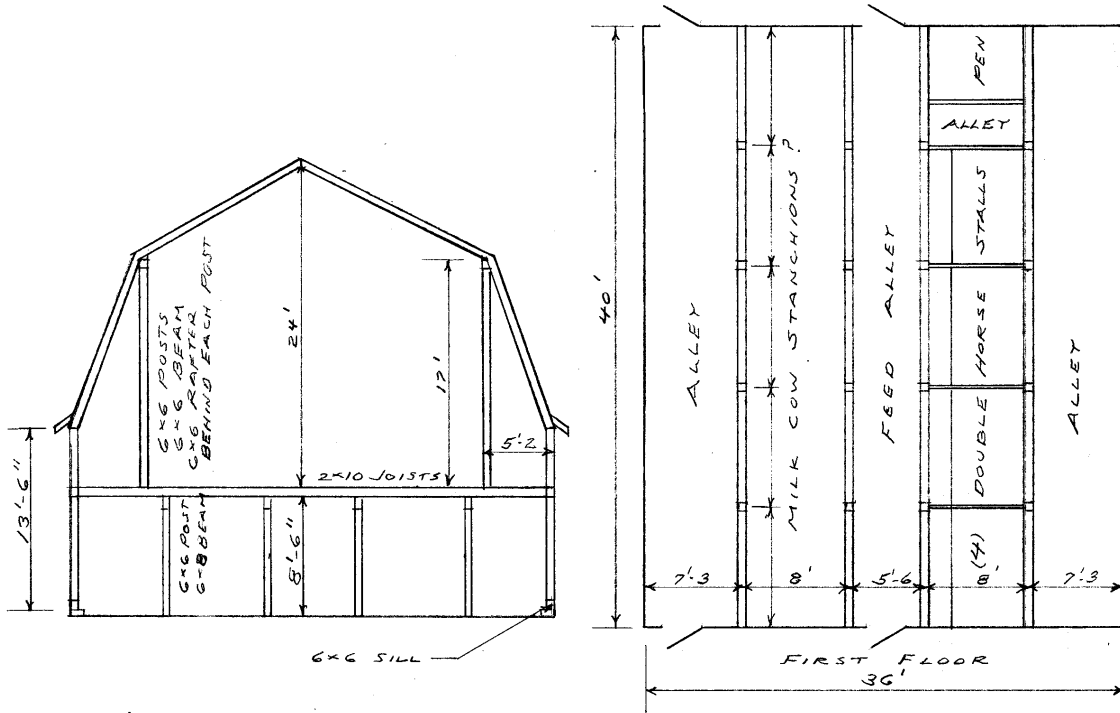

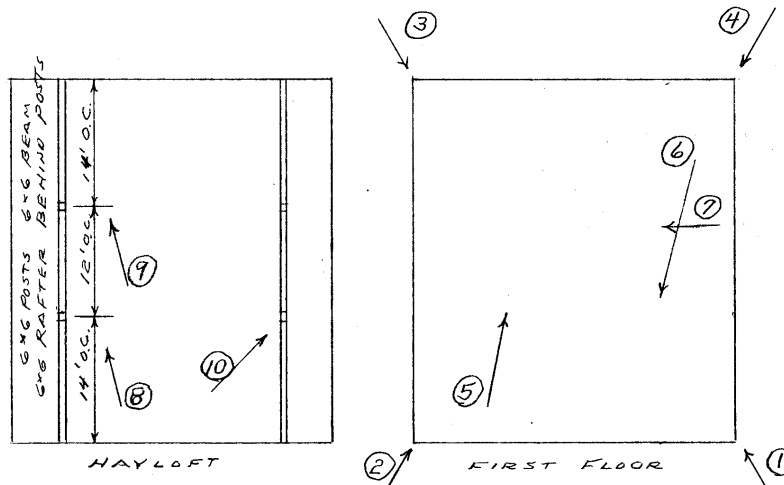
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SKETCH MAP

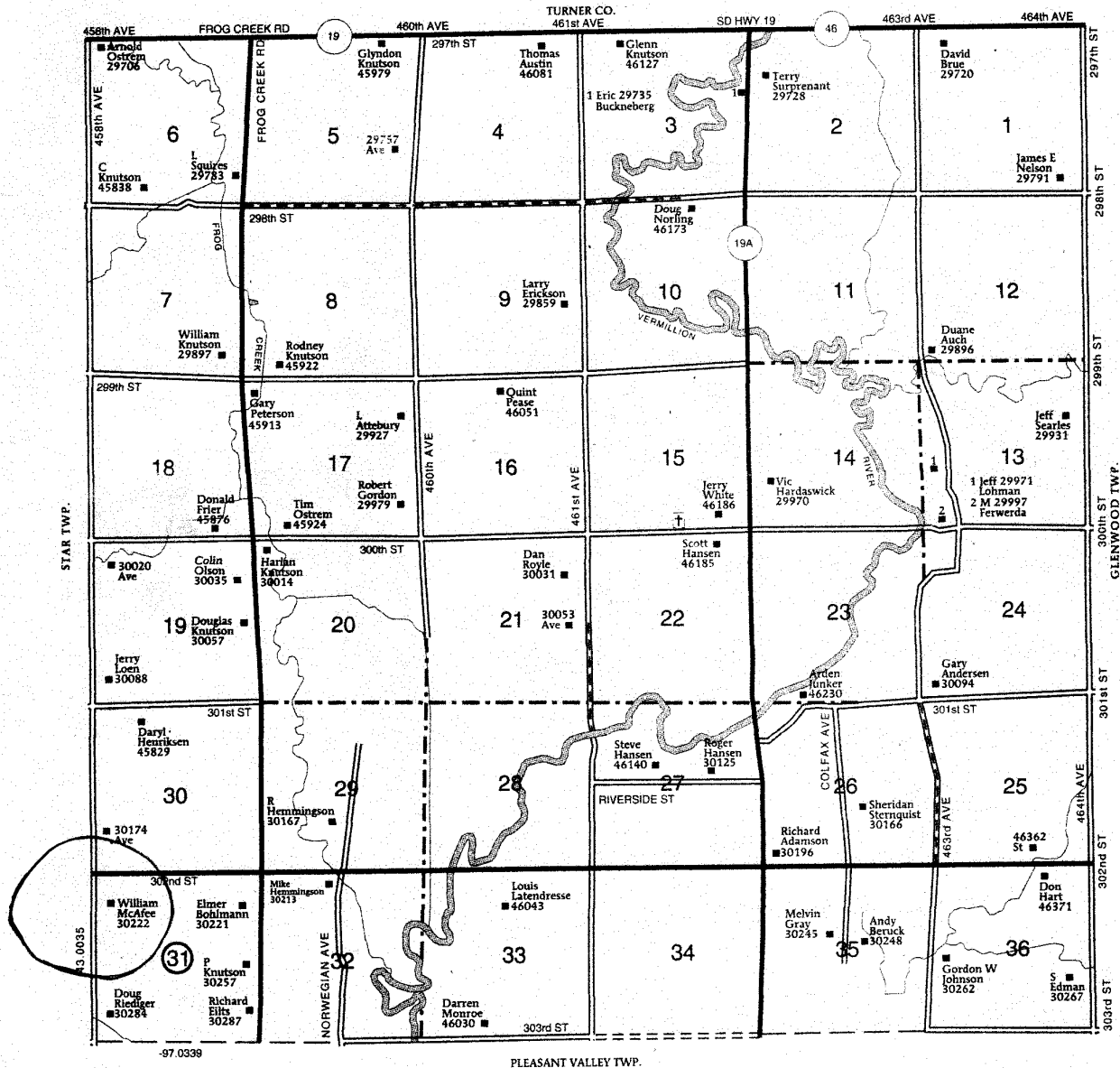

The 1912, 1924 and 1937 Clay County Atlas lists William W. Schmidt as the owner. The 1924 Clay County Atlas also lists the farm as “West Riverside Farm”

The 1948 and 1956 Clay County Atlas lists D. F. Collins as the owner.
