



1877 Anders J. Sjuberg received the land patent on this farm.

The 1894 Clay County Atlas lists Anders J. Sjuberg as the owner.

The 1912 and 1924 Clay County Atlas lists Anders J. Shuberg as the owner. (Note change in the last name.)

The 1937,1948 and 1956 Clay County Atlas lists H. L. Paulson as the owner.
