for hayloft floor. Six horse stalls, one milk cow stall and stairs to hayloft are still in place.

OTHER NOTES: Nine 9x12 four light windows on the first floor, two more in hayloft on the North wall  
and two 9x12 over 9x12 four light window in hayloft on the South wall.

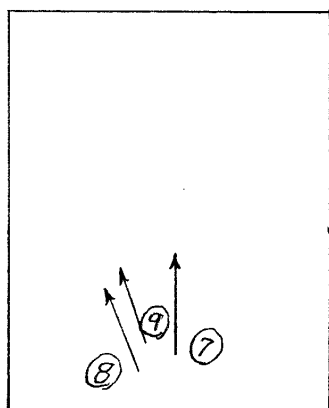

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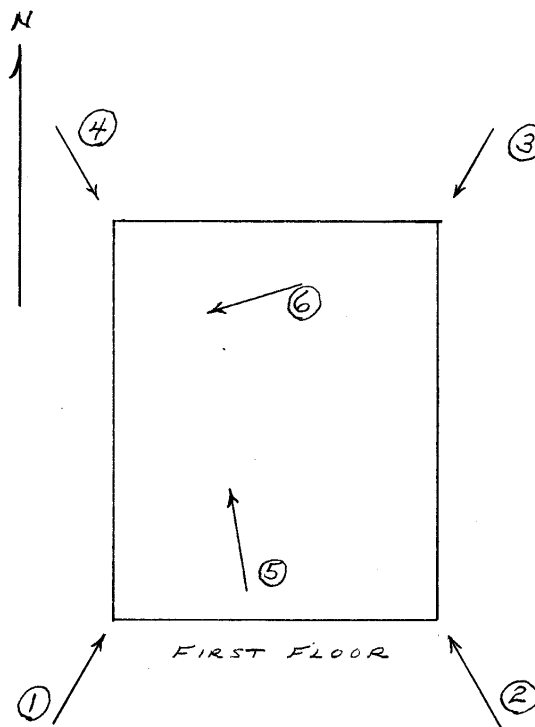
**SKETCH MAP**

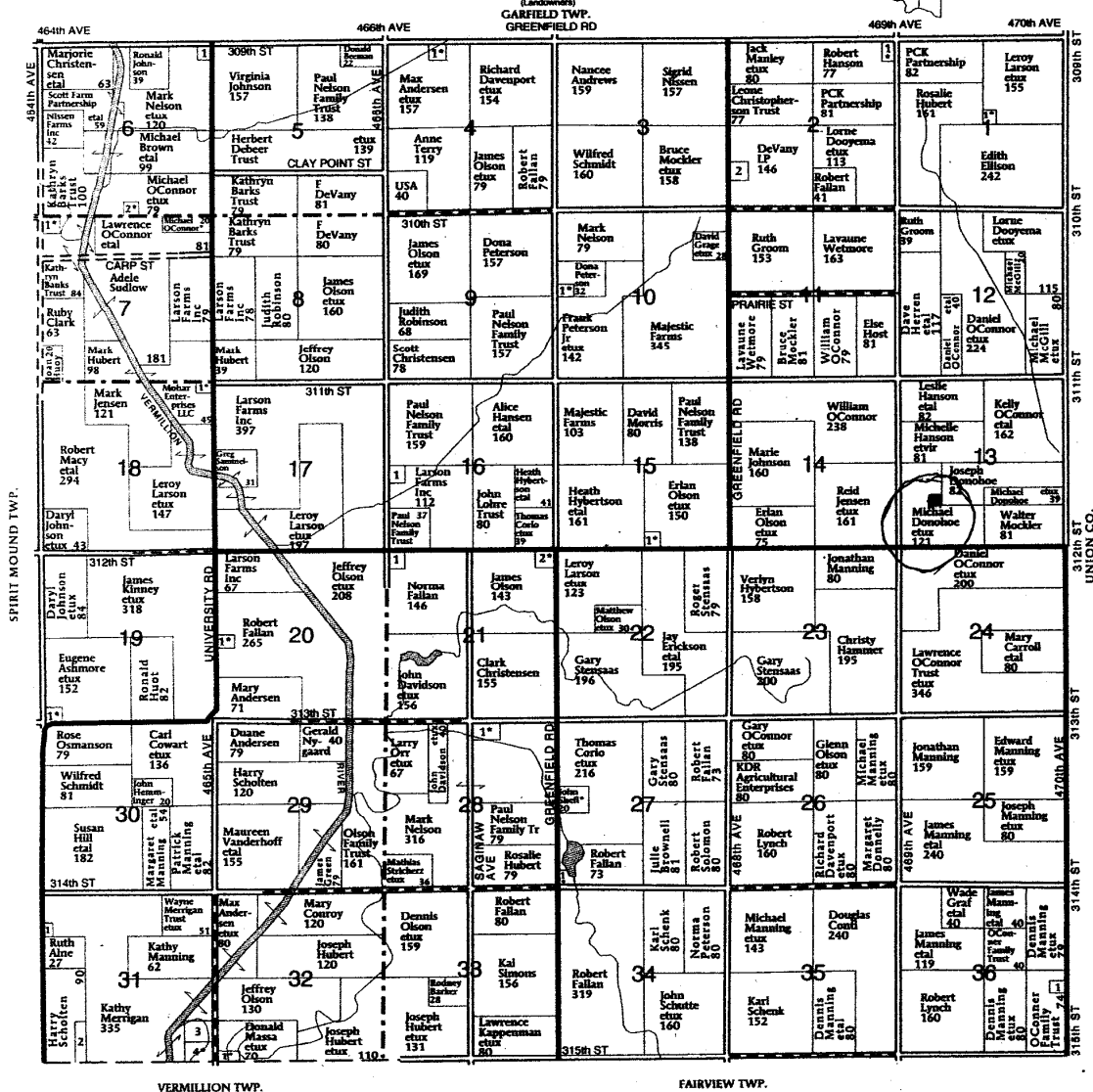
